Denton County Sheriff Tracy Murphree says Abbott's mask order is contradictory

Denton County Sheriff Tracy Murphree said last week that the sheriff's office will not enforce the new mask mandate issued by Gov. Greg Abbott.

The Governor issued the executive order last Thursday afternoon, mandating people cover their nose and mouth in public in counties with more than 20 COVID-19 cases. Many studies have shown that wearing masks can help reduce the spread of the virus.

Murphree said that the sheriff's office is too busy working other cases, and he also believes the Governor overstepped with the order.

"I don't have the time or manpower to worry about whether people are wearing masks or not," Murphree said. "I believe the Constitution trumps everything, and I believe in personal responsibility."

Murphree said that personally, he will comply with the order, but he

has instructed deputies specifically to not enforce the mask order. He worries that the order "invites chaos."

"Business can require a mask, and people who don't want to wear a mask don't have to go to those businesses," Murphree said. "I think people will rebel and purposefully try to go into establishments without masks. When people are told to do

something that violates their civil rights, it invites chaos and protest."

As far as area town police departments are concerned, education is the first step when it comes to enforcing the mandate.

Murphree posted more details about the mandate on his Facebook page after a petition to oust him stemmed from not enforcing Gov. Greg Abbott's face mask mandate. But, he says the order's contradictory wording is prohibiting him from enforcing it.

"A week ago they were carrying signs that said F the police, and demanding police be defunded. They were ignoring the Denton curfew order and blocked city streets. Now those same people are mad at me for refusing to enforce the mask mandate issued by the Governor. Their hypocrisy is mind blowing. Please read the following taken directly from the order."

Local Guitarist and Evia Music Teacher Doing Virtual Program for Sanger Library

Nik Woods moved to Sanger when he was twelve years old and began taking guitar lessons from Victor Gann when he was thirteen. He continued to study with him until the age of 20, when he moved to California to attend the Musicians Institute in Hollywood. Returning to Texas in 2014, he began teaching at Victor's newly named business, Evia Music, a year later.

All of those years of music study paid off, as demonstrated by his versatility, from "shredding" in his rock band Spank to playing solo Jazz at a wedding. He also enjoys teaching now more than ever. Reflecting on his experiences, he said, "Many musicians like myself don't attend music school to become a teacher, but it is something that I've grown to love over the last five years. I look forward to meeting anyone in the community of Sanger that is curious about learning guitar, or would like to improve their current skills."

His upcoming virtual program for the Sanger Public Library will be streamed on their Facebook page on Saturday, July 11th at 2:00, and will be available for viewing for a month. Nik will demonstrate a few different aspects of guitar playing, including the basics of how strings make a sound and how fingers should be placed on the fret board. He will then demonstrate how to play a simple song, "Smoke on the Water." Chords and scales will also be discussed, and how they are the building blocks of music. He applies all of these musical aspects when practicing and performing, and he stresses their importance in a student's growth as a musician.

Sanger is fortunate to have the Evia Music School in the heart of its downtown square. Its owner, Victor Gann, is an

internationally known guitarist whose songs have been used on many television shows, commercials, and professional leagues such as the NFL, NASCAR, and the NBA. All instructors have either a degree in music or have performed, toured, or recorded professionally. The school currently offers lessons for guitar, bass, ukulele, theory, songwriting, recording, drums, percussion, voice, piano, flute, and clarinet.

- IN COUNTIES WITH 20 OR FEWER CASES WHO OPT OUT BY FILING WITH TDEM
- CHILDREN 10 YEARS OR YOUNGER
- INDIVIDUALS WITH HEALTH CONDITIONS
- WHILE CONSUMING FOOD OR DRINK
- WHILE EXERCISING OUTDOORS
- WHILE SWIMMING
- AT VOTING LOCATIONS
- AT RELIGIOUS SERVICES

'Local law enforcement and other local officials, as appropriate, can and should enforce this executive order, Executive Order GA-28, and other effective executive orders, as well as local restrictions that are consistent with this executive order and other effective executive orders. But no

law enforcement or other official may detain, arrest, or confine in jail any person for a violation of this executive order or for related non-violent, non-felony offenses that are predicated on a violation of this executive order; provided, however, that any official with authority to enforce this

executive order may act to enforce trespassing laws and remove violators at the request of a business establishment or other property owner.'

