# Sanger ISD bond passes, Muir wins Mayor's race

The Sanger General Election was held Saturday May, 7, 2022. The 130 million dollar Sanger ISD Bond passed 57.34% (949 for) to 42.66% (706 against). Around 1,200 people voted early and it was 69% for and 31% against before Saturday's final voting day. Just over 400 people voted Saturday. A total of 1,655 residents filled out their ballots for the bond.

Incumbent Mayor Thomas Muir won against Jeffrey W. Jarecke. Muir totaled 486 votes (66.94%) to Jarecke's 240 votes (33.06%). The voter turnout isn't as high for the City election, because only residents inside the city limits can vote. Incumbents Gary Bilyeu and Allen Chick were unopposed for City Council.

The only race for Sanger ISD school board was Jesse Hunter and Debbie Reaves. Hunter won with 988 votes and Reaves totaled 453. Incumbent Lisa Cody didn't have an opponent as did newcomer Bruce Elsey, who's filling Dr. Dale Gleason's vacant seat. Both, Gleason and Ken Scribner didn't run for re-election. School board members will be sworn in on Monday.

### Georgia Lois Sanders Windle

April 25, 1927 - February 2, 2022

Georgia Lois Sanders Windle, known by many names over the course of her long and full life--"Lois," "Mom," "Nonnie," "Auntie," to name a few--passed away in Denton, Texas on February 2, 2022 at 94 years old.

Lois was born, along with a twin brother who died in infancy, to Patrick Riley Sanders and Lillie Virginia Fulgham Sanders on their family farm in Clay County, Texas on April 25, 1927. Lois was the fourth of five surviving children; she had two brothers and two sisters with whom she remained close throughout her lifetime.

Lois attended school at Midway ISD in Clay County, where she nursed big dreams of leaving farm life behind. In high school, she met and fell in love with the young man who would ultimately take her away from the farm and with whom she would spend 75 years of her life. She and Ray D. Windle married at a young age and remained together from 1944 until his death on January 7, 2020 at the age of 91.

Lois and Ray had two children: Larry Doyle, who died as an infant in 1945, and Donald Ray, born in 1948, the couple's sole surviving child.

While Ray pursued his interests in electronics and communications, Lois pursued her own interests in real estate, antiques, and interior design. She was an active member of the International Women's Club of Dallas for many years, where she developed several long-time friendships. She was also a skilled hostess, which was enormously helpful to Ray as he established his company. Together, Lois and Ray renovated, remodeled, and built at least 10 different houses and lived in places as varied as Texas, Illinois, Arkansas, New Mexico, and California. Ray's business sent them all over the world, and the former farm girl visited Japan, Australia, Germany, United Kingdom, and many cities across the U.S.

One of Lois's favorite roles was that of "Nonnie" to her beloved granddaughters, Beth and Amy. Lois was an active and involved grandmother, and she became known as "Nonnie" to many of Beth and Amy's friends, whom she hosted at numerous parties, sleepovers, and afternoons in the pool. She also enjoyed maintaining close relationships with her extended family through holiday gatherings and frequent phone calls. She especially loved long phone conversations with her nephews Bob and Mike.

In her final years, with vision and hearing failing, Lois and her family had the immeasurable benefit of the compassionate care of Helen Kamau, whose dedicated service was above and beyond the call of duty. Helen brought Lois great comfort. Another close companion was Diane Hail, who never failed to keep Lois entertained with conversation, good food, and laughter.

Lois was the sole survivor of her generation and some who followed. She was predeceased by her spouse Ray D. Windle (2020), son Larry D. Windle (1945), daughter in law Dr. Ann S. Windle (2001), granddaughter Amy Rebecca Windle (2011), as well as her parents, brothers, sisters and their spouses, and five of her nieces and nephews.

Lois is survived by one son, Judge Don R. # ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

## SHANI BRADSHAW

Meet Shani Bradshaw, Director of Economic Development, Sanger, TX.

Shani was born in Nocona, and raised in Euless, Texas, then home of the Trinity Trojans! Like most Texans, she loves her high school and all things football. Shani grew up in what most people of today would consider a fantasy world. An only child, she was very close to her parents (who were married for 40 years) and her extended family.

