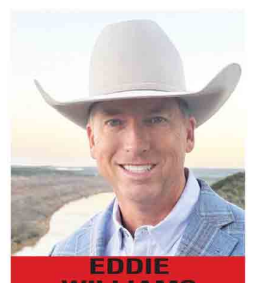

740-acre development to bring high-end homes, retail and hotel just outside of Sanger

This story was originally published by the Fort Worth Report and reprinted by Denton Record-Chronicle and Sanger News:

A Florida developer last week announced plans for a 740-acre mixed-use development including single-family and multi-family residential offerings, a hotel, retail and restaurant sites, and recreation amenities.

The development, called Wildhaven, is from An Ki Land Development of Sarasota, Florida. An exact address was not available, but according to map coordinates in sales

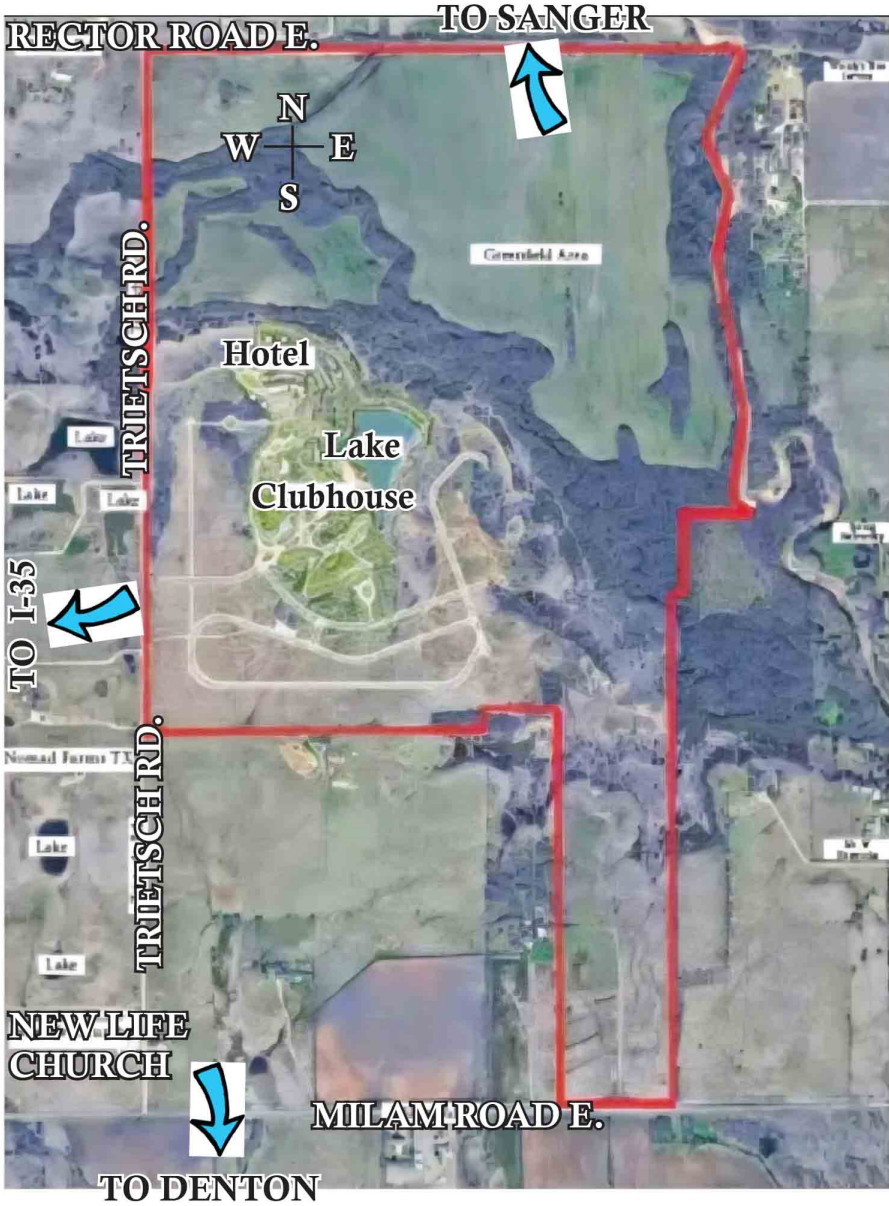
presentation documents, the project will be located in unincorporated Denton County, south of Sanger between Rector and Milam Roads, just north-east of New Life Church. (SEE MAP LOCATION):

This project is inside the Sanger ISD Zone Map, and just outside of Sanger and Denton city limits. Wildhaven will include approximately 150 high-end homes, up to 500 multi-family units, a 120-bed hotel, two restaurants, a spa and commercial buildings. The project will include a strong outdoor and hospitality emphasis, including

hundreds of acres dedicated to recreation and an equestrian-centered component, according to the company.

