City is committed to Sanger Senior Center

A plan is in place to address conditions of the building

Members of the Sanger Senior Center are worried their deteriorating building in downtown Sanger will be condemned. They have posted signs that read “SAVE OUR CENTER”. The rear of the building was closed until repairs can be made. A meeting was held Thursday, May 25 at 10:30 a.m. Sanger’s Parks & Rec, as well as City Manager John Noblitt, were on hand to give brief recap of preliminary findings on the building. The Center’s building was donated to the City of Sanger by the Sullivan Family and any Sanger citizens over the age of 50 can use the facility.

The City is committed to providing a home for Senior Services to the community. The City of Sanger released a statement early this week:

“Concerns were brought to current City staff earlier this year regarding the condition of the Sullivan Senior Center. The City took the expressed concerns seriously and has since taken the necessary steps to determine a maintenance plan for the building and establish a best go-forward plan.

In early March, the City contracted the engineering and architecture firm Halff Inc. for an assessment of the condition of the roof. During its evaluation, Halff engineers determined that the roof and ceiling framing needed to be replaced. Addi-

tionally, they recommended that the rear of the building remain closed for all purposes, except limited storage, until the roof and ceiling framing are replaced. No immediate concerns were noted regarding asbestos. However, the engineer report suggests that the old ceiling tiles be tested before moving forward on any repairs to the roof and ceiling framing.

City Manager John Noblitt requested a meeting with Senior Center members to address their concerns. During the May 25th meeting, Mr. Noblitt recapped the efforts to date to address the conditions of the building.

The City further tasked the engineers to provide a detailed scope of work for the repairs

Herbert Lee Griffin

September 12, 1945 - May 21, 2023

Herbert Lee Griffin, Jr., 78, of Sanger, Texas, passed away on Sunday, May 21, 2023, in Denton, Texas.

Born in Memphis, Tennessee on September 12, 1945, Lee was the third child of Herbert Lee Griffin, Sr. and Audrey Gwendolyn (Riddick) Griffin. On August 23, 1971, he married Margaret Janice Spratt, at Eielson Air Force Base in Fairbanks, AK. They made their home in Alaska for the next fifty years.

Lee graduated from Nicholas Blackwell High School in Bartlett, Tennessee in 1963. He then attended Memphis State University, where he completed ROTC training and received a bachelor's degree in Industrial Technology in 1968. Lee immediately reported for service in the U.S. Air Force, where he served on active duty for over 12 years, rising to the rank of Captain. His first duty assignment was to Korat, Thailand. He also served at England AFB in Louisiana, and at a remote base in Turkey. However, he was an Alaskan at heart and spent the majority of his time at Eielson AFB near Fairbanks, Alaska.

As an Air Force Reserve officer, Lee served several years as the Civil Air Patrol liaison in charge of cadet training in Fairbanks. He completely retired from the Air Force in 1991, and promptly joined the Alaska Air National Guard, where he served until his retirement at the rank of Tech Sergeant in 1996.

Lee earned his A&P license in 1982, which allowed him to devote even more time to his great love of all things aviation.

In 1982, Lee joined the Federal Civil Service as an Industrial Engineering Technician at Ft. Wainwright in Fairbanks. Most of this phase of his career was in the Environmental Office, where he supervised hazardous material site cleanup and spill mitigation. He retired in 2016 with the rating of Environmental Scientist after 34 years of service.

Lee served on the Board of Directors of the Pioneer Air Museum at Pioneer Park in Fairbanks, and was a longtime member of the Experimental Aircraft Association. In 2021, the FAA awarded Lee the Wright Brothers Master Pilot Award in recognition of his over 50 years of outstanding service to civil aviation.



Lee loved Alaska, and anything relating to airplanes. He spent five years restoring a North American T28 and decades flying his Citabria, on wheels, skis, and floats. He loved flying around Alaska, and often ferried friends to remote hunting and fishing areas.

Lee was a twenty-three year esophageal cancer survivor, in no small part due to the care and treatment he received at M. D. Anderson Hospital in Houston, TX.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one sister, Charlene Chapman. He is survived by his wife of 52 years, Jan Griffin of Sanger; one sister, Sharon Bell of Bullard, Texas, brother-in-law Joe Spratt of Sanger, seven nieces, and two nephews.

Lee will be laid to rest at 2:30 pm on Wednesday, June 7, 2023, at Fort Richardson National Cemetery in Anchorage, AK.

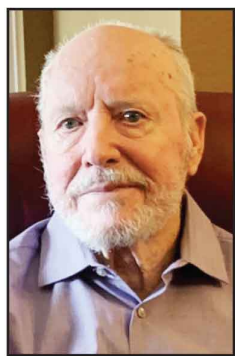

Meet the City of Sanger Economic Development Director

Shani Bradshaw joined the City of Sanger in August 2018. As the Director of Economic Development, she is responsible for leading the City's economic development efforts to expand the property and sales tax base, encourage the creation of jobs, improve quality of life, and facilitate a self-sustaining economy for the community.

We took the EDC week as an opportunity to sit with Shani and ask her a couple of questions.

How long have you worked in economic development?

I've been in Economic Development for 10 ½ years, and I have a total of 25 years in municipal government.

What is your favorite thing about working in economic development?

I love everything about this profession! I love seeing projects come to life, working with our business community and partners, and learning and adapting to new challenges as an Economic Developer.
