17 statewide propositions will appear on the November ballot

Here's what Texas voters need to know.
A majority of the proposed constitutional amendments address tax cuts for homeowners and businesses.

On Nov. 4, Texas voters will get the final say on 17 constitutional amendments — usually listed as statewide propositions at the top of the ballot — including billions of dollars in property tax cuts for homeowners and businesses. This affects Sanger and Denton County voters.

Earlier this year, a two-thirds majority of the state Legislature passed the joint resolutions calling for the constitutional amendment elections, along with the state's budget for the next two years, which includes \$51 billion for property tax cuts.

Texas lawmakers have used multibillion-dollar budget surpluses, the result of inflation and temporary federal stimulus dollars during the COVID-19 pandemic, to pay for tax cuts in recent years. Proponents of tax cuts and bans, including Gov. Greg Abbott, have said they will maintain Texas as a competitive, business-friendly state and contribute to economic growth.

If the constitutional amendments are ap-

proved, a majority of state lawmakers and Texas voters would need to pass new constitutional amendments to undo measures. Constitutional amendments are the only ballot propositions Texans get to vote on at the state level and will appear on the top of voters' ballots, above any local races or measures they may be deciding.

To weigh in on the constitutional amendments, Texas voters need to be registered to vote. Early voting will run from

- Homeowners.
- Businesses.
- Elderly and disabled homeowners.
- Spouses of veterans.
- Homeowners who had home destroyed in a fire.
- Property owners w/ border security infrastructure.
- Those who sell animal feed.

Other proposed amendments would prevent the state from imposing additional taxes on:

- Personal or business capital gains.
- Securities transactions, those working in securities.
- Inheritances.

Other proposals would fund:

- Water infrastructure.
- The Texas State Technical College.
- Research on dementia treatment and prevention.

A few proposals would amend the constitution to:

- Limit when a person can be released on bail.
- Enshrine parental rights.
- Clarify citizenship requirements for Texas voters.
- Overhaul the State Commission on Judicial Conduct.

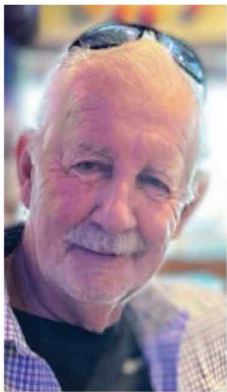

Susan Kaye (Suzy) Self, a resident of Pilot Point, Texas, passed away September 21, 2025. She was preceded in death by her husband Buford T (Big Tom) Self and her parents. Suzy was born November 14, 1942, in Lawton, Oklahoma to E. Frank Rush and Genelle Rush from Cache, Oklahoma and later of Carrollton, Texas. Suzy was the granddaughter of Frank S. Rush and May (Mamo) Rush of Cache, Oklahoma and Dilmus A. Walker and Maudie Smith Walker of Blair, Oklahoma.

Suzy succumbed to cancer after a courageous battle.

Suzy and Tom were married for 58 years before Tom's passing in 2020. They met at Craterville Park near Cache, Oklahoma. Suzy's grandparents and parents founded and operated Craterville Park, which was the family entertainment center of Southwest Oklahoma from 1923 until it closed in 1965. Tom's grandparents worked at Craterville Park, so Tom and Suzy spent much of their childhood together. Suzy graduated from Cache High School and Southwestern Oklahoma State University in Weatherford, Oklahoma. She was an accomplished rider and performed as “Sure Shot Annie Oakley” in the Rush family Wild West Show at Six Flags Over Texas in 1966 and 1967.

Suzy and Tom were also co-owners of Sandy Lake Amusement Park from 1971 until the park was closed and the property sold in October of 2018. Suzy's parents, Frank and Genelle Rush (both now deceased), and her brother Frank and his wife Vickie Rush, were the other co-owners of the popular Carrollton fun spot for 48 successful seasons.

