Sanger gets record hail

Last week, Sanger and Denton County, saw some of extremely large hail. Venessa Henderson sent a photo of an enormous hailstone found in Sanger to DFW Fox 4 News. "All of a sudden, we heard something like a damn meteor hit the top of our roof," said Henderson. "We went outside and looked, didn't see anything, all of a sudden it just started falling. One hit the street that shattered into five different pieces that were golf ball

Last Thursday, hailstones at least 5 inches in diameter hit Sanger. Henderson said her hailstone wasn't even the biggest and said she saw photos of hail that could have been about 6 inches in diameter. The Sanger News is publishing some of the photos Sanger residents posted on Facebook.

Large hail is unusual for North Texas in June. Why all the large hail? The FOX Forecast Center said an unusually strong subtropical jet stream in combination with a flow from a massive upper-level low over the Great Lakes and plenty of moisture were the root causes for the event.

"It was very anomalous," an official at the National Weather Service said. "This was not something that we see regularly throughout the summer.'

Meteorologists at the NWS also said lapse rates, or the amount of temperature change through the lower levels of the atmosphere, were off the charts with massive temperature drops, causing more unstable air.

Here's what led to the large ice stones last week during the severe weather over the South. Hail forms when raindrops become suspended in updrafts. The ice chunks typically start off as the size of peas and dimes but grow as they are suspended in the thunderstorm cloud. When the hailstone grows to a size that the updraft can no longer support, it falls towards the ground.

The largest hailstone ever reported in the U.S. fell in Vivian, South Dakota, on July 23, 2010. NOAA reported the ice chunk was 8 inches wide and weighed nearly

According to the FOX Forecast Center, last week was the first time on record that 5-inch hail or larger had been reported for three consecutive days.

Hailstones of at least five inches in diameter were reported across the South during the week of severe weather.

Significant storms across the South last week produced an array of severe weather with tornadoes and wind damage reported across the region but hail likely cemented itself into the history books.

The FOX Forecast Center said that for five straight days, hail that measured at least 4 inches in diameter, which is unusually large for the South in June, fell over communities in Oklahoma, Georgia, Mississippi and

Local National Weather Service offices issue Severe Thunderstorm Warnings when hail the size of a quarter, or an inch in diameter, is anticipated, but these storms crushed even what is typically considered sizable.



Ralph Amyx

November 20, 1940 - June 12, 2023

Ralph Dennis Amyx, 82, of Sanger, Texas, peacefully passed away on Monday, June 12, 2023, at his home, surrounded by his family. The oldest of three sons to Fred B. and Marvel (Balthrop) Amyx, Ralph was born in Decatur, Texas, on November 20, 1940.

Ralph graduated from Sanger High School and began attending North Texas State University (now called the University of North Texas), where he earned his Masters's Degree. On July 30, 1960, in the Lois Community, Ralph married the love of his life, Lela Mae Springer. They made their home in Sanger, where they raised their two children, Curtis and Lynelle. This year would mark 63 years of marriage. He



and Lela were members of the First Baptist Church in Sanger, where she worked as the church secretary for forty years, and Ralph served as a Deacon.

In 1963, Ralph began his teaching and coaching career with Sanger ISD. In basketball, he led the Sanger Indians to several Bi-District and District Championships. The signs still hang in the gymnasium on Seventh Street to this day. After receiving his Master's Degree in November 16, 1941 - June 13, 2023 Physical Education, he moved to the elementary school where he taught P. E. and Science. He was an excellent teacher, from academic books or life lessons. If you were coached or taught by Ralph, then you were given a nickname. If you walked up to him today, he would still call you by that nickname. He loved and truly cared for his students. He retired after 30 years with Sanger ISD. When he retired in 1993, he had taught two generations of students.

Growing up on a dairy farm, Ralph returned to farming full-time after retirement. Amyx Farms raised some cattle, as well as sheep and goats. Eventually, he concentrated solely on sheep and goats. Ralph was instrumental throughout the State of Texas in helping many of the youth in FFA and 4-H with their show lambs.

Ralph served on the Sanger ISD Board of Trustees for nine years. He was a 32nd Degree Mason and a member of the Bolivar Masonic Lodge #418, having earned his 60-year Service Award with the Bolivar Lodge and the Grand Lodge of Texas in 2022.

Ralph was a family man and loved the Lord. He lived it every day by example for others to see and follow. Ralph and Lela followed their children and the grandchildren in all their involvement. In May, he was able to travel to graduation for his granddaughter, Ashton, with her Doctoral of Physical Therapy. He had the best outlook on life. He always enjoyed a good story, whether being the teller or the listener. He loved teasing, cutting up, and laughing with everyone he knew.



Brush Removal Service


The City of Sanger has contracted with Republic Services to continue our resident brush removal services. Residents whose utility account is in good standing, will be permitted one pick-up per calendar month of up to four cubic yards, at no charge.

- * Pickups will be made on Wednesdays. Only one pickup per calendar month permitted.
- * Inclement weather may delay your scheduled pickup.
- * You must schedule your brush pick-up by 5:00 PM the Friday prior to your pickup.
- * Pickups can be scheduled using our free app "Sanger Solutions" (preferred method) or by calling 940-458-2571. Calls can be made M - TH 7:30 AM - 5:00 PM and Friday 7:30 - 11:00 AM.
- * Brush left on the curb without scheduling a pick-up will not be removed.
- * Tree limbs larger than 1" in diameter must be cut from the main branch.
- * Brush must be less than eight (8) feet in length and less than eight (8) inches in diameter.
- * Place limbs and brush on the curb with the cut side out. Brush should not extend into the
- road and should be free and clear from any overhead obstruction or utility facilities.
- * No shrubs with root systems, whole or large portions of trees will be removed.
- * No material generated by a third party, hired, commercial, or contracted person will be removed.
- * For pickups exceeding 4 cubic yards, please contact customer service for pricing and scheduling.

* All other yard waste shall be disposed of according to the guidelines posted on the City's website under Utility Customer Service/Yard Waste.
