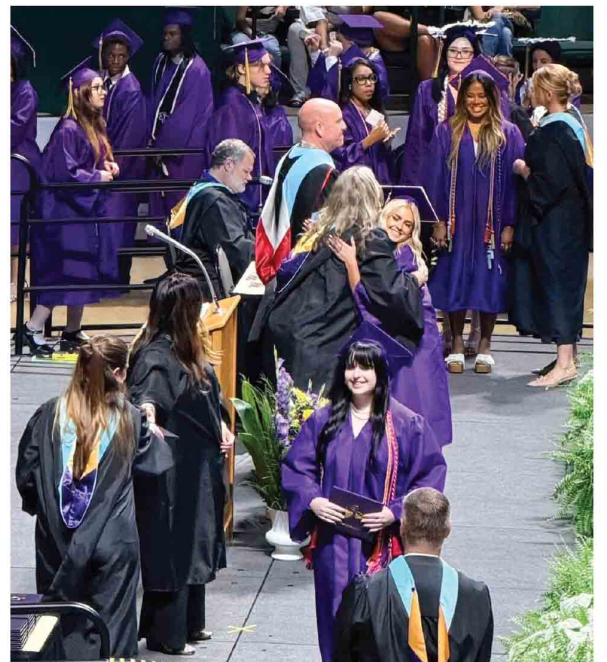
What an incredible accomplishment for this group of young men and women. From classrooms to competitions, performances to community service, this class has left its mark on Sanger ISD in so many ways.

June 26, 1979 - May 18, 2026

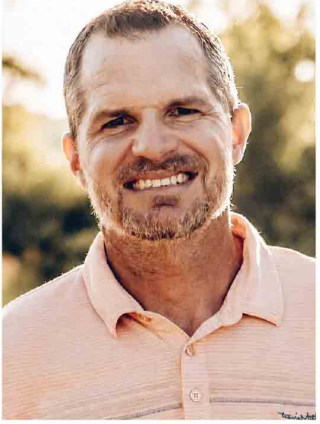

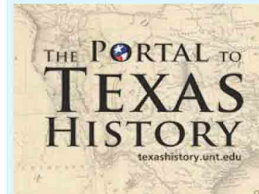

# When Stress Turns Into Something More: How to Tell the Difference

Stress is part of life. A busy week at work, a child's packed schedule, unexpected repairs that turns into a large bill—our bodies and minds are built to respond to pressure. But sometimes stress doesn't "turn off." It lingers, grows, and starts to affect sleep, relationships, focus, and even our physical health. If you've been wondering, Is this normal stress... or is it anxiety? You are not alone.

Here is a simple way to think about it: stress is often tied to a specific situation, while anxiety can stick around even when the situation changes. Stress might show up as racing thoughts before a deadline or tension during a tough season. Anxiety

may feel like your brain is constantly scanning for danger, even when things are "fine."

Common signs stress may be crossing the line

You do not need a dramatic breakdown to "qualify" for help. Many people in our community keep functioning—going to work, taking care of their family—while quietly carrying a heavy load. Consider reaching out if you notice:

- Sleep problems (trouble falling asleep, waking up often, or feeling exhausted even after resting)
- Irritability or feeling "on edge" more days than not
- Difficulty concentrating or remembering things

Physical symptoms like headaches, stomach problems, muscle tension, or chest tightness

Avoiding places, people, or tasks because they feel overwhelming

Increased conflict in relationships or feeling emotionally shut down

These signs don't mean something is "wrong" with you. They're often your nervous system's way of saying, I need support.

Why your body reacts this way

When stress hits, your brain and body shift into survival mode; fight, flight, or freeze. These responses are helpful in true emergencies, but when it becomes constant, your body stays flooded with stress hormones. Over time, this can lead to burnout, anxiety, and even depression.

The good news is that your nervous system can learn a new pattern. Therapy can help you identify and understand your trig-

gers, build coping skills, and create a sense of safety in your body again.

A few practical tools you can try this week

These aren't "magic fixes," but they can help you start calming the stress response.

1. Name what's happening. Try saying, "My body is in stress mode right now." Naming it can reduce shame and create space.

2. Breathe low and slow. Inhale for 4 seconds, exhale for 6 seconds, repeat this pattern for 2-3 minutes. Longer exhales signal safety to the nervous system.

3. Do one small thing. Anxiety often grows when everything feels huge. Pick one tiny action: send the email, wash the dishes, take a 10-minute walk.

4. Limit the 'what if' spiral. When your brain jumps to worst-case scenarios, ask: "What do I

know for sure right now?"

