

Sellabration to be held Downtown on October 30

"Beer Garden" approved from 5:30-7:30 p.m. during live entertainment

The 43rd Annual Sanger Sellabration will be held Saturday, October 30th, in conjunction with SAFE SPOOK. The Sanger Chamber of Commerce combined both events last year, during the pandemic and it was a huge success. Organizers had planned to move the Sellabration to Porter Park this year to expand the event. Organizers would be able to get more vendors, food trucks, entertainment and a "Beer Garden".


The "beer garden" was going to be in the pavilion, but it is illegal to consume alcohol on City property. The Sellabration will remain in downtown Sanger this year with the "Beer Garden" on private property just south of the square, next to Gypsy Cowgirl.

The Chamber went before the City Council on Monday to request a one-day variance permit to Article 4.1000 Alcoholic Beverages, Section 4.1004 (b) Sale Near Daycare Center or Childcare Facility. The Chamber was given permission to have a beer sales vendor located on the vacant lot west of 308 Bolivar Street by the owner of the property. However due to the distance from Guiding Hands Christian Academy (child care facility) located at 416 Bolivar Steet, a tenant of the same property owner, and the vacant lot being 300 feet or less (approximately 185 feet), the chamber requested the one day variance. The event will be held on a Saturday, which the child care facility will be closed to the public.


The Council voted unanimously to give the Chamber the variance. "We are so excited about the 'Beer Garden' during our live entertainment portion of Sanger Sellabration," said Sanger Chamber of Commerce President Kelsi Bannahan. "We have been asked endlessly over the years about incorporating adult beverages into our events and we finally found a way to do so. We had to get creative as we hit a few snags along the way, but we accomplished what our members and business owners asked for.

We as a Chamber know the importance of creating attractive events for our local businesses to gain added exposure as well as tap into tourism by drawing others to our growing town. This is a small step for us, but we will definitely take it!"

The Sellabration is an all day event, but the Chamber will have live music and beer sales from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. Bubba Harper will be on the stage performing during this
