Sanger woman pleaded guilty to manslaughter

A Sanger woman set to be tried for murder for her husband Jeffrey McBride's shooting death instead pleaded guilty to manslaughter on Friday, according to the Denton Record-Chronicle article that was published earlier this week.

Amber Rosales, 32, accepted a plea deal of five years in prison for the lesser offense of second-degree felony manslaughter.

Had Rosales gone forward with a trial, she could have faced 5 to 99 years or life in prison. Manslaughter has a punishment range of 2 to 20 years.

Her defense attorney, Caroline Simone, said a jury would

not have been allowed to consider manslaughter in lieu of a murder conviction had Rosales gone to trial.

During a docket call Friday, Simone said Kailey Gillman, a special prosecutor from Collin County, brought a new deal to the table. Rosales rejected it.



Then, Simone said, Gillman returned with five years for a manslaughter plea.

"There are things we could put on as the defense team that we believe are strong pieces of evidence and would be powerful to a jury, but there's always some risk [with a trial]." Simone said. "It's one of those offers that's just too good to refuse with the type of risk, especially on a murder charge."

Denton police responded to a shooting in the 1100 block of East Sherman Drive on April 25, 2022.

McBride was found unconscious in the driver's seat of a vehicle. He had a gunshot wound to the abdomen.

Rosales was in the vehicle at the time and allegedly told police a man approached the truck, shooting McBride and causing the truck to crash. Police said surveillance footage showed no one ap-

The prosecution of

The Denton County brought in Gillman, a chief felony prosecutor for the Collin County District Attorney's Office, as a special prosecutor.

Gillman prosecuted the case due to conflicts of interest, Jamie Beck, the first assistant district attorney for the Denton County District Attorney's Office, said in a 2023 interview.

Denton County prosecutors interviewed Rosales as a victim and had her testify as a victim in a prior case.

There was further potential conflict of interest because the Denton County District Attorney's Office previously prosecuted McBride. He went to trial for the offense of murder and argued self-defense. After a mistrial due to a hung jury, he pleaded guilty to criminally negligent homicide and received a two-year sentence.

Simone said she respected the Denton County DA's Office for acknowledging the potential conflict from the start of

Family, Simone said, was the reason Rosales decided to plead guilty when offered the final plea deal.

"She's particularly concerned about her son. He's young, and knowing that there is an end in sight is particularly motivating to take that type of deal," Simone said. "And, Jeff was the love of her life. So, to avoid putting his family as well as her family through trial was also a factor."

Katy McBride, Jeffrey McBride's sister, painted a different picture of the

Jeffrey had not known Rosales for long before they got married on April

21, 2022, four days before his death, Katy Mc-Bride told the Denton Record-Chronicle in May

In a statement Tuesday. Katy McBride said again that her family believed Rosales was abusive toward Jeffrey.

"Jeff was a sweet, kind-hearted person who loved people hard and was the unfortunate target of an abuser," Katy McBride said. "... Men are victims of domestic violence, too, and love shouldn't hurt."

McBride said she encourages anyone who is experiencing domestic violence to reach out to local resources such as Denton County Friends of the Family.

"A prison sentence will never bring him back to those who love him. His absence brought heartbreak that will never heal," she wrote. "We were robbed of a brother, son, uncle, nephew, cousin and friend because of the reckless behavior of one individual.'

McBride said that her family doesn't feel that the length of the sentence Rosales received is adequate and that there was a mountain of evidence against Rosales. But her family doesn't think there is any amount of time that would have felt like justice, she added.

Nonetheless, the Mc-Bride family chose to trust the Collin County DA's Office's discretion, Mc-Bride said, and the plea deal solidified Rosales'

"We knew that a manslaughter conviction would ensure that Miss Rosales would serve some time, making her a convicted felon of a violent charge. ... We're thankful for the hard work of the Collin County [DA's] Office and their ability to ensure a conviction here. We are especially grateful to the Denton Police Department for the extensive investigation that led to this conviction," McBride said.

"We will let the Florida courts decide how to proceed with her other pending charges," Bride said of Rosales.

Rosales was on probation when she was arrested in relation to Jeffrey Mc-Bride's death.


Rosales received an adjudicated sentence from a Bay County, Florida, judge for one count of deadly conduct and one count of making a false report of sexual battery involving a law enforcement officer.

She was allowed to return to Texas to live with family in January 2022, according to Bay County court records.

Being arrested for the offense of murder, police records say, was a violation of the conditions of her probation and reopened the cases. Rosales remained in

the Denton County Jail as of Tuesday evening.


She was very career-oriented working for corporate as well as non-profit organizations. She cared very deeply for


her girls to provide the life she wanted them to have. Her support as they grew was paramount in helping shape the women they have become today. She will be deeply missed by all whose lives she touched.