"This is an executive order not a law. Only the legislature can make law. So the accusations that

Alton installed the first typesetting equipment that allowed his newspapers to be composed for the new offset method of printing.

While Alton and Wanda were living in Sanger, their son, Kevin, was born on January 3, 1963. Because of the long hours in the newspaper business, Alton sold the newspapers shortly after Kevin's birth, and the Kites moved to

Gainesville, Texas, where Alton began teaching at Cooke County College, now North Central Texas College, while earning an M.S. in Business from the University of North Texas in Denton, Texas. During this time, Alton was also in the residential construction business. He taught accounting and business law at North Central Texas College for 30 years, retiring in 1999. Alton was a member of the First United Methodist Church in



Gainesville, Texas.

Alton is described by friends, former students, and colleagues as a kind, honorable, humble, compassionate person, and a true gentleman in every

I'm refusing to enforce the law are not true. See where it says."

"Local law enforcement and other local officials, as appropriate, can and should enforce this executive order."

"Nowhere does it say 'shall'. The Governor is a former Attorney General - he knows the difference in can and should vs. shall in the legal world. Now this line - 'But no law enforcement or other official may detain, arrest, or confine in jail any person for a violation of this executive order.' "Once again the Governor knows what detain means. If I stop you for speeding you are detained, if I stop you on the street for littering you are detained. Even if I'm just issuing a warning. So according to the order I am not allowed to detain you for not wearing a mask. So I can't even stop you and talk to you about not wearing a mask, I can't tell you to come with me while we discuss your failure to wear a mask. I certainly can't arrest you or put you in jail. There is no way to know who has had a warning and who hasn't. If you tell me you have a medical condition I can't ask for proof. The order is not a law, there is no requirement that any police officer enforce it, and it's unenforceable. We can't spend our time running from place to place for calls about mask, we can really do nothing about. Like I said I will comply because I want to comply. I won't and I don't believe I can take any enforcement action on this order. I do believe I have sworn to uphold the constitution and I will do so."


Here's a little scenario for you. Mr. Smith is not wearing a mask in violation of the order. I'm called and I confront Mr. Smith. I tell Mr. Smith he's getting a ticket and I need to see his identification. Mr. Smith is now detained and not free to go. I have now violated the same order I'm accusing him of violating. Let's say I write Mr. Smith a ticket. Mr. Smith then doesn't show up for court and doesn't pay his fine. Now the judge issues a warrant for Mr. Smith. Now what do I do? A warrant says you shall arrest Mr. Smith, but the order forbids me from arresting or jailing Mr. Smith. Now



Regional road and bridge updates

FM 2181 North-South – A \$37.6 million project to widen FM 2181 from two lanes to a six-lane divided roadway from the Denton/Corinth city limits to Lillian Miller Parkway is expected to be complete in November 2021. Activities expected include City of Denton water lines, storm water drainage lines and culverts; lime treatment subgrade;

concrete removal; SW3P activities; barricades; general clean-up.

U.S. 380/U.S. 377 – (Loop 288 to U.S. 377) – Frontier is splicing and Oncor relocations should be complete by mid-June. The project let on June 4, 2020. Apparent low bidder is Ragle Construction, Inc. with a low bid of \$21,269,536.66, at 33.15% over the engineer's estimate. There are 800 working days and 39 months of barricades.

U.S. 380 East – (U.S. 377 to Collin County line) – Utility coordination meeting held virtually on May 28, 2020.

U.S. 377 North –Ongoing property owner contacts are being made as follow-up to e-mail comments generated from the virtual public meeting. TxDOT provided 60% review comments on April 23, 2020. TNP addressed TxDOT comments and submitted 95% schematic on May 24, 2020.

U.S. 380 Feasibility Study –NCTCOG and TxDOT met on June 2, 2020, to discuss. NCTCOG to run additional models for different integrated corridor alignments and concurred with TxDOT's alignment alternatives.

FM 428 – Project is from Loop 288 to West Sherman Drive/proposed outer loop. TxDOT is negotiating with HDR to initiate efforts on the FM 428 feasibility study as a separate work authorization. TxDOT met

with NCTCOG to discuss alternative alignments.

FM 1385 – The preliminary drainage report was submitted to TxDOT for review on May 28, 2020. The 30% schematic is underway and expected to be submitted to TxDOT on June 23, 2020.