Being very much a daddy's girl and somewhat of a tomboy, Shani grew up playing softball, riding motorcycles, and camping and fishing with her parents nearly every weekend. She proudly admits she learned to gut a fish on one such camping trip! Her love for sports and the outdoors doesn't stop there; during her high school years, she took up Rodeo Barrel Racing and, to this day, enjoys running to get her exercise and calm her mind.

After graduating high school, Mrs. Bradshaw attended Texas Women's College, where she studied Marketing. Later she attended the University of Oklahoma Economic Development Institute. She noted that her "first big-girl job" was working in the Accounting Department of Bass Enterprises. A few years into the job, she was promoted to Executive Assistant. Her venture into working for a city and, ultimately, Economic Development came about almost accidentally.

Her father-in-law was the first to plant the seed for her to work in public service. At the age of 23, Shani applied for and got a position in Utility Billing with the City of South Lake. In just two years, she had worked her way up to being Director of Utility Billing having four staff members reporting to her.

In 2003, Shani had her first child, Hunter. Hunter had some medical issues, so in 2004, Shani decided to take a step back from work to take care of her child. Once Hunter was better, a little over a year later, Shani decided it was time to return to work.

Shani decided to explore opportunities with the City of Justin. She was offered a position in marketing and events. A few years later, she was asked to take the Economic Development Director position. Initially, she turned it down, but after some reconsideration and the fact she was already covering a portion of the role, she decided she would take the job.

While working for the City of Justin, Shani continued to keep herself busy outside of her day job. The center of her world, both then and now, is her two boys, Hunter and Tanner. Both boys, at a very young age, played soccer and hockey. Tanner first stepped on the ice at age four, and both boys continued to play throughout high school.

In addition to the boys keeping her busy, Shani worked as a volunteer firefighter and certified EMT. She even worked as an EMT for the Texas Motor Speedway. But as her



Economic Development position grew more demanding and the boys' sports took up more and more time with traveling, Shani knew she had to give up something. So, after seven years, she turned in her pager, letting go of the volunteer work, and focused on ED and her boys.

In 2017, after being diagnosed with uterine cancer, Shani's life came crashing down around her. Shani said, "The hardest part was the two months after diagnosis. The time when you are going through all the unknowns and thinking only the worst possible outcome." "My first thought was my boys. How could I leave them?"

Shani was one of the lucky ones. They caught her cancer early. She told me, "It really makes you stop and look at things differently. The problems you used to think were impossible to overcome didn't seem nearly as important." So, she did begin to look at life differently.

One of the first things she looked at was her career. She had spent 10 ½ years in Justin. She loved ED, but things were changing in Justin, and for Shani, it was time to move on.

In her search for new opportunities, she came across a posting for Director of Economic Development for the City of Sanger. She had always loved Sanger, she had ties here, and she felt drawn to the Downtown. In August of this year, Shani will celebrate four years with the City.



I asked her what she loved and the challenges of the position. "I love the people and the

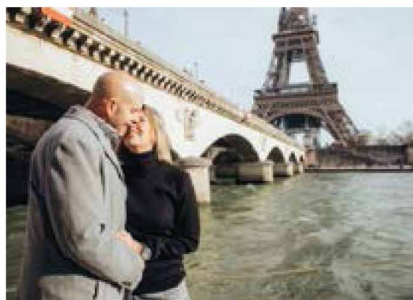
networking. It is great to meet so many people and help bring about the future of this great town," she said. "The challenge is in the perception. People think that we can snap our fingers and bring any business we want at any time. The reality is that Economic Development is a long-drawn-out process. It can take two to three years for a company to decide to locate here. It is rewarding when it happens. By the time we get to talk about it, we have been working on the project for a long time."



What's next for Shani? She plans to continue living as if she were dying. She and her husband James love to travel. Recently they visited Greece and Paris and frequently travel to Mexico. Together, they plan to continue to explore the world.

Additionally, they love to go to concerts. Shani has a broad love of music but feels most connected to the music of the 80s. Motley Crue is coming to Dallas soon. She and James will have seats up close.

As for her career plans? Shani says that one day she hopes to retire. She says, "Retirement is out there somewhere, but I don't expect it for another 10-15 years. As long as I continue to love what I am doing, I want to keep doing it."

