Bassmaster Classic coming to Lake Ray Roberts next month

The eyes of Texas — and the world — will be watching as the Super Bowl of Professional Bass Fishing heads to Fort Worth with fishing taking place at Lake Ray Roberts, just east of Sanger. For just the third time in the event's storied history, the 2021 Academy Sports + Outdoors Bassmaster Classic will be coming to Texas. If you can't make it out, the event will be covered live and streamed on Bassmaster.com, ESPN3 and the ESPN App, and five hours of original programming will be aired on ESPN2 and the Pursuit Channel following the event.

Originally scheduled from March 19-21, the 51st Classic was moved to early summer as the tournament dates shifted to June 11-13, 2021, because of the pandemic. They did it to make it possible for more fans to be a part of the daily weigh-ins at the new Dickies Arena

and the Bassmaster Classic Outdoors Expo at the Will Rogers Memorial Center, both in downtown Fort Worth.

"We look forward to seeing thousands of fans, along with our partners and industry friends, at the 51st Bassmaster Classic," said B.A.S.S. CEO Bruce Akin, in a news release.

Having a summertime Classic is certainly not unprecedented. The 2001 Classic in July was won by Kevin VanDam took place in the steamy bayous and marshes near New Orleans. And when the Classic visited Lake Texoma back in 1979—an event won by Hank Parker—the derby was actually held in September as the summertime heat waned and fall began.

In fact, B.A.S.S. officials note that from the inaugural Classic in 1971 until 1983, the event took place in the autumn months. Then from 1984 until 2005, the event was

held during the summer-time.

The so-called "Super Bowl of Bass Fishing" was moved to a springtime event in 2006 when the first season of the Bassmaster Elite Series took place. That calendar timeframe remained in place during the Classic's second visit to Texas back in 2017 when the Lake Conroe event was won by Jordan Lee.

While the third Classic ever held on Texas waters could have likely occurred on Ray Roberts in the late March time slot with only the anglers, tournament staff, and Sports TV cameras looking on, it was becoming increasingly unlikely that the usual number of bass fishing fans would be able to attend.

That thought made the move into early summer more palatable for officials with B.A.S.S. and the city of Fort Worth, the

host community for the event.

Just how important are fans to the Classic? Extremely important as a look at the numbers from previous events will show.

Take, for instance, the last two Classics held in Birmingham, Ala., and Knoxville, Tenn., which B.A.S.S. officials say drew record-breaking crowds of 122,814 and 153,809 fans respectively to the weigh-ins, Expo, and other Classic Week events.

In the end, while the

Classic is all about an exciting fishing derby that one angler wins on Championship Day, it's also an economic engine that is vital to organizers, host cities, and manufacturers who unveil a number of new products.

While Lake Ray Roberts would have likely been able to show off a number of big bass catches in the springtime event, the move to June is more of a win-win scenario for those putting on the event and hoping to see something

like the \$35.9 million dollar economic impact that the 2020 Classic generated for host city Birmingham.

After all, that's what the Bassmaster Classic is all about, the enthusiastic gathering of anglers, fans and the industry in the biggest bass fishing party of the year.

The event will have an economic impact on Lake Ray Roberts and Sanger with heavy traffic from anglers and fans, along with national TV exposure for the area.

Look past these life insurance myths

Most people recognize the need for life insurance – but many of them still don’t have it.

Why? People offer a variety of rationales for remaining uninsured. But these reasons may just be myths. Here are a few of them:

“I’m single (or married with no children), so I don’t need life insurance.” Even if you’re single, you may still have financial obligations that could be met by life insurance proceeds if something happened to you. Perhaps you have taken out some loans with a co-signer who would be on the hook for the balance, or maybe you have a business partner who might be in trouble without your resources. And if you’re married but don’t have children, you’d still want to provide support for your spouse, particularly if student loans or a mortgage is involved.

“Life insurance is too expensive.” Different types of insurance carry different costs. If you purchase permanent insurance, such as whole life or universal life, your premiums are paying for a death benefit and a savings component. Consequently, this type of policy is more expensive than term insurance, which just provides a death benefit for a certain number of years. Term insurance is usually quite affordable, and, generally speaking, the younger you are, the less expensive the policy – and, of course, you can shop around for the best rates.

“I get enough life insurance through my employer.” Many employers do offer life insurance

as an employee benefit, but there are two possible issues with this coverage. First, it may be for a minimal amount and not enough for your needs, especially if you have several dependents. And second, an employer’s life insurance policy is not necessarily portable – if you leave your job, you might lose your coverage.

“I have a pre-existing condition, so I’m sure I couldn’t get life insurance.” Some pre-existing conditions don’t automatically disqualify you from getting life insurance, although you might end up paying higher premiums than someone without any health issues. In any case, it’s a good idea to look at what various companies might offer, as insurers use somewhat different underwriting processes and may view pre-existing conditions differently.

“Insurers don’t want to pay out the proceeds.” Actually, there’s a fairly straightforward process for paying out death benefits. Your beneficiaries must file a claim and submit the death certificate – and that’s about it. An insurer must have a strong reason to deny a claim, and, in fact, the company is typically motivated to pay as soon as possible to avoid incurring interest charges

for delayed payments.

Don’t let any of these myths deter you from obtaining life insurance. Then, when you’re ready to act, you’ll need to ask some questions: How much coverage do I need? Should I get term or permanent insurance? How should I designate my beneficiaries? You may want to work with a financial

professional to determine the type and amount of insurance you need. Once you’ve gotten your coverage in place, you’ll know that you’ve done what you could to help protect your loved ones – and that’s no myth.

Jerry Jones heads to Sanger for latest industrial property play

The development site purchase is on Interstate 35, north of R&L Carriers

According to an article in the Dallas Morning News, Dallas Cowboys owner Jerry Jones is expanding his industrial real estate sights with the purchase of a large site in Denton County.

Jones' Blue Star Land has purchased 274 acres for industrial construction on Interstate 35 north of Den-

ton. The property is adjacent to a major Walmart distribution center in the town of Sanger.

Warehouse and distribution development activity in the Denton area has been picking up in the past year, and the tract Blue Star purchased is one of the largest sites to change hands.

"Denton is basically out of any more industrial sites to accommodate large users and this site is well positioned to serve as the new business logistics center for the area," said real estate broker Rex Glendenning with Rex Real Estate. "I feel the I-35 corridor north of Denton is extremely well positioned."

Glendenning and Randy Potts with Harvest Real Estate brokered the property sale with Randy Smith of Smith Properties.

Blue Star Land's new mixed-use project is about 30 miles south of downtown Dallas in the Ellis County town of Waxahachie.

This is the latest in a series of recent industrial property plays by Blue Star Land.

The Jones family's real estate arm has purchased more than 120 acres on Interstate 35E in Waxahachie for a mixed-use project that will include industrial and e-commerce buildings. And late last year, Blue Star Land bought 40 acres on First Street in Prosper to build a business park.

Blue Star Land has also made several industrial development site purchases between Preston Road and the Dallas North Tollway in Frisco. Jones' more than 200-acre Star Business Park off Preston Road south of U.S. Highway 380 has attracted multiple industrial building tenants.

Dallas-Fort Worth is the country's largest industrial building market with more than 25 million square feet of space under construction.