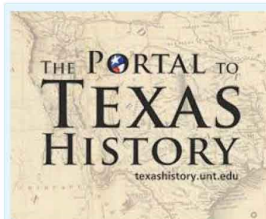
Suzy's primary park responsibility was the operation of FunFest. FunFest became, by far, the largest and longest-running privately owned school music competition in the nation. FunFest, held at Sandy Lake Amusement Park, hosted as many as 1,400 bands, choirs, and orchestras annually during the nine weeklong competitions. Suzy recently accepted the prestigious 2025 Phi Beta Mu Outstanding Contributor Award at the Texas Bandmasters Association Convention in San Antonio on behalf of the Sandy Lake Amusement Park family and FunFest.

Suzy is survived by their son Tom F Self, and his wife Annesa Self of Valley View, Texas, one grandson, TJ Self of Valley View, and her brother Frank Rush III and wife Vickie Rush of Frisco, Texas.

Tom F Self and Annesa, along with Suzy and Tom's nephew David Rush and his wife Tori Rush, their niece Jodi Rush Cuccurullo and her husband Frank Cuccurullo, plus the 5th generation amusement park family, including TJ Self, Whitney Rush Strong, and Taylor Cuccurullo, worked and lived at the family-owned park.

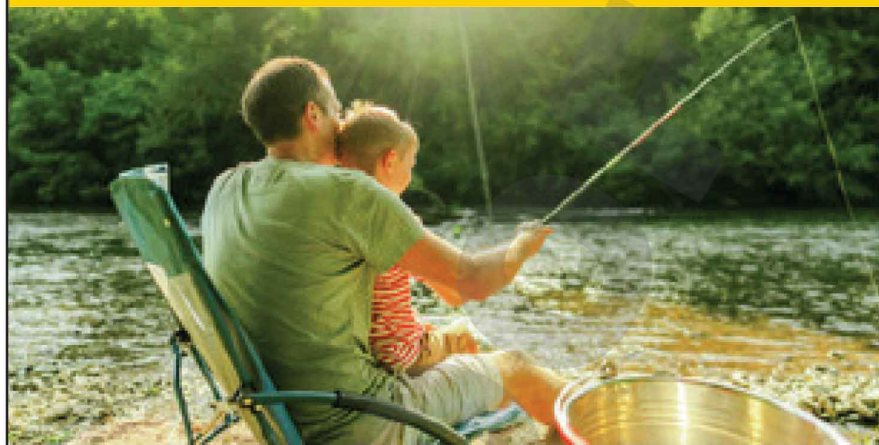

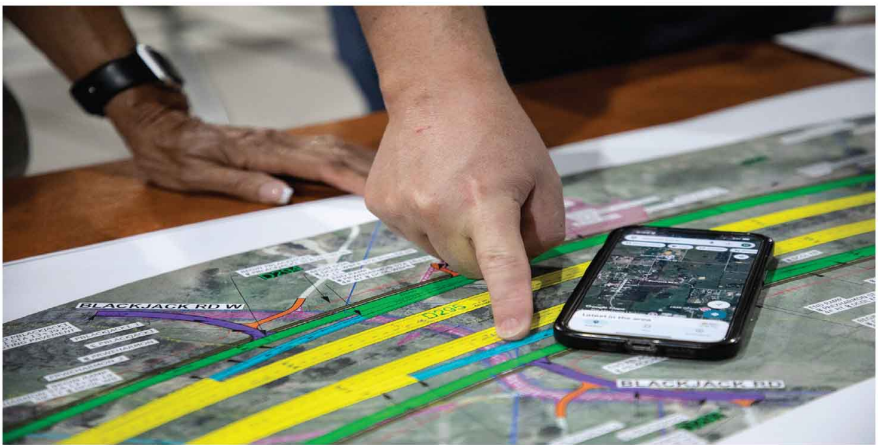

To address increasing growth in the region, Denton County, in partnership with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), is developing an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) to construct a six-lane freeway primarily on new location



