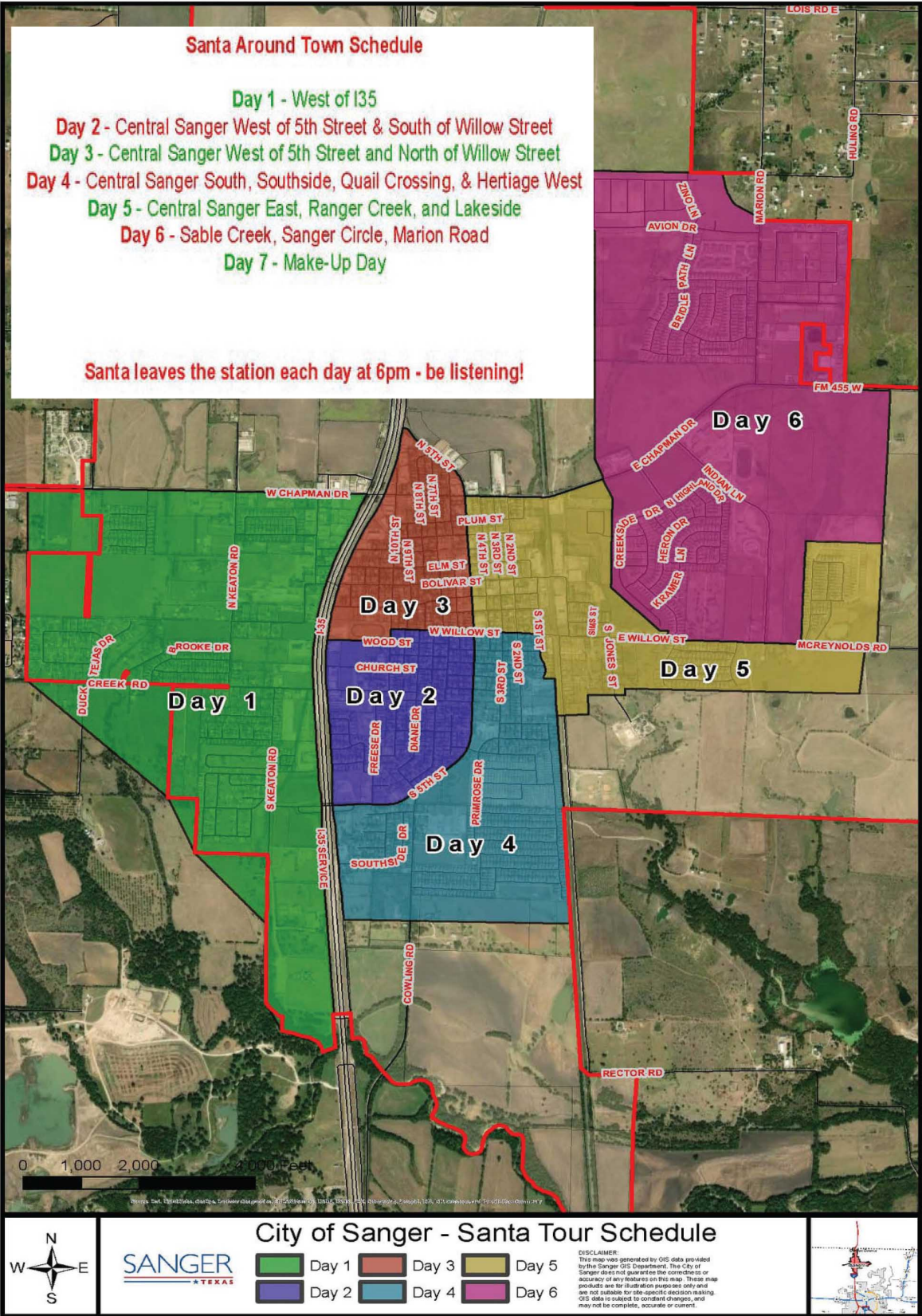
Santa to visit Sanger neighborhoods Dec. 12-17