## Saving for Retirement: Are You Guessing or Planning?

Let's say you dream of spending your retirement mornings on a warm beach, coffee in hand, waves rolling in. To get there, you had a simple plan: save \$1 million and buy the beach house you always wanted.

But when retirement arrives, reality hits. After accounting for keeping your current home, everyday expenses and health care, \$1 million doesn't stretch as far as you thought, and the beach house remains a dream. The problem wasn't your discipline – it was that your number was never really your number. It was arbitrary, not anchored to what your ideal retirement would actually cost.

How can you make sure your retirement number is right for you?

A solid savings goal starts with a clear picture of the retirement you want. Think through where you plan to live, whether you'll keep your current home or downsize, how much you plan to travel, if you'll help children and grandchildren financially and what health care might cost you later in life. Build a realistic monthly budget, then multiply by 12 months to find your annual need. Adjust this amount for inflation until the first year of retirement.

Then, multiply that figure by 25 to get a sense of how much may be needed to save. It's a formula based on the idea of withdrawing 4% annually from your savings, assuming you retire in your mid-60s.

If you need \$60,000 a year, your target is around \$1.5 million. You may need more or less depending on your lifestyle, health, unexpected expenses, Social Security benefits and other income. No single rate or strategy will work for everyone. A financial advisor can help you determine your number and strategy.

Once you know your target, the path forward becomes clearer. Here are a few tips for next steps:

Start early. The sooner you begin saving, the more time compound interest has to work in your favor. Small amounts set aside automatically each paycheck have the opportunity to grow significantly over decades.

Live below your means. Spending less than you earn is one of the most powerful wealth-building habits. When your income

rises, save and invest the difference instead of upgrading your lifestyle.

Keep your debt under control. Since credit cards and other high-interest debt can slow your progress, pay off balances monthly when possible.

Invest consistently. If your employer offers a 401(k), aim to contribute at least 10%-15% of your salary, and increase your contributions after every raise. If you max out your 401(k), a traditional IRA or Roth IRA may offer additional tax-advantaged growth (eligibility and contribution limits apply).

Boost your income when you can. Develop new skills, ask for a raise or explore a side income. Every extra dollar saved

moves you closer to your goal.

The difference between a retirement you love and one full of compromises often comes down to the planning you

do today. Know your real number, build a solid plan and get the right help along the way.

attempt to take a 7-6 win in their regional final series opener. Sanger (22-13-3) scored four runs in the bottom half of the third inning and three more in the fourth to build an early 7-1 lead. Richland worked its way back with two runs in the top of the sixth and three more in the seventh as it got the tying run to third base with two outs. Salt Lake CC signee Paige Child induced a flyout that left fielder Carley Kates extended to snag for the final out of the victory.

Oklahoma Christian signee Lily Wilson hit a two-run home run to help lead Sanger offensively. Dalilah Millan went 2 for 4 with two RBIs, and Child finished 1 for 2 with two walks, two RBIs and two runs scored. Kates added a double, a walk and one run scored.

**GAME 2** didn't go the Lady Indians way, but this team showed fight from the very first pitch. Sanger exploded for 12 runs on 16 hits and battled all night long in an offensive showdown with Richland before falling 16-12 in Game 2 of the 4A Region 2 Finals.

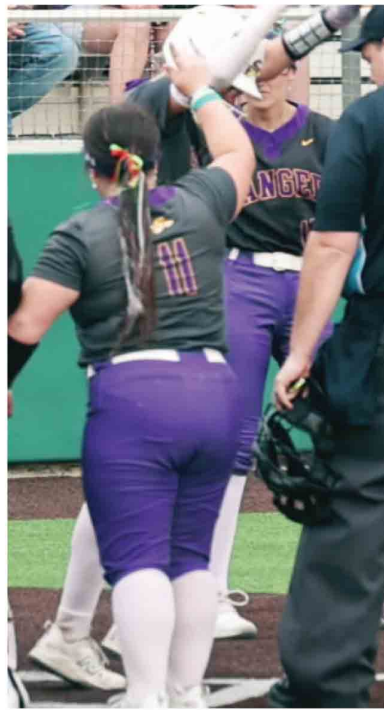
Prosper Richland (33-7) advanced to face Dumas (36-2-1).

