The store and home of his Great Grandfather still stand today in Forestburg. Merwyn graduated Forestburg High School as class President in 1948. After serving Sanger for 15 years as "The Telephone Man", with the help of Ken Cornel and other builders, Merwyn started Tucker Electric and Tucker's Cabinet Shop, serving Sanger for over 40 years until retiring at age 79. Merwyn also served the City of Sanger as a member of the Sanger Volunteer Fire Department for 40 years, 17 years of which he was the Fire Chief until retiring in 1992. Merwyn was also the City of Sanger Electrical Inspector for 20 years. Merwyn is a Mason, active for many years, and a member of the Bolivar Lodge. Merwyn enjoyed life, camping, fishing, hunting, traveling, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and all of their fur babies throughout the years.

Merwyn is survived by his wife of 55 years, Polly Ann (Tipton) Tucker, marrying on 15 April 1966 in Ardmore, Oklahoma. 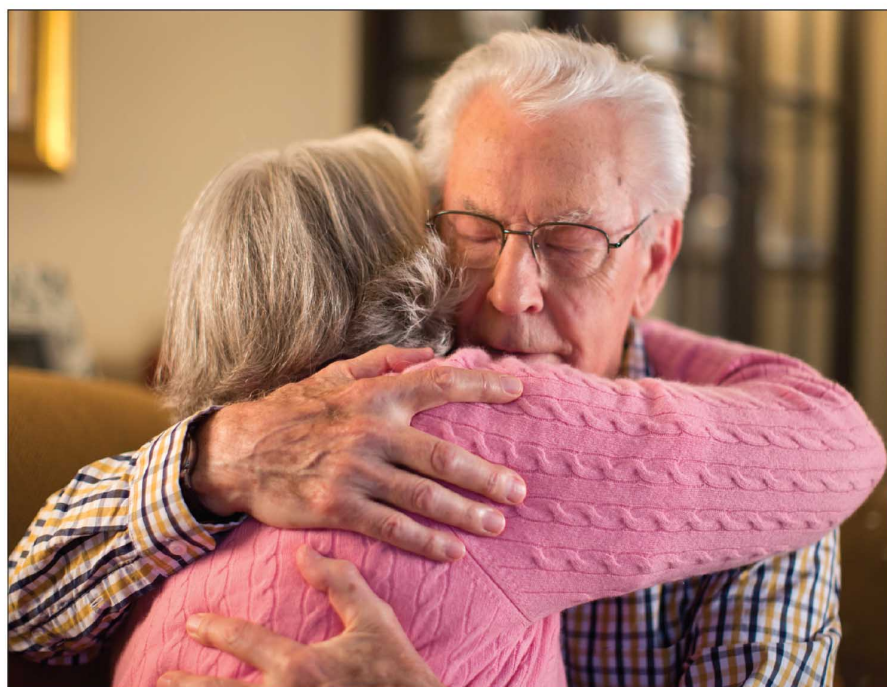

Is Roth IRA better for young workers?

If you're in the early stages of your career, you're probably not thinking much about retirement. Nonetheless, it's never too soon to start preparing for it, as time may be your most valuable asset. So, you may want to consider retirement savings vehicles, one of which is an IRA. Depending on your income, you might have the choice between a traditional IRA and a Roth IRA. Which is better for you?

There's no one correct answer for everyone. But the more you know about the two IRAs, the more confident you'll be when choosing one.

First of all, the IRAs share some similarities. You can fund either one with many types of investments – stocks, bonds, mutual funds and so on. And the contribution limit is also the same – you can put in up to \$6,000 a year. (Those older than 50 can put in an additional \$1,000.) If you earn over a certain amount, though, your ability to contribute to a Roth IRA is reduced. In 2021, you can put in the full \$6,000 if your modified adjusted gross income (MAGI) is less than \$125,000 and you're sin-

gle, or \$198,000 if you're married and file jointly. The amount you can contribute gradually declines, and is eventually limited, at higher income levels.

