# H-E-B to build a store in Denton at Rayzor Ranch on University Drive

Tom Thumb in Sanger on schedule to open by the end of the year

Texas grocery company H-E-B is planning not one but two stores for Denton. The store will be located just nine miles south of Sanger.

The San Antonio-based company has started the permit process with the city to build a second store, currently dubbed "Denton #2," at the northeast corner of University Drive and Bonnie Brae Street, Mabrie Jackson, managing director of public affairs for

H-E-B and Central Market, said in a Tuesday evening message to the Denton Record-Chronicle.

Construction on the 119,000-square-foot store is set to begin in spring 2026.

"H-E-B is excited to serve even more residents of Denton and surrounding towns with a second store located at University and Bonnie Brae," Jackson wrote. "We look forward to sharing more construction details after the first of



the year."

H-E-B purchased the property just off University Drive in 2015, but for years it had no immediate plans to build there. Torchy's Tacos and a shopping strip currently sit at the busy corner next to Rayzor Ranch Marketplace.

In March, H-E-B announced plans to open its first grocery in Denton on a 20-acre site at the northwest corner of Interstate

35W and Robson Ranch Road.

Sanger residents will have a convenient option in their own town with the new Tom Thumb Grocery Store on the corner of FM 455 W. (Chapman Drive) and I-35, that is expected to open by the end of the year. See photo of the progress of construction on page 5.

Tom Thumb and H-E-B are building stores, as well at Robson Ranch in Denton, near Argyle.

Richard "Kenneth" Fultz, Jr., 81, passed away peacefully on Sunday, July 20, 2025.

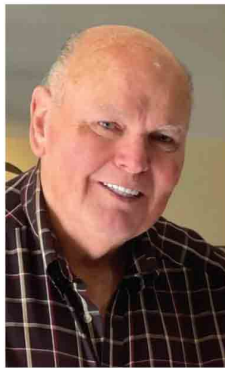

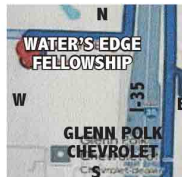

## You Have an Estate Plan — Whether You Know It or Not

Think estate planning is only for the wealthy or elderly? Think again. If you own anything — a home, a car, a savings account, even a pet — you already have an estate plan. The only question is: Did you create it, or will your state do it for you?

When someone passes away without an estate plan, state laws take over, deciding who gets what

and when. This legal process may not reflect your wishes. That's why taking control of your assets through a personal estate plan should be a top priority.

At its core, estate planning is about clarifying your wishes and making things easier for your heirs. It ensures your assets are distributed according to your preferences, designates who will make decisions on your behalf if you can't and provides guidance for your care in a medical crisis. Most plans include four key components:

A Will – This docu-

ment outlines how your assets should be distributed after your death and names an executor to oversee the process in probate court. It can also designate guardians for minor children. Keep in mind that a will doesn't cover everything — certain transfer on death (TOD) accounts and jointly held property may bypass your will entirely.

Power of Attorney – If you become incapacitated, you'll want someone you trust to be able to make decisions on your behalf. A durable power of attorney designates such a person, helping to ensure your bills are paid, your business continues (if you have one) and your wishes are honored.

Health Care Directive – Sometimes called a living will, this document spells out your preferences for medical treatment if you're unable to speak for yourself. It can also designate someone to make health care decisions for you.

Beneficiary Designations – Accounts like 401(k)s, IRAs, and life insurance policies transfer directly to the people you name, regardless of what your will says. It's essential to review these beneficiary designations regularly, especially after significant life events such as marriage, divorce, death of a spouse or the birth of a child.

One common myth is

that a will is all you need. But wills only take effect after death; they don't help if you're alive but unable to make decisions. Another misconception is that estate planning is only for the wealthy. In truth, planning is about more than money — it's about making things easier for the people you love during difficult times.

An effective estate plan can prevent costly legal battles, reduce confusion and give your loved ones a clear roadmap to follow. It also allows you to leave a legacy that reflects your values and priorities.

As your life changes, your estate plan should change along with it. Review your documents every few years or after major life events. It's often a good idea to seek help with such reviews. Your financial advisor or attorney can guide you through the process, ensuring your plan fits your unique circumstances.

In the end, estate planning isn't just about planning for what happens when you are gone. It's about feeling confident, knowing that what matters most — your family, your purpose, your legacy — is protected.

**Oasis Apartments** is a planned 82-unit, three-story apartment community located at 4300 McReynolds Road, near Lane Ranch.