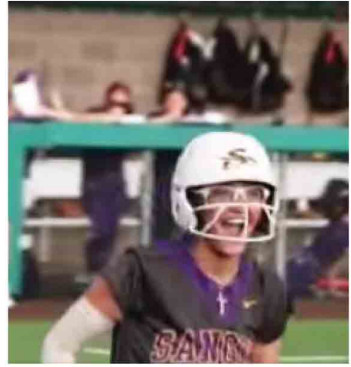
Sanger has a long history of success in the sport, one that got a little longer with the Lady Indians' playoff run this year.

Reed Sebastian, Twister Wilson, and Luke Hendricks each collected hits for the Indians, while the defense continued to battle until the final out.

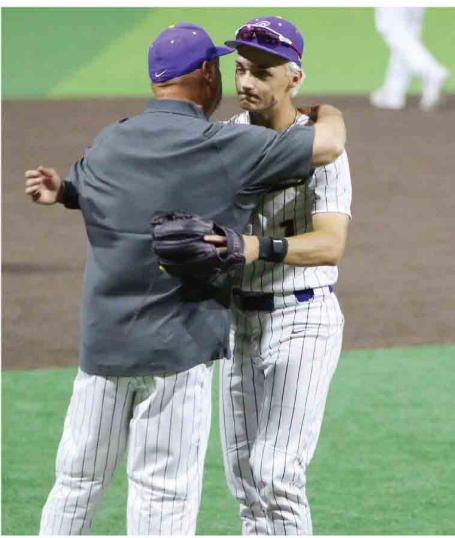
**GAME 1 - Texarkana Pleasant Grove 12, Sanger 2 (5 innings)**

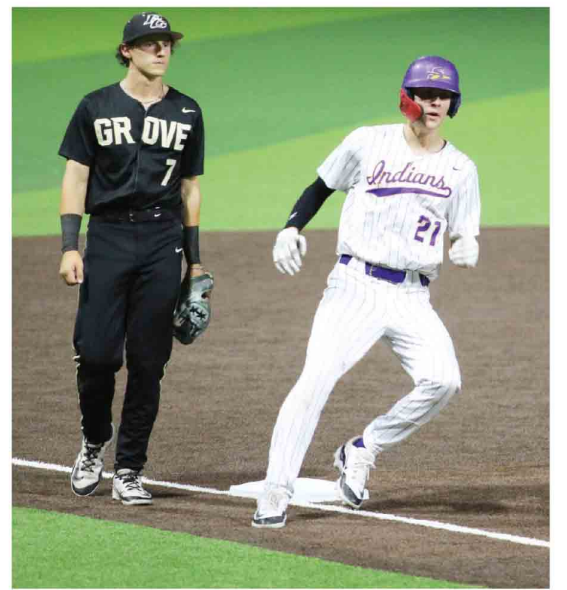
Pleasant Grove broke the contest open and ultimately brought the run-rule into effect with nine runs in the bottom of the fifth.

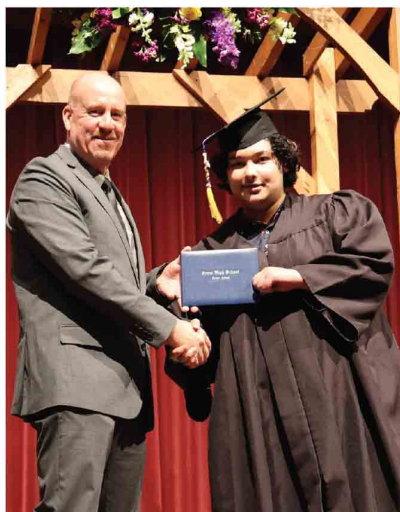

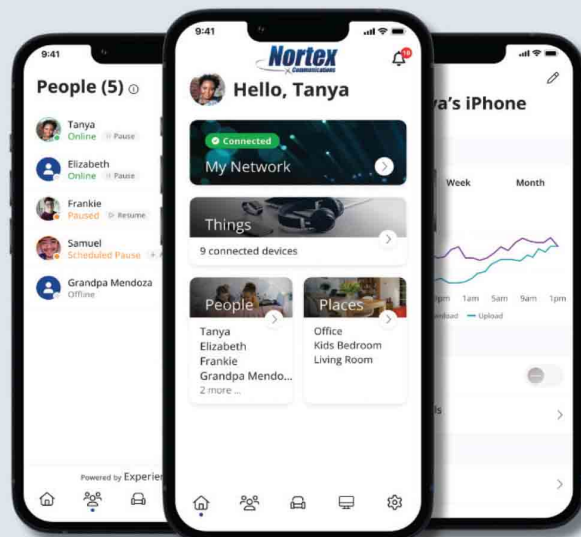
