New law raises Social Security income for some



Until recently, if you received a pension from a job that did not pay into Social Security and you've also worked in a job that did, your Social Security benefits at retirement were reduced based on your pension income.

As of Jan. 5, 2025. that's no longer the case, thanks to the Social Security Fairness Act. Now, you'll receive both your pension and your fully earned Social Security benefits because the Act repealed the Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP).

This new law also repealed the Government Pension Offset (GPO) provision which had reduced spousal or survivor Social Security benefits for people employed in government jobs. These benefits will be increased in 2025.

PLAYOFF BOUND.... SHS baseball earns top seed

Sanger jumped out to an early lead and held off Gainesville's rally attempt for a 6-3 win last Tuesday to clinch District 9-4A's top seed for the 4A Division II playoff bracket.

With its seed for the program's fourth straight playoff berth officially secured, Sanger (17-10, 8-3 in district) also locked in a matchup with fellow Denton-area squad Aubrey (15-13, 6-5) in this week's bi-district round.

The Indians earned that opportunity behind a strong showing in 9-4A play aside from three losses to perennial power Celina, which is ranked among the top 10 4A teams in the state by both Texas High School Baseball and the THSBCA.

Sanger notched two of its biggest district wins in completing a season sweep of Van Alstyne with victories by 5-2 and 8-2 margins.

Martinez finished off the latest victory with two perfect innings of work on the mound in relief of Kade Phillips, who allowed just two walks through the first four innings before Gainesville's big bottom of the fifth.

The Indians got out to their early lead behind a trio of first-inning RBI singles by Levi Hendricks, Luke Hendricks and Riley Tarwater. They added one more run in the third when Luke Hendricks scored on a passed ball.