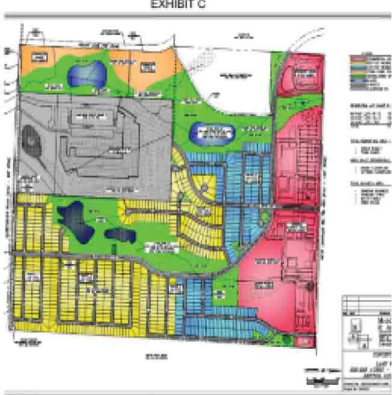
**Windhaven Estates** is developing 19.5 acres located on Marion Road just north of FM 455, across of the new Sanger High School. The development will consist of 30 large residential lots, with lot that are .40 acres and above. This will be a gated community.

**Lois Road Estates** master planned development is located along Lois Road E and will include approximately 784 single-family lots.



Marley Meadows is a 19.653-acre residential development located within the City of Sanger's Extra-Territorial Jurisdiction (ETJ). The property lies on the west side of Sam Bass Road, just north of the FM 455 and Sam Bass intersection. The project includes 17, 1 acre lots.

Lane Ranch has officially broke ground. Lane Ranch will be located along West Chapman Road, just to the east of the Sanger High School. This new development will have 1086 residential lots, 240 multi-family, assisted living, and 43 acres of commercial land.



### Chapman Crossing

This planned residential community spans approximately 68.209 acres along Belz Road, west of North Stemmons Freeway. The development is projected to include approximately 296 single-family lots, along with 11 HOA/open space lots, and 612 multi-family units. Minimum home sizes within the community will range between 1,300 and 2,000 square feet.



### City Approves First Public Improvement District (PID)

The City Council recently approved the City's first Public Improvement District (PID), marking a major milestone in local development. The PID encompasses approximately 306 acres located north of Belz Road and will support the Elada Planned Development. This project includes around 234 acres designated for 1,057 single-family homes, along with 71 acres set aside for parks, open space, and community amenities.

A Public Improvement District (PID) is a defined geographic area where property owners pay additional assessments to fund specific public improvements within that area. These improvements, which can include infrastructure, amenities, or services, are intended to enhance the area's value and appeal. PIDs are a financing tool used by cities to fund projects that benefit specific properties, rather than relying solely on general tax revenue.

Here's a more detailed explanation:

Financing:

Property owners within the PID pay special assessments, which are in addition to their regular property taxes. These assessments are usually based on the property's value or frontage and are used to pay for the improvements.

Improvements:

PIDs can fund a wide range of projects, such as:  
Roads and sidewalks.  
Water and wastewater systems.  
Drainage improvements.  
Parks and landscaping.  
Public art and beautification projects.  
Security and enhanced services.

