Sellabration and Safe Spook this Saturday

Organizers of the 92nd annual North Texas Fair and Rodeo proved an event can be held during the pandemic. The fair had 43,253 visitors for the nine-day event.

NTSF Executive Director Glen Carlton said it was important to have it, because if you cancel altogether, when you start back up you're starting from scratch. "Events like

this lose momentum if you cancel, so we already got a head start on next year."

As for that next year, Carlton said the fair may keep some of the changes in the way it used video boards, but that for the most part he's hoping to return to the way it's been held in the past. "We're ready for normal again," Carlton said. "I think a lot of people are."

It's important for people to support the Sanger Sellabration and Safe Spook on Saturday, as well. DATCU and GLENN POLK are hosting the 42nd Sanger Sellabration on Saturday, October 31 from 8 a.m. - 4 p.m. The annual Sellabration was postponed in September because of the pandemic, but will bring a new Halloween theme this year with a Spooktacular Downtown Square. The Sanger Area Chamber of Commerce is doubling up this year, combining their two biggest events. Safe Spook will be from 2-4 p.m. and the Little Mr. and Miss Costume Contest will be held from 1-2 p.m.

All day, there will be craft and food vendors and a fun zone. Also a petting zoo. In the afternoon there will be a cake walk every 15 minutes starting at 2:15 p.m.

On election day, Tuesday, November 23 will be a little more tricky, because you have to vote at your assigned precinct. In Sanger, there are now four precincts, which means there are four locations to vote in Sanger on Nov. 3. To find your precinct number, go to Voter Lookup on vote.denton.com.

After recording their first loss of the season against first place Aubrey, the Sanger Indians got back on track against Krum last Friday night by using a 21-point second quarter to secure the victory.

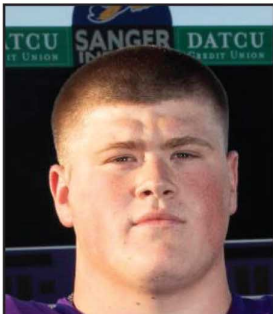
The Indians finished the night with 443 total yards on offense with 297 of those




