Ida was the mother to four children;





Henry Louis Sestak December 16, 1944 - May 8, 2019

There are some people in this world whose memory will not fade with the passing of time. These individuals impact the world so profoundly that their memory echoes as a reminder to those of us still living that there is a higher standard to which we should strive.

Henry Louis Sestak gave to all who knew him a re-

markable example of a Catholic life welllived. He was ardently devoted to the Latin Mass and to the Holy Rosary, which he prayed multiple times each day for his family and for the Souls in Purgatory. In gratitude to the work of Archbishop Lefebvre, Henry remained committed to the apostolate of the Society of St. Pius X. His Catholic Faith defined every aspect of his life, and he transmitted this Faith to his children from an early age, teaching them the Baltimore Catechism on his knee every Sunday.



Born in Oklahoma on December 16, 1944 to Otto and Josephine Sestak, Henry and his brother, Charlie, grew up on an old haunted farm in Prague – a small city to which Czech immigrants migrated, naming it after their beloved capital of the Czech Republic.

Henry met his wife, Ruth, at church on Sunday and it was 'love at first sight.' He sent her red roses which Ruth received on the final day of her novena to St. Theresa. Ruth's prayer to find a good Catholic husband was answered and they were married on May 22, 1976. Henry loved Ruth deeply. Throughout their 44 years of marriage they were the best of friends, wholly devoted to each other and to the service of God.

He was immensely proud of his six children—Allison, Michael, Patrick, David, Eric, and Maria—and his twenty-three grandchildren, whom he loved more than life itself. He had memorized each of their birthdays and never failed to send best wishes and gifts to each child.

Henry's work ethic was unrivaled. The majority of his life was spent rising before dawn to begin his workday. Henry loved his career as a Systems Analyst and he devoted over 28 years to Bank of America. The example of Henry's consistent dedication to duty will be forever emulated by his children. He was a proud U.S. veteran and loved his country immensely.

Henry's life was filled with both joyous and funny moments. Every year, he would write his famous Christmas Letter filled with humorous musings on life and the accomplishments of his children. His two greatest hobbies were tennis and fishing, especially when enjoyed with family. His intense love of reading was realized in his management of the church bookstore. He was a softie and was quick to show emotion. Nothing would make the waterworks start flowing faster than the song Seven Spanish Angels by Willie Nelson. He loved camping with his boys and was quick to remind everyone of his Indian title, Chief Make'm Lost. At night, Henry loved to sit by the fire and tell stories of Bigfoot, leprechauns, and his haunted childhood farm. The seriousness with which he told these stories made his listeners believe them to be true. He loved to go to bed early every night since he "had to be up in a couple of hours." Asleep in his favorite La-Z-Boy chair, Henry would participate in the conversation in-between his snores. He could sit for hours working on jigsaw puzzles, especially when he was working side-by-side with his grandchildren.

Henry did not fear death. His only concern was how his wife and children would go through life alone. He prepared himself to meet God with a conscience deserving of a heavenly reward.

Henry L. Sestak, age 74, passed away on Wednesday, May 8th, 2019, in Denton, Texas, surrounded by his family during the recitation of the Holy Rosary. He received Last Rites and the Apostolic Blessing by Fr. Thomas Asher, SSPX, and died wearing his scapular, with his Rosary tightly clenched in his fist. All three Sanger High School boys state qualifiers finished a very respectabe fourth place at the UIL State Track & Field State Championship this past weekend. Senior Hank Lemons performed first on Saturday morning at 8 a.m. He went from sixth place to third place with his fifth attempt (21-11.25). Lemons could taste bronze, but on the next to last jump in the entire competition knocked him down to fourth. Justice Clemons of Sweeny moved from fourth to second ⁴) on his sixth and last jump (22-03.75). Lemons was the eighth seed going in the event and improved four spots. On Saturday afternoon,

Crandall ends SHS baseball season

Sanger only managed four hits in the first game of the area-championships best-of-three series on Friday evening at John Paul II High School in Plano.

In Game 1, Sanger used three pitchers in an attempt to keep its two district starters usable for Games 2 and 3, but Crandall settled in and found a rhythm, resulting in four runs over the fifth and sixth innings.

A home run by Erik Ly lifted the Indians to within one in the fourth, and a Cade Hamilton sacrifice fly trimmed the deficit to 4-2 in the sixth.

Cade Hamilton, usually Sanger's catcher, held off the potent Pirates early, allowing only two hits and two earned runs in four innings.

Hamilton starting a playoff game was not something Ford envisioned before the season, but injuries and circumstances threw the team for a loop time after time.

"The plan was for [Hamilton] to pitch three innings, and he did and he pitched well," Ford said. "It's just the way it goes. Our motto this year was 'next man up,' and that's what had to happen. They were willing to do whatever they had to do to win all season — just like they did tonight. This just didn't work out, but I'm blessed to be a part of this year."

Hamilton, an all-district third baseman moved to catcher when Brock Howard had surgery on his foot at the beginning of district play. Howard was an all-district catcher.

Ly, Hagen Coin, Hamilton, and Tallyn Welborn each collected one hit to lead Sanger.

Both teams had left-handers on the mound to start Game 2, and the Pirates stormed to a 6-3 lead through two innings.

"[Pitcher Trent White] did what he's done all year for us — force ground balls and pop-ups — but we made a couple mistakes behind him and also weren't in position for some of them," Ford said.

The Indians (12-13-1, 6-4 district) trimmed the deficit to 6-5 in the top of the fourth before Crandall rebounded quickly, posting two runs in the bottom of the inning to take an 8-5 lead. In the bottom of the sixth, the Pirates added three more runs for insurance.

Caleb Freeman, Coin, Zach Shepard, Riley Blagg, and Welborn each managed one hit.

Sanger finished in second place in the district and will lose seniors Caleb Freeman, Erik Ly, Cade Hamilton, Brock Howard, Hagen Coin, Grayson Rutledge and Trent White.