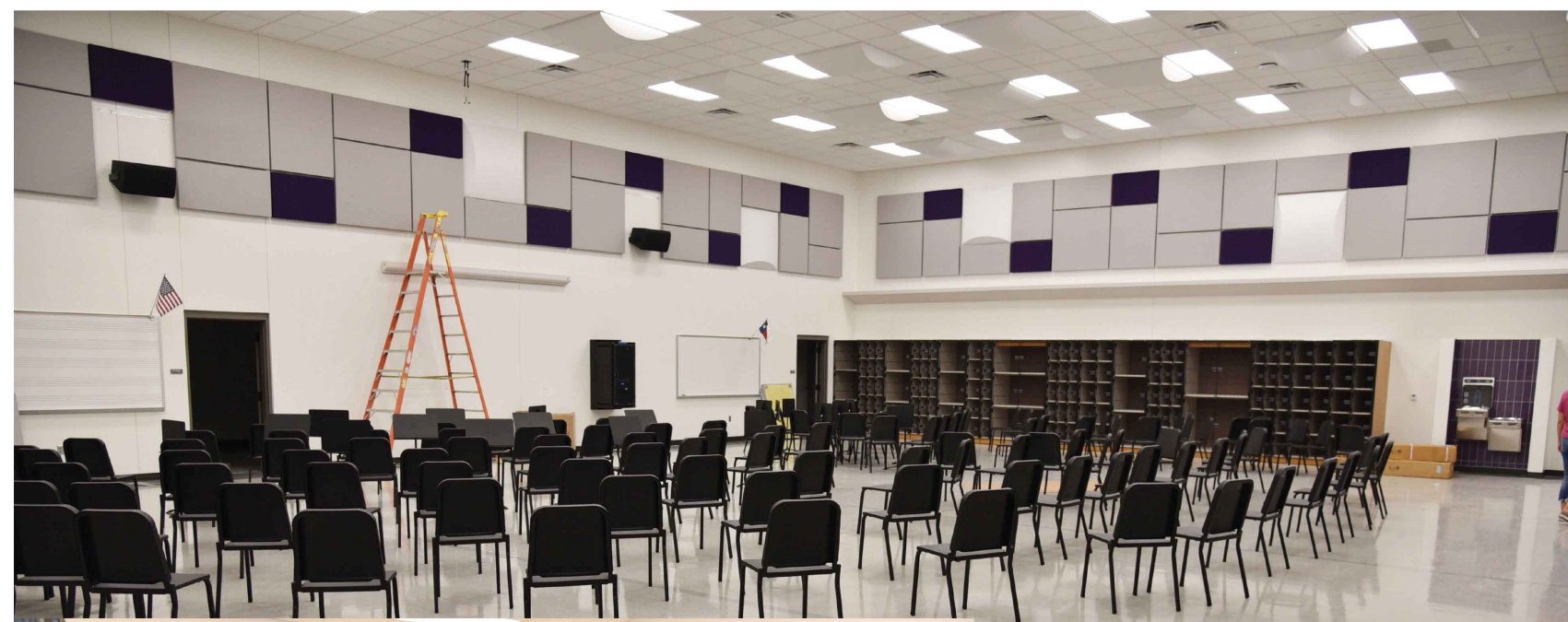

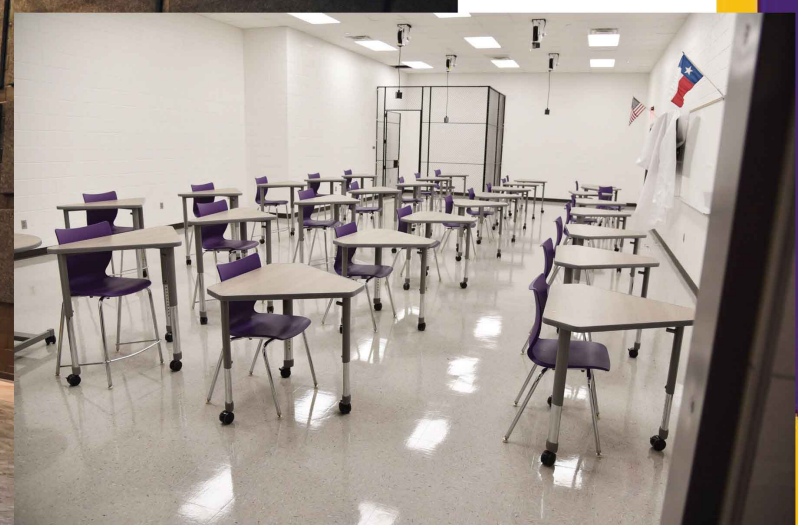

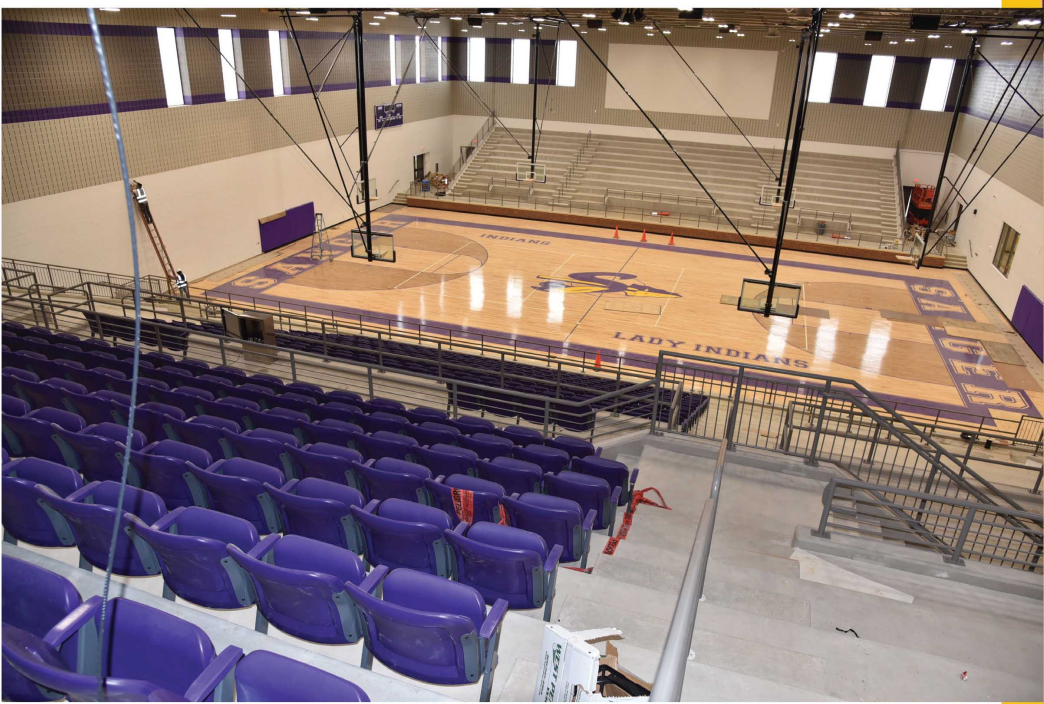
The new Main Gym can seat over 2,000 people and has a digital screen scoreboard.



