Bond meetings to be held

Last year, Sanger ISD convened a Long-Range Facilities Planning Committee composed of 38 citizens from across the district. These volunteers spent months learning about school finance, facilities, assessments, tax impact data, demographic projections and more.

What this committee found was Sanger ISD is growing rapidly. The district is projected to increase by almost 40% within 10 years, resulting in over 1,000 new students in classrooms by 2032.

With this growth in mind, the Long-Range Facilities Planning Committee has recommended a Sanger ISD 2022 bond that includes a new high school, new athletic annex, new agricultural science facility and additions/renovations to existing buildings, increasing their capacity and security. The bond was presented to the Sanger ISD school board on February 7th, and the board unanimously approved the call for an election.

The bond totals \$130,000,000, with the projected tax impact on a \$100,000 home to be \$25 per month. Early voting is April 25-May 3, and Election Day is Saturday, May 7.

Sanger ISD family, did you know that the district is growing rapidly?

Over the next 10 years, student population is projected to increase nearly 40%. That's over 1,000 new students in classrooms! Home sales within the district have more than tripled in the last decade, and there are currently more than 5,500 planned future lots in seven future subdivisions within Sanger.



Quick Trip plans to build at the corner of FM 455 W. and I-35, on the property where Super Save and Burrus Supermarket were in business for nearly 40 years. The company has filed for a proposed highway sign. Last year, Super Save closed and the building was demolished because of the FM 455 and I-35 TxDOT highway expansions. Super Save lost several feet of Right of Way in the front parking lot and where the loading dock was, forcing them to go out of business.

The City of Sanger City Council will conduct a public hearing on Monday, April 4, 2022 at 7:00 P.M. for the purpose of considering A request for a variance from Chapter 3 Building Regulations - Article 3.1400 Sign Regulations Section 3.1407.b.2.A to allow a variance from the minimum setback of 15 feet and to al-

low for a setback of 1 foot. The proposed sign will be located at 701 N Stemmons.

- The hearing will be held in the Historic Church Building at 403 N 7th St, Sanger, Texas.

Properties within 200 feet of the subject property were notified of the request pursuant to the Texas Local Government Code. The QuikTrip Corporation, more commonly known as QuikTrip, is an American chain of convenience stores and fuel stops based in Tulsa, Oklahoma that primarily operates in the Midwestern, Southern, and Southeastern United States as well as in Arizona.

All four fuel stops at I-35 and FM 455 have closed - Snap Shop, Chevron, Shell and Chicken Express Conoco. Chevron (Convenience Store) and Chicken Express restaurants remain open.

While impressive, these accomplishments were not what Jonell held important. Her passion and her true devotion, second only to her love and devotion to God and Jesus Christ, was to her husband of 63 years, Truman; her two sons, James and Danny; later to her two “daughters” who she adored, Jayn and Karen; and to her grandchildren and great-grandchildren. 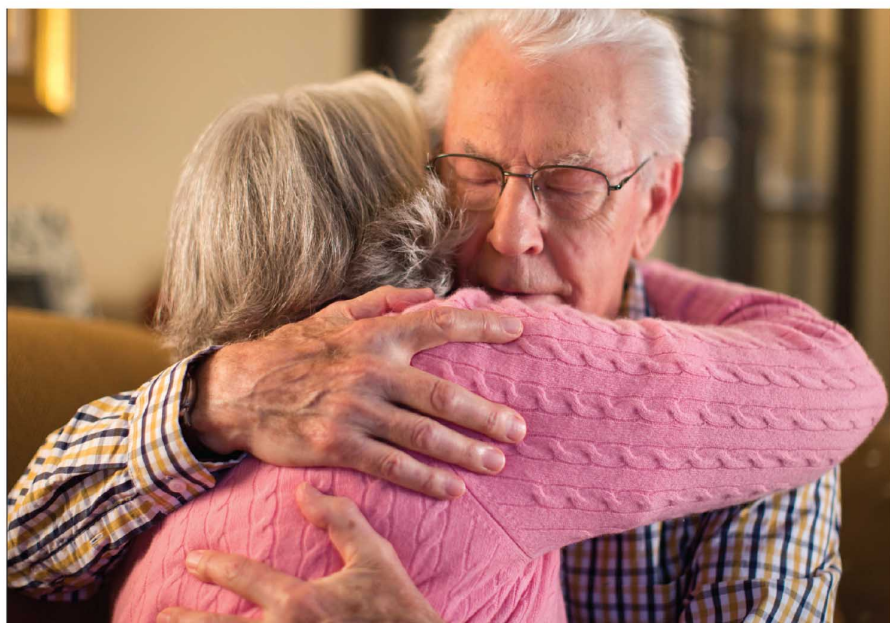

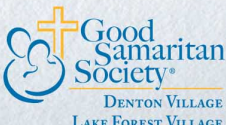

Financial FOCUS

We all hope for long, healthy lives. But there's a serious "side effect" of longevity – the possibility of outliving our money. How can you help prevent this?

It's useful to know the seriousness of the threat. Consider this: About 41% of all U.S. homes in which the head of the household is between 35 and 64 are projected to run short of money in retirement, according to the Employee Benefit Research Institute.

While this statistic indicates a cause for concern, it certainly doesn't mean that you are necessarily headed for trouble – because there's a lot you can do to help build and manage enough resources to last a lifetime. Here are a few suggestions:

Consider your estimated longevity. On average, a 65-year-old man can expect to live another 17 years, while a 65-year-old woman can anticipate about 20 years, according to the Centers for Disease Control. Of course, you'll want to take into account your health and family history of longevity to arrive at a reasonable estimate. You can then use this figure to help determine how much money you'll even-

tually need. To play it safe, you might even want to try to build an income stream that can last beyond your estimated lifespan, possibly up to age 90.

Don't overlook health care costs. When budgeting for retirement, allow enough for your health care expenses, which can be considerable. Even with Medicare, you can expect to spend anywhere from \$4,500 to \$6,500 per year, per person, for traditional medical costs. Also, you may want to prepare for two to three years of long-term care expenses, which currently range from about \$50,000 per year for home health care to over \$100,000 per year for a private room in a nursing home.

Keep building assets for retirement. While you're working, constantly try to put away as much money as possible for your retirement years. Each year your salary goes up, increase your contributions to your 401(k) or similar employer-sponsored retirement plan. You may also want to contribute to an IRA, depending on your goals. And within your retirement savings, make sure you devote a reasonable percentage of your investment dollars to growth-oriented vehicles that align with your goals and risk tolerance.

Seek out sources of guaranteed income. As a

retiree, you will receive Social Security benefits – and the longer you wait before claiming them, the bigger your monthly checks will be. But you might also consider investments that can provide a source of income you can't outlive, such as annuities.

Revisit your strategy before you retire. As you near retirement, you may want to review your investment strategy, possibly adjusting your risk level so that your portfolio would be somewhat less susceptible to market volatility. This is also a good time to review your spending needs in retirement.

Maintain a reasonable withdrawal rate. Once you are retired, you'll likely need to start withdrawing from your 401(k), IRA and other investment accounts. To avoid taking out too much money too early in your retirement, you'll need to set a reasonable, sustainable withdrawal rate based on your assets, age and retirement lifestyle. A financial advisor can help you determine an appropriate rate.

It will take dedication and determination to help ensure your money doesn't run out during your lifetime. But you'd probably agree that it's well worth the effort.