FM 2931 – Aerial survey was received in late May 2020. The 30% schematic is underway and is scheduled to be submitted to TxDOT on June 19, 2020. Virtual public meeting is scheduled for July 7, 2020. Meeting materials will be posted on http://www.keeppitmovingdallas.com/FM2931.

FM 455 – From west of FM 2450 to east of Marion Road; the project is slated to have 100% plans ready in September 2020 with a January 2022 let date. Received approval of bridge submittal on June 11, 2020. Profile updates are in progress; consultant is updating retaining wall location and drainage to match ultimate design location. Consultant continues adjusting roadway profile to take drainage runoff to the roadway, adjusting driveway profiles based on roadway profile adjustments, checking driveway grades and tie-in points, and evaluating driveways for retaining walls.


Consultant is coordinating with commercial property owner on FM 455 to adjust driveway to allow large delivery trucks access; this will require adjusting culvert headwall. Consultant and TxDOT to meet for Traffic Control Plan review on June 18, 2020. Anticipate submittal of 95% plan in mid-July 2020. Consultant submitted revised Railroad Exhibit A for approval on May 27, 2020. Utility coordinating meeting to be held on June 23, 2020.

I-35 at FM 455 – Estimated cost of reconstruction of approximately 4,500 feet of I-35 over FM 455 is projected at \$27,231,547 with a let date of August 2022. Received approval of bridge submittal on June 11, 2020. Profile updates are in progress; consultant is updating retaining wall location and drainage to match ultimate design location. Consultant and TxDOT Dallas District to meet for Traffic Control Plan review on June 18, 2020. Anticipate 95% plan set submittal in mid-July 2020. Utility relocation coordinating meeting to be held on June 23, 2020.

I-35 North (Segments 1 and 2) – The project from U.S. 377 to FM 3002 is projected to cost \$573,740,000 with a ready to let date of October 2022 and a let date of December 2022. TxDOT has reviewed plan set and provided comments to consultant.

I-35E/Mayhill – This \$62.2 million project to reconstruct the interchange

Texas High School Coaches Association in-person convention canceled



The Texas High School Coaches Association decided that it would not be best to bring several thousand coaches and administrators together in person as coronavirus numbers continue to spike in Texas.

Two days after the state reported a record high of 8,258 new COVID-19 cases, the THSCA announced that it has canceled its in-person convention and coaching school and that the event will be held virtually only.

Sanger High School head football coach Rocky Smart said Tuesday, he and his staff were set to go to the convention, but now will have to participate virtually.

The THSCA had previously stated on its website that it was expecting 7,500 coaches, athletic administrators and exhibitors to attend July 19-21 at the Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center in San Antonio. But the pandemic continues to worsen, and last week Gov. Greg Abbott ordered Texans to wear face masks in public and gave local officials power to restrict outdoor gatherings with more than 10 people.

"As an association, we just felt like it was in the best interest of everyone to

go virtual," said THSCA president Rodney Webb, the football coach at Denton Guyer. "There were a lot of coaches that were electing not to be there in person. There were a lot of districts that are not allowing any kind of travel — educational, athletics — of any kind. To make it the best possible experience, it was best to go all virtual."

This will be the first time that the annual event will be held virtually. The THSCA had already been planning to make it possible to take part virtually for those who weren't comfortable attending in person because of the pandemic, but now there will be only one way to participate.

"This is an enormous disappointment and not a decision we have taken lightly," the THSCA said in a statement on its website. "THSCA's Coaching School and Convention is the biggest event of the year for the association, and it is our favorite way to celebrate high school coaches from all over the state with educational lectures, fellowship, and many other events. It was a tough call to make, but in our efforts to support the preventative protocols set forth by our Texas school

administrators, the UIL Executive Staff and governing authorities at both state and local levels, we are choosing to prioritize health and safety first."

The UIL had planned for July 20-21 to be days on which its schools could not hold summer strength and conditioning and sport-specific workouts. But the THSCA and UIL both said Monday that schools can now hold workouts on those days, and the coaching school agenda has been updated to allow for coaches to take part in those workouts.

"We will still host Coaching School, July 19-21, but have intentionally consolidated the content to the afternoon each day, in an effort to help coaches balance valuable time with athletes and an opportunity to obtain skills and knowledge through coaches education," the THSCA said in the message on its website.

Prominent football coaches Ed Orgeron of national champion LSU, Lincoln Riley of Oklahoma and Dave Aranda of Baylor were among the many guest speakers who were scheduled to attend. Webb said the THSCA is still planning to have all of the original speakers.

