Sanger Sonic plans being finalized to purchase property right next to current location

Restaurant to close doors by January 2020 as crews come in to move utilities for TxDOT widening of FM 455



Owners of the Sonic in Sanger have come to an agreement to purchase the land just west of the current location and right off 10th Street. It's the property where the old Chevrolet Dealership building was demolished this year with the future expansion of FM 455 by TxDOT.

An assistant manager at Sonic of Sanger confirmed that Sonic will be closed in January 2020. That is the TxDOT deadline as crews will come in and start to move utilities for the widening of FM 455 from Marion Road, just east of Sanger High School to the 4-way stop in Bolivar. Unfortunately, that means most of the of Sonic employees will be looking for new jobs when it closes. The TxDOT Right of Way (ROW) reaches the Sonic building. The original plan was to rebuild and turn it from north-south to east and west. But the downside was losing several vehicle spaces for customers to order their food and drinks.

Meanwhile, the Sanger Sonic along with Krum and Denton were sold by Gene Gumfory. It was bought by a group and is controlled by the Sonic Corporate office in Oklahoma City. Lynn Stucky, Republican member of the Texas House of Representatives for the 64th District in Denton County

and long-time resident of Sanger owns the property right next to Sonic, which is 0.56 acre. He confirmed on Tuesday that he has reached an agreement with the Sonic Corporate representatives on a sale price. He said Sonic wanted to do core samples of the soil to make sure it's not contaminated and confirm from TxDOT the two entrances from this property that connects to 10th Street and FM 455. They are testing the soil because the old Chevrolet Dealership was on this location for several years and the building was just torn down this year.

"These things take time," Stucky, said. I think it is a great location for them, especially with the expansion of I-35, as well." In the I-35 expansion, the Shell station between Stucky's property and the highway will be taken by TxDOT's (ROW). He confirmed that Sonic plans on using both properties when they rebuild.

Don't Change 401(k) Mix During Market Drops

As you're well aware, we've seen some sudden and sizable drops in the financial markets in 2019. While market volatility is nothing new, the recent plunges happened during a period of general political and economic unease. Still, it can be harmful to overreact to such events

— especially if it means making radical changes to your 401(k). And yet, many people do just that. During market downturns, investors often move money from their 401(k)'s stock accounts into perceived safer accounts, such as those primarily containing bonds or other fixed-income securities. This move may result in reduced volatility on your 401(k) statements, and if that's all you want, you might be satisfied. But you do need to realize the cost involved — specifically, fixed-income investments will not provide the same rate of return that equities (stocks) can. So, if

you liquidate some of your equity holdings, you may slow the growth potential of your 401(k), which, in turn, could slow your progress toward your long-term financial goals. Furthermore, if you get rid of substantial amounts of your equities when their price is down, you won't be able to benefit from owning them when their value goes up again — in other words, you'll be on the sidelines during the next market rally.

Here's the key issue: A 401(k) or similar employer-sponsored retirement plan is a long-term investment account, whereas moves made in reaction to market drops are designed to produce short-term results. In other words, these types of actions are essentially incompatible with the ultimate objective of your 401(k).

Of course, when the market is volatile, you may want to do something with your 401(k), but, in most cases, you're far better off by sticking with the investment mix that's appropriate for your goals, risk tolerance and time horizon. However, this doesn't mean you should never adjust your 401(k)'s portfolio. In fact, you may well want to make some changes under these circumstances:

You're nearing retirement — If you are nearing retirement, you may need to prepare your 401(k) for future downturns — after all, you don't want to have to start taking withdrawals when your portfolio is down. So, if you are within, say, five years of retirement, you may need to shift some, but certainly not all, of your assets from growth-oriented vehicles to income-producing ones.

Your goals have changed — Even when you're many years away from retirement, you probably have an idea of what that lifestyle will look like. Perhaps you plan to travel for several months of the year or purchase a vacation home in a different climate. These are expensive goals and may require you to invest somewhat aggressively in your 401(k). But you could change your mind. If you were to scale back your plans — perhaps more volunteering, less traveling — you might be able to afford to “step off the gas” a little and invest somewhat more conservatively in your 401(k), though you will always need a reasonable percentage of growth-oriented investments.

By responding to factors such as these, rather than short-term market declines, you can get the most from your 401(k), allowing it to become a valuable part of your retirement income.

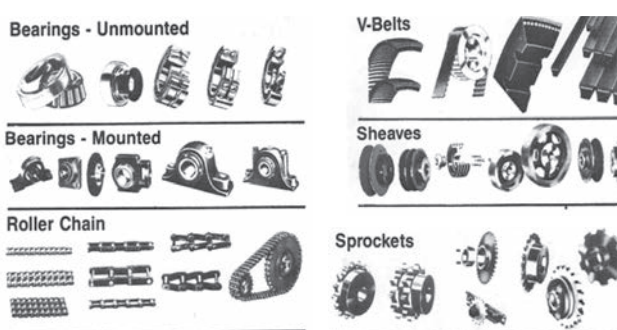
