Sanger Farmers Market opens this weekend

Saturday, March 18th will begin the first day of the 2023 farmer market season in Sanger. The market, which was approved by City Council on December 5, 2022, will be located at Stephen Baker Field next to Linda Tutt Learning Center off of the I-35 Service Road. Preparations for the market began after its approval: reaching out to potential vendors, becoming a Certified Farmers Market with the Texas Department of Agriculture, filling in potholes in the parking lot. The most recent has included leveling the ground from years of erosion. Although this project has proved to be the most difficult with the constant rain.

Nevertheless, 30 vendors have been accepted into the market since applications have been open in January; and 28 will begin selling on Opening Weekend. Of those 30 vendors that have been accepted, 15 of them are Sanger residents and the remaining


are from surrounding cities including Valley View, Denton, Ponder, and Aubrey to name a few.

Downtown Sanger Farmers' Market, or DSFM for short, will have a variety of different vendors on both Saturday and Sunday. There is a very diverse amount of food producers that range from cookies, produce, french macarons, gluten free baked goods, authentic Mexican salsas, pecans, microgreens, a selection of nut butters, simple syrups, breads, soft pretzels, canned goods including jams and peppers, as well as seasonings and meats. Along with food there will be vendors that are selling plants, mealworms (great for chicken feed and fertilizer!), soaps and body scrubs, body products (like deodorant and body balm), chain-mail jewelry, crocheted goodies, quilts, pottery and cutting boards.

In addition to these vendors Texas Farm Bureau will have their mobile learning barn there on both Saturday and Sunday. The mobile learning barn is an interactive trailer that teaches about Texas crops, livestock and their by-products.

Downtown Sanger Farmers' Market will be open the first and third weekends of the month. Saturday's they are open from 8-12 and Sunday from 9-1. In the instance of severe weather any delays or closings will be posted on the Facebook or instagram page an hour prior to the event. If you would like to sell any of your goods you can apply at www.dsfarmersmarket.com. Make sure to stop by and support all of the local producers, vendors and artisans this upcoming weekend and throughout the season!

ART NATIONAL Youth Art Month

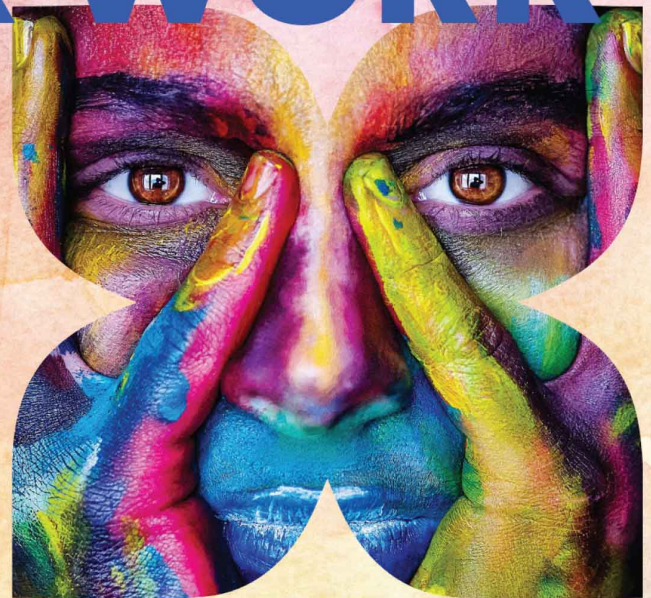
April is National Youth Art Month. Youth Art Month promotes art and art education in the United States.

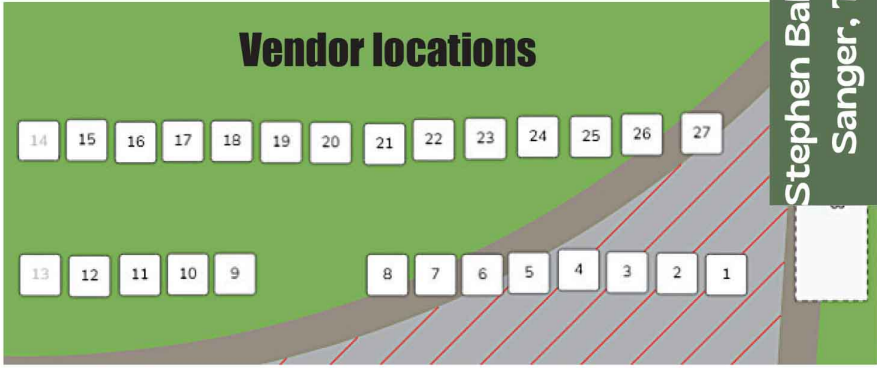

Volunteer Income Tax Assistance is a program of United Way Denton County. Income tax returns are done by IRS trained preparers at Sanger Public Library on Saturdays, between 9 and 12 (arrive by 11:30). The same team of local volunteers from 2015 to 2021 is again here to help you.

This program has a family income limit of \$60,000 to quality; larger amounts need paid preparers. You should bring with you: photo ID for taxpayer and spouse (if joint), SS cards for taxpayer(s) and all children listed on the return. Small one person family businesses can often be done; (if employees, inventory, or depreciation it is out of scope for us). Forms we typically help with are: W-2, 1099 INT and DIV, SS 1099, 1099-R, 1099-C, 1099-MISC, 1098-T 1095-A, capital gains, and others.

There are other rules that make some returns “out of scope” for us, but most taxpayers with under \$60,000 income we can help.

This service will continue on Saturdays through April 15. No appointments, just show up. If too many come we can refer to our larger facility in north Denton.



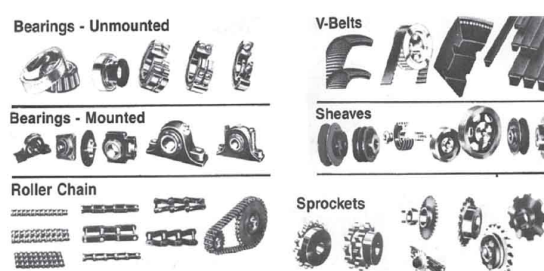