There are two-levels (upper/lower) on the home side. The middle features chair seating. The rest of the home side and visitors will be bench style with a back rest.



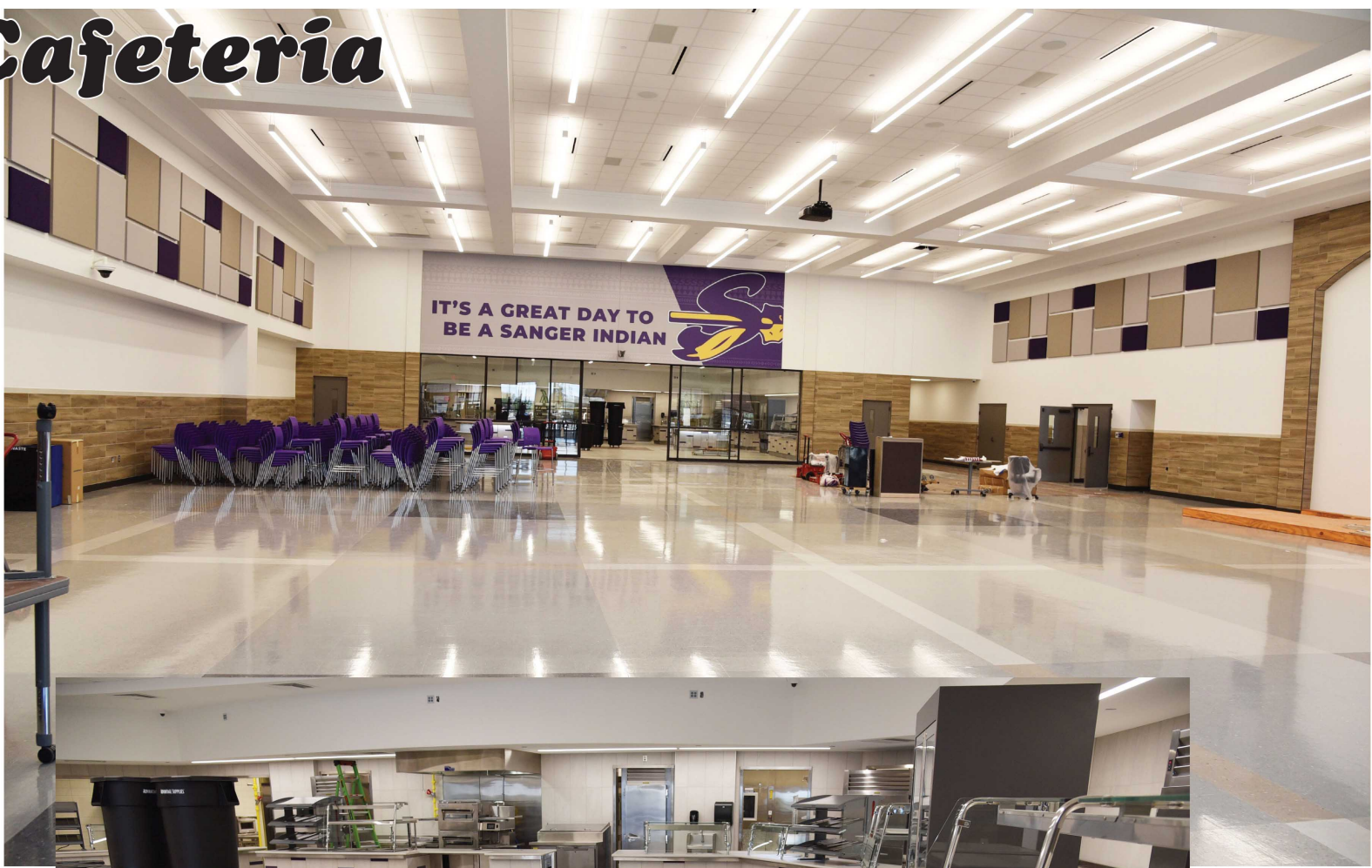

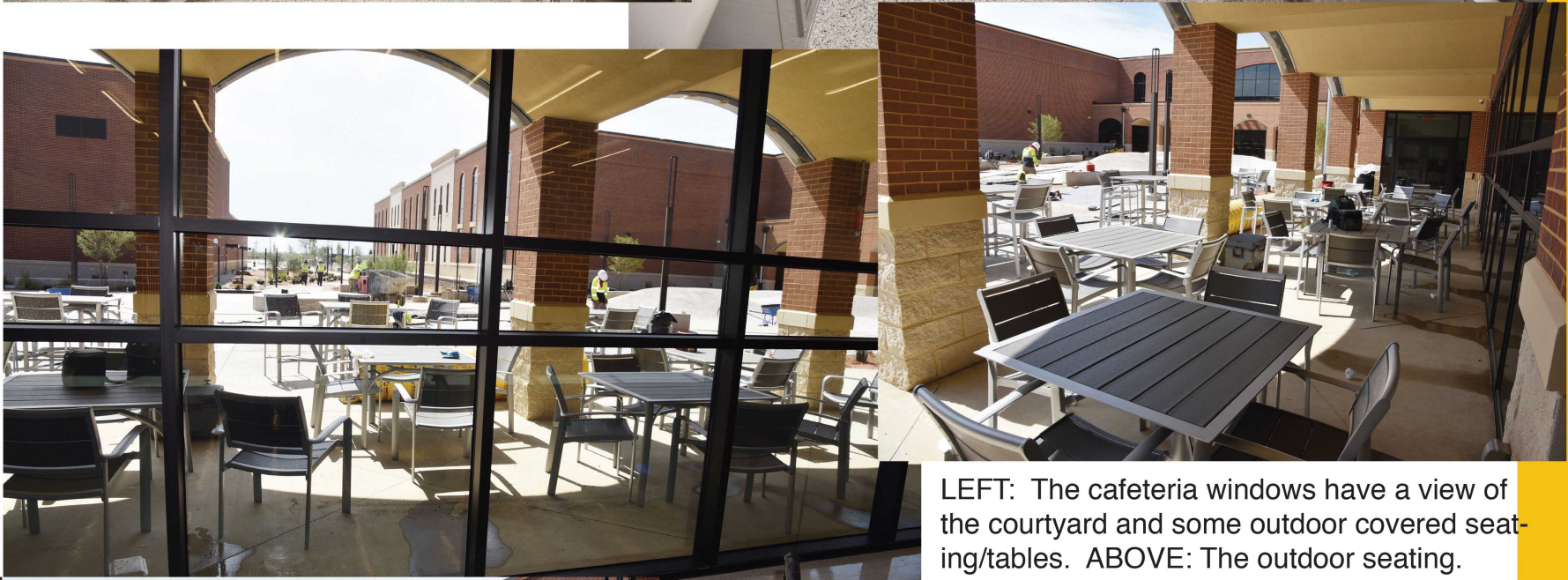

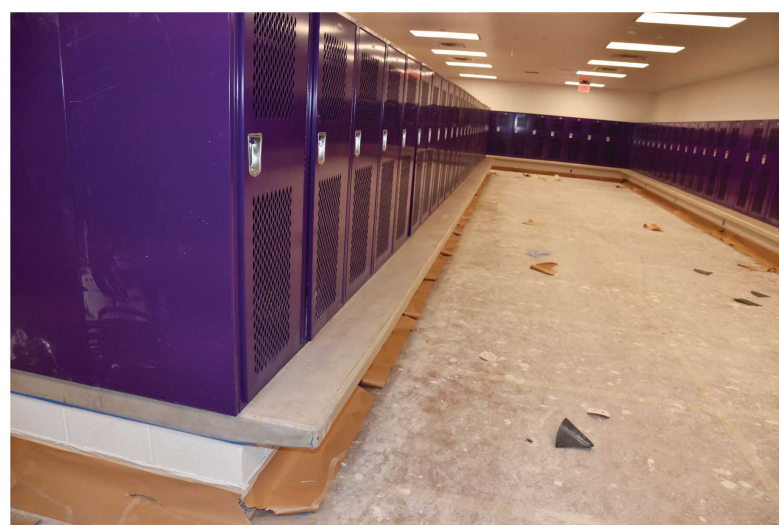