“Wildhaven is proud to offer a residential development that demonstrates our deep commitment to environmental stewardship and North Texas’s natural landscape,” said Logan Breen, managing director, in a news release. “Every aspect of our project will reflect our environmental commitment. We want to offer residents a thoughtfully designed community that grows with the land,

not against it.”

Phase 1 of the project will see the development of 86 acres of land already owned by An Ki Land. That part will include homes on about 25 buildable lots of 1 to 2 acres each, multifamily offerings with up to 500 units on 27 acres, along with two commercial parcels. Phase 2 will encompass 548 acres of land currently controlled by An Ki Land, and will consist of 126 buildable lots and a club-resort hotel component.

“Wildhaven will be unlike any other development in North Texas,” said Larry Spelts, part of the development team.

“This development is intended to serve buyers and residents seeking a high-end, experience-driven lifestyle in a market characterized by strong demand and limited inventory,” he said.

Massive master-planned communities like Wildhaven have been transforming Denton County’s open land into residential and commercial hubs.

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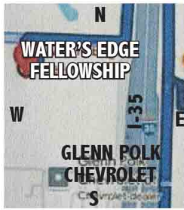

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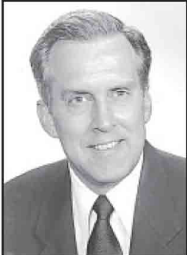
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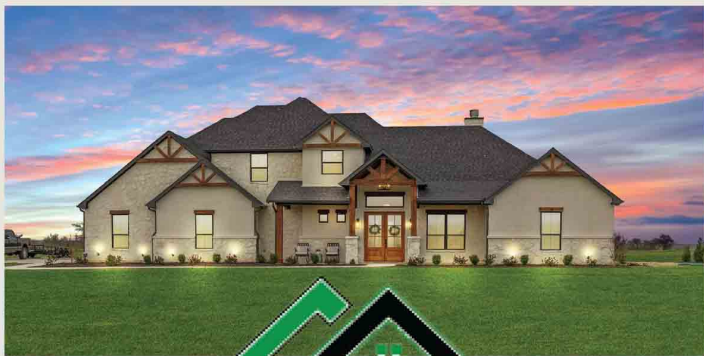

Building your child's education fund, one brick at a time

Every solid house starts with a good blueprint and a strong foundation. Saving for a child's education is very similar.

College costs can seem daunting. In addition to tuition, you'll need to account for housing and food, books and supplies, transportation and other expenses. The average annual budget at an in-state public university runs around \$30,990 today, and a private school is \$65,470 according to the College Board. While most families won't pay a college's list price, you'll still want to start saving as early as possible to be ready when your child is.

Lay the foundation early. You don't have to wait until you have the perfect set of plans to start building. There are specific accounts designed to save for education and some do not require a minimum opening deposit. Setting up automatic recurring contributions, even modest ones, lets you build steadily over time without requiring constant attention.

As your child ages, look for ways to redirect expenses you no longer have towards the build. For example, daycare costs, which can exceed \$1,000

a month, can be shifted into a college savings account once your child enters school. Tax refunds and annual bonuses make excellent additional contributions. And others can pitch in – instead of birthday or holiday toys, ask grandparents or relatives to contribute directly to a college savings account.

Know the size of the house you're building. Families saving for community college followed by two years at a public university might target around \$65,000. Those aiming for four years at a public school are looking at roughly \$100,000. Whatever the goal, plan for education inflation of about 4% annually, which can roughly double costs over 18 years.

You don't have to source all the building materials yourself. Scholarships, grants, student loans and income from part-time work are all legitimate ways to help finish the structure.

Don't let one project consume the whole budget. One risk for parents is pouring so much into the college fund that the retirement fund goes neglected. Remember, loans and grants exist for college, but not for retirement. Strik-

ing the right balance may mean targeting a more affordable school, planning to cover only a portion of costs or adjusting retirement timelines slightly.

Choose the right building materials. For many families, a 529 plan is the right foundation. Earnings grow tax-free, distributions are federally tax-free when used for qualified education expenses, and many states offer additional income tax deductions for contributions. Even better, anyone – such as grandparents or friends – can contribute.

Additionally, qualified expenses for a 529 plan go beyond tuition and cover books, computers, internet access, room and board, and more. Vocational and trade schools often qualify, too, opening the door to careers in skilled trades, healthcare and technology.

No contractor builds alone. A knowledgeable financial advisor can help you draw up a realistic blueprint and make sure the college project doesn't crowd out the rest of your financial future. The earlier you break ground on that conversation, the stronger the structure will be.

