
Second City of Sanger Comprehensive Plan Meeting held



sible with his grandsons Ethan and Evan. He was an amazing husband, father, grandfather and friend.


Jack is preceded in death by his parents, his sisters Dorothy and Treecia, and his brothers Donald (Slim) and Roy (Red).