"There is going to be some really innovative stuff," Webb said. "From a content standpoint, it's going to be as good as it was in person. We are still going to have speakers still talking live. It's not going to be prerecorded."

"We're excited about the prospect of it still being a very viable, informative convention. We're optimistic that we're going to get a ton of participation. We're going to make it really conventional for coaches to plug in."

Last week, the Texas Girls Coaches Associa-

tion canceled the in-person portion of its summer clinic that had been scheduled for this week, Monday through Thursday in Arlington. Member coaches can still access the TGCA's virtual clinic July 15 through Aug. 31 for staff development.

UPDATE ON SANGER CAMPS:

Coach Smart said Tuesday, the annual football camp is up in the air. "I have zero information on if the guidelines that were set for camps will change where we can have one. I don't anticipate a 1-6th grade football camp happening this summer as of today, but hopeful that could change."

SHS is doing champions camp during July for male athletes and football players 7-12th grade. The girls are going to start back later in July.



at Mayhill and I-35E is projected to begin in June 2022. The 95% plans are underway and are expected in July 2020; the 95% plan set will incorporate traffic and final survey. Level A SUE north of Mayhill and south of Loop 288 is underway and is expected to be complete in June 2020.

I-35E / 35E / 35W Merge – Consultant addressed comments and submitted second draft of pre-30% plans on May 26, 2020. The 30% plans were submitted on June 5, 2020. TxDOT to discuss aesthetics with City of Denton. For U.S. 380 bridge, the District has decided to utilize 18'6" clearance on main lanes and turn-arounds since U.S. 380 is a truck route. Level B SUE data collection is complete for -090, and consultant is reviewing.

I-35E/Loop 288/Brinker/Mayhill – This \$27.5 million project was expected to be completed in June 2020. TxDOT is working to complete the punch list.

I-35E/US 77/Dallas Drive Interim Improvements – TxDOT to review possibility of design and construction to address safety concerns at I-35E exit to Dallas Drive, the northbound I-35E service road where it crosses the northbound exit ramp, and the southbound lanes of Dallas Drive.

I-35E/Dobbs/Lake Sharon – This project involves reconstruction of the interchange and existing frontage roads. TxDOT held a pre-scoping meeting for the project the first week of June 2020.

County road and bridge updates

Arvin Hill Road Project US 377 to Red Mesa – Red Mesa to New Hope construction completed. New Hope to US 377 scheduled completion September 2020.

U.S. 377/Stewart/Arvin Hill Intersection Improvements – Preconstruction meeting held. Notice to Proceed will be issued on July 6, 2020 and scheduled completion in November 2020.

Rockhill Road/Arvin Hill Road Project Red Mesa to UP RR – Revisions to 100% plans for USACE comments underway. Utility relocation coordination ongoing.

Sam Bass Road Project - FM 455 North of Nance Road – Construction started. Estimated completion November 2020.

Pecan Valley Road Culvert Replacement – Construction started. Estimated completion May 2020.

Hackberry Creek Park Road Project – Construction request and mitigation plan submitted to USACE.

Lois Road West Culvert Replacement – Survey and Engineering study ongoing.

Rector Road West Culvert – Construction completed and road now open.

Hickory Creek Road Street Lights – Oncor has completed installation of street lights. Project completed.

Indian Trail Improvements – Engineering underway. Estimate 100% plans and bid package October 2020.

Mayhill Road –

Punch-list items continue to be addressed for water, sanitary sewer, streets, and drainage. Sodding, striping, and minor work continues.

Dallas North Tollway, Extension 4B – NTTA continues making minor revisions to plans. NTTA anticipates advertising the project in July 2020, with bid opening in August and approval of construction contract in September. Anticipate start of construction in October or November 2020, with a two-year construction timeframe.

Lake Sharon Extension – Corinth held pre-construction meeting

with Wildstone on June 10, 2020. Construction recommenced on June 15, 2020.

Sam Bass Road – From FM 455 to approximately 500 feet north of Nance Road, this estimated \$3.5 million project will be rebuilt as a two-lane rural road and realign the intersection with FM 455. Current activities include headwall construction. Embankment and lime stabilization scheduled for next month.

Shady Shores Road – An estimated \$10 million in STBG funds have been allocated for this project. TxDOT has drafted a fund-

ing agreement. Consultant submitted scope for review. ITS has reviewed and provided feedback.