## The Watch Dog

Every property owner will receive 30 days to file protest on property taxes

*"Every property owner will receive 30 days to file a protest. So even if you did not receive your NAV until June 2nd, you would still receive 30 days and have a deadline of July 2nd. The mailing date does not matter, everyone will get 30 days."*

My obsession with teaching Texas property owners how to protest your property taxes began in 2011 when my county appraisal district debuted online protesting. One Saturday night, in a matter of minutes, I entered my ideal home value, and the computer accepted it.

I called it "The Price Is Right," and I won.

Phase two began in 2017 when I launched my "Everybody File a Protest" campaign. I even created a flag to support my little revolution.

As I explained, "Appraisal districts will be overwhelmed with workloads like never before. There's nothing wrong with this. It's your legal right as a Texan to file a protest every year, even if your taxes don't go up, and even if your school taxes are frozen because you're a senior or disabled."

"Overload the system like never before, and in return, appraisers would have to settle cases in greater numbers than ever to clear their calendar by the state's July deadline."

I know it worked because Denton County Chief Appraiser Rudy Durham blamed me in 2019 for his problems.

"There's a consumer watchdog that is encouraging people to file a protest," he complained. "He wants to mess up the system and shut it down and prove a point."

Here now comes Phase 3 of my Watchdog Nation revolution. With the help of Glenn Goodrich of PropertyTax.io (which helps predict your chance of protest success), we unveil a new plan.

One part is to use open records to request

from the appraisal district its evidence they plan to use against you ahead of time.

The other part is making it possible for you to win your protest without showing up for the hearing. Sound good?

**You can miss your hearing**

Let's start with you protesting without showing up. Many tax fighters can't make hearings because of work or family responsibilities. Property owners sign up to protest but don't show up. But if you fill out an affidavit, get it notarized and mail it in, certified with a return receipt so you know they received it, they have to honor it. A hearing will be held, but you don't need to be there.

You can find the form on the state comptroller's website by searching for "Property Owner's Affidavit of Evidence." But you don't even need to send the form as long as you offer all the information it requests in a letter, get it notarized and send to the Appraisal Review Board.

Information sought includes: property address and owner, account number, property description, phone and email, date and time of scheduled hearing and information on whether the owner will attend the hearing. You also outline your case for lowering your appraisal and submit evidence. This way you can skip your hearing, but your evidence is still considered.

If you do use the form, check the top box on Page 2 where it says, "I do not intend to appear at the hearing in person, by telephone conference call or by videoconference."

This affidavit and the evidence and/or argument submitted with it may be used at the hearing if I do not appear in person at the hearing."

You can also change your mind and let them know you plan to appear.

And make sure when it asks for "Reasons for Protest" you check "Other."

**Knock out their evidence against you**

The second strategy takes advantage of the confusion and work overload appraisal districts endure, especially if everybody files a protest.

According to the rules of this process, no evidence may be presented at a hearing by either the county appraiser or by you if this evidence isn't shown to the other side.

What kind of evidence? Photos, comparable properties, repair estimates. They are supposed to see what you have, and you should see what they have. They can see yours at a hearing or in the affidavit described above. (You produce five copies — three for ARB members, one for the appraiser and one for you.)

Their evidence against you, on the other hand, can't wait for the hearing. The district must produce your evidence before your hearing. It arrives via mail, email or through the district's website.

But they only have to give it to you if you ask for it.

Here's the important part. If they fail to provide the evidence ahead of time, they can't use it at the hearing. And appraisal districts are often not set up to easily distribute the information in a timely way. This is a sensitive pressure point, and you take advantage of it.

As Goodrich explains, "I would advise anyone to make the 14-

Let's change that.

You can only get your evidence if you file a protest by the protest deadline, 30 days after you receive your blue-colored appraisal notice.

To request evidence, you write a letter to the appraisal district asking for any evidence they will present in your ARB hearing. Mail this letter certified so you can prove that you requested the evidence at least 14 days prior to your ARB hearing date.

Producing evidence ahead of time is time-consuming. Glenn says the reason ARB hearings sometimes run long and waiting room time is

lengthy is because they don't prepare evidence ahead of time and just wing it during the hearing.

So, to summarize, you fill out a "Property Owner's Affidavit of Evidence" to serve as your substitute so you don't have to attend your hearing. And you send a request for evidence to be used against you 14 days or earlier before your hearing.

Imagine hundreds of thousands of protesters following these two tips.

Your appraisal district likely didn't highlight these for you. The Watchdog did.