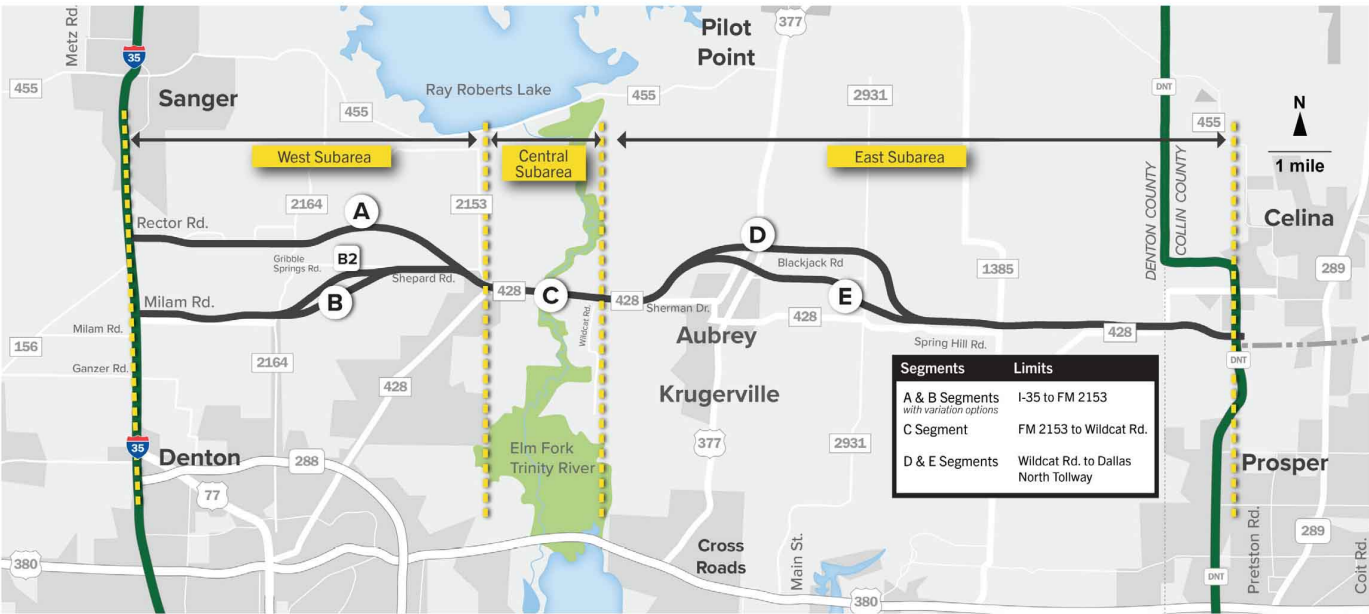
TxDOT began the development of an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) to evaluate the potential impact of the project and alternatives under consideration in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process.

In this EIS, Denton County and TxDOT are evaluating four alternatives for a new location six lane freeway in addition to a “no-build” alternative. Alternatives are evaluated for their potential impact

to both the human and natural environment and in consideration of input received from Federal, State, and local agencies as well as stakeholder groups and the public. No decisions have been made about a final alignment.

Transportation projects require years of advanced planning and development, which is why the county must plan now for the growth it expects in the next 30 years.

This area of Denton County is growing at a rapid pace. With a population of 1.07 million people in 2025, Denton County is projected to grow to 1.88 million people by 2050, according to North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) demographic forecasts for the region. That's an approximately 76% increase in population.

This project will enhance regional mobility and connectivity. The existing roadway network in the study area consists of small rural county roads and Farm-to-Market roads. These roadways were not designed to handle the expected traffic growth and increasing congestion is hampering travel times. As growth and development continue to move north and east in the County, another high-capacity east-west corridor will be needed.

This is an ongoing job and we could stay here until midnight and still not finish what needs to be done. So please be patient and kind to our volunteers.

This is just an example of what might be a normal week at the Crisis Center.

- We have approximately 75 shoppers,
- 10 families needing food or clothes,
- 4 needing financial assistance and,
- 25 knocks at the back door dropping donations.

We are so blessed to be able to do this for the Sanger community. But we would not be able to help as many citizens as we do now, if it wasn't for your donations and generous contributions.

