



Funeral Service was held Friday, April 19, 2024 at Pilgrims Way Baptist Church in Sanger.





During his flying career, Van flew many different aircraft including the P-47 Thunderbolt, P-51 Mustang, DC-10, and Boeing 747s. In 1984, Captain Van retired at the age of 60 after 30 years with American Airlines. Van retained his pilot's license until the age of 80 as flying was truly his passion and hobby. He enjoyed social organizations such as the Grey Eagles and Quiet Birdmen.


AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANGER, DENTON COUNTY, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CITY OF SANGER CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER13 UTILITIES, ARTICLE 13.2200 WATER CONSERVATION AND DROUGHT CONTINGENCY PLAN, SECTION 13.2201 PLAN, TO AMEND THE WATER CONSERVATION, AND DROUGHT CONTINGENCY PLAN; PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING A SERVERABILITY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR NO CULPABLE MENTAL STATE BEING REQUIRED FOR CONVICTION; DECLARING ADOPTION OCCURRING AT A MEETING OPEN TO THE PUBLIC; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. SECTION 3. Any person, firm, or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this article shall be quality of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fines in an amount not to exceed the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) for each offense, and each and every day such offense shall continue shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense. PASSED AND APPROVED by the City Council of the City of Sanger, Texas, on this 15th day of April, 2024.

CITY OF SANGER, TEXAS ORDINANCE NO. 04-06-24

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SANGER TEXAS, TO IMPOSE AN ADDITIONAL PENALTY FOR COLLECTION COSTS; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CON-FLICT; PROVIDING A CUMULATIVE CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. SECTION 1. There shall be imposed on delinquent property taxes and future delinquent PID assessments that become due or are delinquent on the dates described in 33.07, 33.08 and 33.11, Texas Property Tax Code, in the amount of compensation specified in the most recent contract entered into under 6.30, Texas Property Tax Code by the City of Sanger, with Mc-Creary, Veselka, Bragg & Allen, P.C. for the collection of delinquent property taxes and delinquent PID assessments. Sanger's softball team clinched the district championship last week over Burkburnett. The victory helped the No. 15-ranked Lady Indians (27-5, 8-0 in district) wrap up an undefeated District 7-4A title, ahead of second-place Burkburnett (25-9, 6-2).

Sanger last won an outright district championship in 2014. The Lady Indians also shared a district title with Krum in 2015 and reached Round 4 of the playoffs for a second straight year during that campaign but had been unable to return to those heights in recent years.

"We've been working the entire time from when my seniors were freshmen," head coach Toby Kloewer said. "They're getting to that point where they're starting to believe that, 'Hey, it's not like we're chasing the good teams. We're right there with the good teams.' I'm so proud of them for how much work they've put in on all this stuff and getting after it."

Kloewer's daughter, Leala, has been a key part of Sanger's upswing over the last few years. The junior earned All-Area Best of the Rest honors for her freshman season in 2022, then made some key contributions late in the 2023 season after an injury kept her sidelined for a sizable chunk of the season.

Kloewer has put up career numbers thus far in 2024 with 177 strikeouts and a 1.18 ERA in 89 innings pitched as the Lady Indians' primary option in the circle.

She delivered another strong outing last Friday, striking out 14 while allowing four hits, four walks and one unearned run across a complete-game effort.
