



Message from theCITY MANAGER

Finally, the meteorological summer is over. And we are returning to lower and much more comfortable temperatures. This hotter-than-usual summer put most of the state of Texas under significant drought conditions and has impacted the electrical grid.

On Thursday, August 17th, the City implemented 30-minute rolling blackouts to preserve our systems' integrity and prevent the need to pass excessively high energy rates back to you, our customers.

On August 18th, we issued a notice about the possibility of rolling blackouts for the weekend of August 18 - 20. We sent the notice early on August 18th in response to your request to notify you as soon as possible.

Rolling blackouts is not something that the City likes to do. However, during times of excessive spikes in power usage, they can prevent serious damage to our system, ensuring that we can continue to supply reliable power to our community.

The City issued a precautionary message to the Sanger Electric customers due to the excessive heat and spike in demand combined created the need to be prepared to do one of two things:

1. Enact rolling blackouts of 30 minutes per occurrence to help reduce the strain on our equipment, ensuring that we could provide on-

going reliability electricity to our customers. Or;

2. Do nothing and potentially compromise the integrity of our system, which could have led to a City-wide outage of indeterminate length.

The City has to make decisions that we believe are in the City's best interest as a whole. In this case, should we have needed to do the rolling blackouts, we believe cutting power for 30 minutes would have been the best option for the City of Sanger.

Thankfully, we never hit a point where we had to enact the blackouts.

Our street department has been working hard this summer making needed road repairs.

They just finished some work from Oak to Willow, Wood from 10th to the Service Road, and Church from 7th to 10th Street. As soon as the gas company finishes up its work, we will begin working on 7th Street from Willow to Houston.

We are beginning the contracting for our portion of the utility relocation for the I-35 project. Once all of the utilities are moved, you will begin to see the I-35 construction start.

If you want to stay current on the projects in the City, I invite you to attend our City Council meetings.

I wish you a very happy and cooler beginning to fall.

Buddy was the true viewer favorite from the very beginning, capturing 65% of the nationwide voting and beating out 11 other contestants, most notably Miranda Lambert, by over 2 million votes on the final episode.

He and America have been involved in a love affair ever since. His self-titled Columbia Records debut release landed at #1 on the Billboard Top Country Album charts, was certified GOLD later that same year, and garnered two back-to-back top-five hits with "Sweet Southern Comfort" and "Help Pour Out the Rain (Lacey's Song)"; both tunes are RIAA certified 1 million radio air plays. Buddy has been recognized by the Grammy's, ACM, CMA, ABC Radio Networks, ICMA, ICGMA, and CMT with multiple awards and nominations.

In 2011, he won the International Country Gospel Music Association's "Entertainer of the Year" and "Crossover Artist of the Year" awards. In 2015, he was inducted into the Arkansas Entertainer's Hall of Fame. In 2018, his #1 Christian Country hit, "I'm There," won the ICMA "Song of the Year," and in April 2019, Buddy won ICMA "Male Vocalist of the Year." His talents as a songwriter have garnered him an ICMA #1 for

"When Mama Prayed." Buddy's touching ode to this father, "When I'm Good and Gone," received Grammy consideration for Ricky Skaggs and Sharon White, and in May 2019, Buddy's song, "One in a Row," co-written with Thom McHugh, was released by Randy Travis as his first new song in over six years.

His newest album release (2020), "Bluebonnet Highway," has received much critical acclaim from the likes of Robert K. Oermann, Marty Raybon of Shenandoah, and Patty Loveless. Most notably, the first single, "Teardrop in the Gulf of Mexico, "debuted at #19 on the Bluegrass Today Top 20 Singles Chart, while the album,

"Bluebonnet Highway," reached #20 on RMR's Americana Chart.

Buddy Jewell gives back to his community and beyond on many levels, serving as past spokesperson for The Minnie Pearl Cancer Foundation and Compassion International. He ministers to

inmates at nearby facilities on a regular basis as well. Buddy especially has a heart for children and actively supports several worthy causes, including St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. Buddy has served our nation throughout his career, supporting and entertaining our troops at home and abroad. He traveled with Sergeant Major Kenneth O. Preston on an extensive USO tour to remote forward operating bases on the front lines in Iraq, Kuwait, and Afghanistan.
