Because of you, the Sanger Education Foundation Annual Gala raised \$99,427, less than \$600.00 from the \$100,000.00 goal. The event is still receiving donations from supporters wishing to assist in several ways. During the Call to Action at the conclusion of the evening, attendees were asked to support three instructional programs. The Culinary Arts Career and Technical

Program, the Audio Visual Career and Technical Program and the Space Academy Instructional Program.

Through an Instructional Grant in 2019, a retired school bus was converted into a state of the art Culinary Food Truck. The Grant award was for \$20,000 which began the retrofitting of the bus into "Old #6". At the gala, Amy Giddens, noted that

not only was the culinary arts program at the high school doubling in size, an additional teacher was being hired and a Barbeque Competition Team had been created, needing sponsorship. The BBQ Teams all need sponsorships for competitions.

Next attendees were brought up to date on a \$10,000.00 Audio Visual Instructional Grant in partnership with the debut of

the DATCU partnership providing a new electronic scoreboard at Indian Stadium. The scoreboard provided a working platform for students studying Audio Visual, Production and photography to showcase their skills and build real life, hands on working experience since the scoreboard production is entirely student driven. Area business sponsor their business ads to be played and enjoyed during activities held at Indian Stadium. SHS Audio Visual Director, Shawn Rowe

noted that the program was also growing and additional Professional grade equipment and software to be used in the creation of student lead production was very much needed to keep up with the number of students wanting to explore a career in the field of Audio Visual since students are involved in every aspect of several class and small group audio, video, and film style production projects with emphasis on TV studio broadcasting and news production projects.

Lastly, Brandie Kitchens who spoke on behalf of herself and the two other Science Teachers at Clear Creek Intermediate reported on their recent Instructional Grant award resulting in their attendance and the training they received from NASA SPACE CAMP for Educators resulting in a newly formed "ROCKET CLUB". In order to create the Rocket Club, the teachers themselves were at first supplying all the supplies needed for the Rocket Club