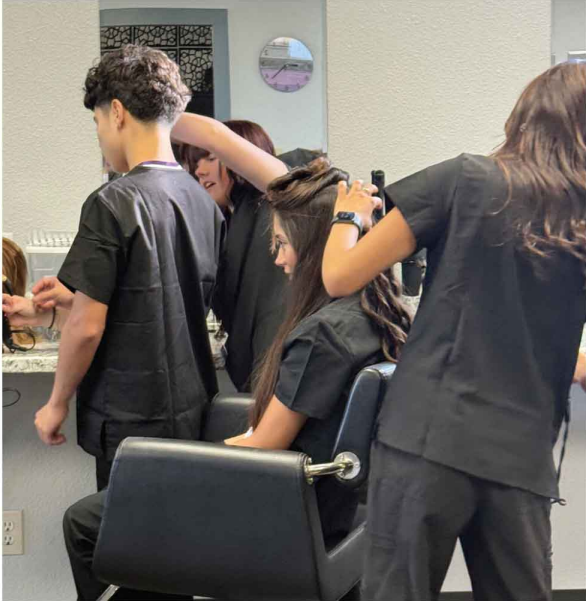

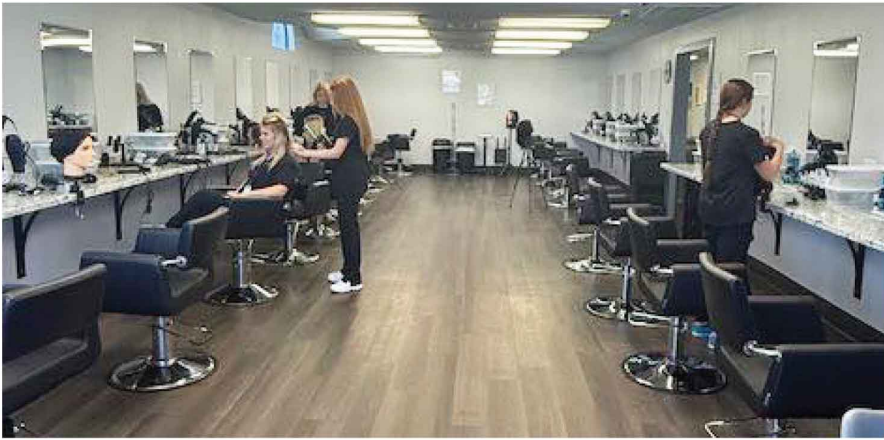

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Indians roll Caddo Mills

Friday night under the lights at Stephen Baker Field at Sanger Indian Stadium, the tribe hosted the Caddo Mills Foxes in a 4A Division II District 5 matchup — and the home team put on a show.

Sanger won the toss and elected to receive, driving deep into Fox territory before a fumble halted the opening drive. But the defense wasted no time making a statement, as Jaise Jackson snagged an interception to give the Indians the ball right back.

After a slow start offensively, the momentum shifted midway through the first quarter when Reggie Jones broke loose for a 40-yard touchdown run to give Sanger a 7-0 lead. Caddo Mills responded with a 30-yard touchdown pass to even things at 7-7, but the Indians answered quickly — this time with Bola punching it in from 10 yards out to reclaim the lead, 14-7, late in the first.

The second quarter brought a defensive showcase for Sanger. After Bola intercepted a Fox pass at the 1-yard line, the Indians marched 99 yards — their longest drive of the season — capped by a 2-yard touchdown run from Austin Martin. The Indians took a 21-7 lead into halftime.

Caddo Mills came out firing to start the second half, cutting the lead to 21-13 before Jaise Jackson blocked the extra point — his second blocked kick of the season. From there, it was all Sanger. The offense exploded, led by the unstoppable Reggie Jones, who found the end zone three more times, including a highlight-reel 89-yard touchdown run. Bola added another rushing touchdown as the Indians rolled to a dominant 49-20 victory.

The Indians' offense was electric, piling up over 600 total yards behind a dominant offensive line that didn't allow a single sack or pressure.

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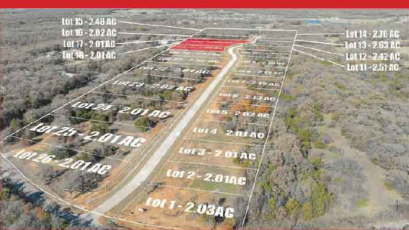
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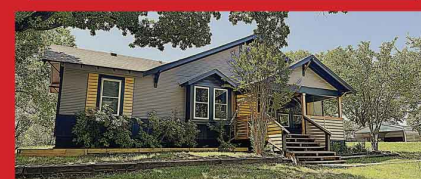
