COVID-19: Texas Motor Speedway immunizing tens of thousands

Denton County hosted its largest COVID-19 vaccine clinic yet on Tuesday at Texas Motor Speedway, immunizing thousands and marking the beginning of a partnership county officials say could be scaled even further.

The first of three to be hosted this week at TMS, Tuesday's clinic utilized about 400 total staff and volunteers. Denton County Public Health allocated 10,000 vaccines out of the state's 32,475-dose shipment to the clinic, and all doses administered Tuesday were of the Moderna shot, with 500 of those specifically set aside for people receiving their second dose.

The speedway's 131-acre parking lot was set up with 16 drive-thru lanes. Recipients remained in their vehicles as they were guided through four stations: check-in, screening for health conditions or potential adverse reactions to the shot, the vaccination itself, and an area where

vaccine recipients waited for 15-30 minutes in case of reactions. For most, the entire process took anywhere from 30 minutes to an hour.

Two other clinics will be held Thursday and Friday at the speedway, vaccinating a similar number in order to use up the week's allocation from the state. While county officials did not have specifics on the future of the partnership, DCPH Director Matt Richardson said the department is likely to return to the speedway, adding that the site could be scaled even further than Tuesday's goal of 10,000 vaccinations.

The clinic began at 7:30 a.m., and DCPH spokesperson Jennifer Rainey stated at about 12:20 p.m. that the county had administered 5,150 doses. The last appointment was set for 4:30 p.m., with the clinic closing at 5 p.m.

Richardson deemed the clinics, which have

been vaccinating more residents each week on the back of growing allocations from the state, the "light at the end of the pandemic tunnel." Denton County Judge Andy Eads has referred to the TMS setup as the largest drive-thru clinic in the state, though Dallas County announced Tuesday morning that it will adapt its Fair Park hub to a drive-thru model, making it capable of vaccinating up to 12,000 per day.

"The ability to vaccinate 10,000 individuals in one day is a monumental task," stated Dr. Matt Richardson, Director of DCPH. "We are thankful for the support from Texas Motor Speedway, various cities generously providing additional staffing, and staff from multiple Denton County departments working in unison to provide mass vaccination to our community."

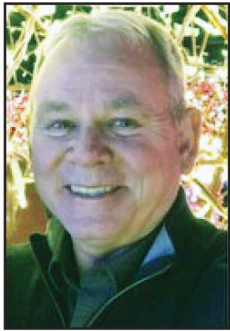

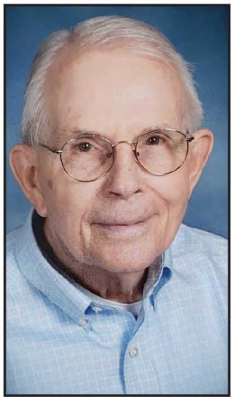

35W at Texas 114, Texas Motor Speedway was the logical choice for the massive clinic with its 131-acre parking footprint. Last summer Texas Motor Speedway hosted more than 30 graduation ceremonies for seniors across North Texas.

"Texas Motor Speedway is honored to be working again with Judge Eads and his staff to provide Denton County residents with a safe, efficient and convenient location for these vital COVID-19 vaccinations," said Texas Motor Speedway President and General Manager Eddie Gossage. "The goal for the incredible scale of these clinics is to get as many North Texans vaccinated as quickly as possible which, in turn, will eventually allow everyone to safely open back up as soon as possible."

Community members in tiers 1A and 1B can sign up for a waitlist to receive the COVID-19 vaccine on the Denton County Vaccine Interest Portal at [DentonCounty.gov/COVID19vaccine](https://www.dentoncounty.gov/COVID19vaccine). As of Jan. 31, 2021, a total of 160,233 residents were on the waitlist.

Volunteers also are needed for future clinics. Anyone interested should join the Medical Reserve Corps at <https://www.dentoncounty.gov/758/Medical-Reserve-Corps>. Each volunteer will receive a one-hour online training course and undergo a background check.



Bi-district playoff game in limbo, Uphill Summit Academy may forfeit

Lady Indians on course to meet Dallas Pinkston in second-round

The Lady Indians basketball team won their district with an 11-1 record. It's the first district title since the 2010-2011 season. They are 18-5 overall and ranked no. 25 in the state by TGCA State Poll in Class 4A. Bi-district playoff games will be played Feb. 11-13 all across the state, but Sanger may not have a first-round playoff contest. Uphill Summit International Academy may not be able to play the game. The team has been hit with Covid-19. They have some players out this week, but are expecting them back Feb. 11. The Academy may forfeit since they won't have time for practice, but Sanger head coach Derek Hilliard said he is willing to work with them to get the game in. "Our girls have worked hard for this and deserve to play in bi-district." If Uphill ends up forfeiting, Sanger will advance to the second round (Area). Hilliard was willing to play the fifth place team from the 10-4A district, but only four teams competed in that district this season, so that isn't an option to get the game in.

Luckily, Sanger has a practice playoff game scheduled for Tuesday, Feb. 9 at 6pm at Poolville (17-3, 9-2).

Tickets can be purchased at the door.

Sanger and Dallas Pinkston (ranked no. 24) are on a course to meet each other in the second-round of the playoffs. Pinkston has knocked Sanger out of the playoffs the last two seasons. Sunnyvale (21-1) and Brownsboro (21-1) are ranked no. 6 and 7 in the state, respectively, and they are the top teams in the region, on paper. The Lady Indians are hitting on all cylinders and are primed for a long run this post season. They are right in the mix of beating any team they face in Region II. Kennedale most likely will be the third-round opponent, if Sanger beats Pinkston.

Because of the pandemic, there won't be a regional tournament. Teams that advance to the fourth and fifth rounds (regional semifinal and final) will have to agree on site for those games to be played. As well as the 6th round (state semifinal). The UIL is only hosting state championship games in San Antonio this year in both boys and girls.

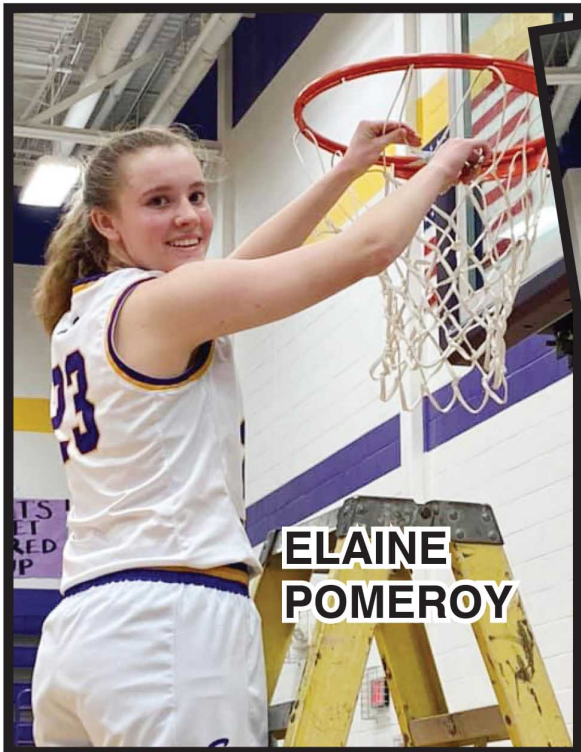

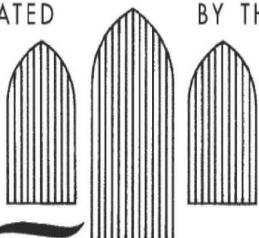

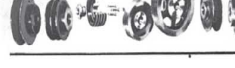