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Summer Burnout Is Real: How to Protect Your Mental Health When Life Gets Busy

Summer is often marketed as care-free. But for many adults, summer is a high-demand season. Kids are home from school which often leads to shifting work schedules, travel planning, family gatherings, and the pressure to “make memories.”

Burnout doesn't only happen in high-powered careers. It can happen in parenting, caregiving, running a small business, or simply trying to keep up.

Burnout is not a personal failure. It's a sign that your nervous system has been carrying too much for too long.

What burnout can look like

Burnout isn't always dramatic. It often shows up as:

- Feeling emotionally numb or detached
- Irritability and impatience
- Difficulty concentrating
- Sleep changes (too much or too little)
- Increased headaches or stomach issues
- Feeling like everything is “too much”

Some people also notice increased anxiety or sadness.

Why summer can increase burnout

Summer brings unique stressors:

- Less routine and more decision-making
- Financial pressure from activities and travel
- More social events (even when

you're already tired)

- More noise and stimulation at home

For people with anxiety, ADHD, or trauma histories, increased stimulation can be especially draining.

5 ways to protect your mental health this summer

- 1) Lower the bar on perfection
You do not need a “Pinterest summer” to have a meaningful one. Kids often remember connection more than activities.

Ask: “What's the one thing that matters most to us this season?”

- 2) Create a weekly rhythm
Even one predictable day can reduce stress:

- Library day
- Pool day
- Family movie night
- Sunday meal prep

Predictability helps everyone feel more grounded.

- 3) Schedule recovery like you schedule events

If your calendar has only obligations, burnout is predictable.

Add recovery:

- Quiet mornings
- A 20-minute nap

- A walk alone
- A ‘no-plans’ evening
- 4) Watch for “over-yes-ing”
Summer invites extra invitations. If you say yes to everything, your body will eventually say no.

Try this boundary phrase:

- “That sounds fun, but we’re keeping our schedule simple this month.”
- 5) Use sunlight and nature as a daily reset

Even brief outdoor time can help your nervous system downshift.

Try:

- Stepping outside for 3 minutes between tasks
- Eating one meal outside
- Taking phone calls while walking

When to reach out for support

If you're feeling persistently overwhelmed, disconnected, or stuck in survival mode, therapy can help you:

- Identify what's draining you
- Build boundaries without guilt
- Improve coping skills
- Strengthen relationships
- Create a sustainable routine

Summer can still be a season of growth—even if it's messy.

11, 2025. He was born in Denton, Texas, on May 6, 1962, to John D. and Carol Ann Springer, Jeff's life was rooted in faith, family, and a steadfast commitment to others.

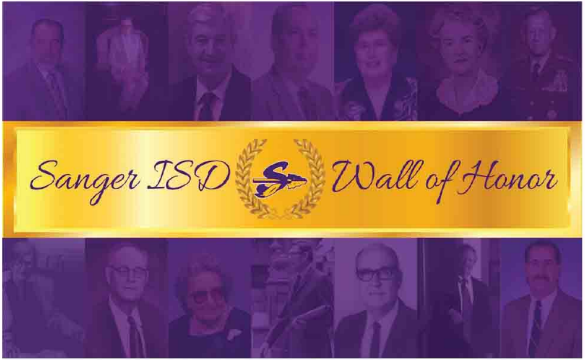
As a young child, Jeff's curiosity and joy for life were evident - even in simple pleasures like chasing prairie dogs through Odessa parks. In 1966, he earned the proud title of "Big Brother" with the birth of his sister, Ann, whom he adored. The family soon returned to Sanger, where Jeff made life-long friends and graduated with the Class of 1980.

At Baylor University, Jeff's steady determination earned him respect - but it was his humility and genuine love of learning that set him apart. He completed both his B.A. in Economics with Honors (1983) and his J.D. from Baylor Law School (1985) in just five years - a remarkable achievement. During law school, he endured the heartbreak of losing his

mother, Carol Ann, one of his earliest encouragers and strongest champions.

It was at Baylor's Allen Hall cafeteria where he met Michelle - the love of his life. They married in 1985 and settled in Denton, where Jeff began his legal career at Phillips and Hopkins, P.C. Their home soon welcomed rescue pups - and later, the greatest joys of Jeff's life: their son Eli in 1994, and daughter Audrey in 1998. Fatherhood transformed Jeff. He loved his family fiercely and without reservation; they were his world.

In 1985, Jeff met Frank Lyle, who became not only his law partner but a brother in every way. Together they founded Springer and Lyle, LLP, a firm grounded in their shared values: service, integrity, and a deep sense of responsibility. Jeff was a gifted litigator and mediator, known not just for his legal acumen, but for the grounded compassion he brought to every case. His contributions to the legal profession were numerous and respected.
