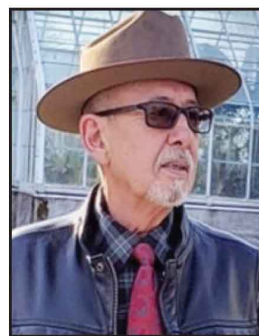
Dan obtained his MBA from the University of Colorado, worked in the computer industry, and finished his career as a real estate broker in his home in San Luis Valley, Colorado.