But the two IRAs differ greatly in how they are taxed. Traditional IRA contributions are typically tax-deductible (subject to income limitations), and any earnings growth is tax-deferred, with taxes due when you take withdrawals. With a Roth IRA, though, your contributions are never tax-deductible – instead, you contribute after-tax dollars. Any earnings growth is tax-free when withdrawn, provided you've had your account at least five years and you don't take withdrawals until you're at least 59½.

So, which IRA should you choose? You'll have to weigh the respective benefits of both types. But when you're young, you may have particularly compelling reasons to choose a Roth IRA. Given that you're at an early point in your career, you may be in a lower tax bracket now than you will be during retirement, making the tax-deduction of traditional IRA contributions less beneficial. So, it may make sense to contribute to a Roth IRA now and take tax-free withdrawals when you're retired.

Also, a Roth IRA offers more flexibility. With a traditional IRA, you could face an early withdrawal penalty, in addition to taxes, if you take money out before you're 59½. But with a Roth, you'll face no penalty on withdrawals from the money you contributed (not your earnings), and you've already paid the taxes, so you could use the money for any purpose, such as making a down payment on a home. Nonetheless, you may still want to be cautious about tapping into your IRA for your spending needs before you retire, since IRAs are designed to provide retirement income.

If your income level permits you to select a Roth or traditional IRA, you may want to consult with your tax advisor for help in making your choice. But in any case, try to max out on your IRA contributions each year. You could spend two or three decades in retirement – and your IRA can be a valuable resource to help you enjoy those years.

SHS football starts practice Aug. 2nd

The Indians varsity football team is coming off an 8-2 season and a play-off appearance. They are primed for a repeat performance in 2021 and a deep playoff run.

SHS starts football practice on Monday August 2nd. They will practice in helmets only on Monday and Tuesday. Then on Wednesday and Thursday they are allowed by the UIL to wear shoulder pads. Friday, August 6th is the first day they can practice with full pads. The high school will practice in the morning each day.

Head coach Rocky Smart helped orchestrate a massive turnaround last year. The Indians eventually fell to Iowa Park 34-20 in the bi-district round.

Sanger has plenty of talent coming back. Starting quarterback Rylan Smart is back for his senior season and will be tasked with leading Sanger's offense. Rylan, the son of head coach Rocky, threw

for 2,075 yards and 17 touchdowns last season. He also added 313 yards and nine scores on the ground.

On offense, the Indians return the following starters: WR Ben Turnbow, WR Chandler Bowland, WR Dewey Terreault, OL Hayden Rodgers, OL Victor Macias, OL Jyrese Jones, QB Rylan Smart.

Other top contributors returning on offense from last season are RB/WR Steven Bush, OL Abel Gonzales, WR Autstin Shackelford, and WR Jimi Dutson.

"We look for sev-

eral varsity newcomers to make a contribution. Some specific names that might contribute are WR Kollin Shumate and OL Javier Zuniga. We also feel transfers Colby Lewis and Logan Lewis will contribute on offense," said coach Smart.

The Lewis brothers both started for Valley View the last two seasons, including the Eagles state semifinal run in 2019.

On defense Sanger return the following starters: DB Steven Bush, DB Kyle Watts, DB/LB Dewey Terreault, DL Victor Macias, DL Jyrese Jones.

Other top contributors on defense from last season that return are DL Hayden Rodgers, LB CJ Flowers, and DB Ben Turnbow.

Coach Smart looks for several other varsity returners and varsity newcomers to make a contribution on defense this year. 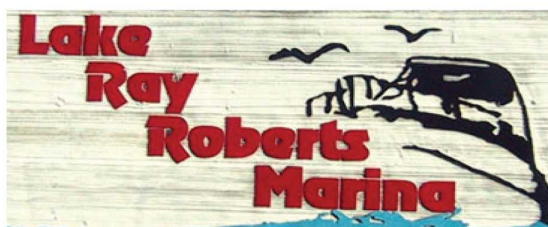
