Three candidates file on last day

All six school board and city council candidate incumbents were unopposed until the last day of the filing period on February 17 for the May 6 election.

The Sanger ISD Board has three places up for election. They are Jarrod Roberts (Place 1), Mitch Hammonds (Place 6) and Bruce Elsey (Place 7). The candidate filing period began January 18 and ended February 17, 2023. All three incumbents filed early in the process. On

Friday, February 17, two new candidates filed for Places 1 and 6. Jessica Baird Allbritton is running for Place 6 and James A. Tuberville is a candidate for Place 1. Elsey is unopposed.

Elsey finished the unexpired term of Dr. Dale Gleason/Jimmy Howard in 2022. Hammonds was appointed in 2019 and elected in May of 2020 and Roberts was elected in May of 2021.

Places up for City Council are Marissa Bar-

rett (Place 1), Dennis Dillon (Place 3) and Victor Gann (Place 5). Dillon and Gann filed early and Barrett turned in her paperwork February 12. Joe Falls, a long-time farmer in Sanger and career election candidate filed February 17 to run against Barrett. Barrett has been on the council since May 2019 for two-terms. Gann (May 2021, 1 term) and Dillon (May 2019, 2 terms).

The Sanger News will profile all the candidates a few weeks before the election.

New SHS head football coach and boys athletic director hired

After leading Tioga to a district title and its best 11-man season since the 1930s, head football coach Chad Rogers is leaving to take the same position at Sanger, pending school board approval.

Rogers spent the past two seasons at Tioga, compiling a 13-9 record and making the playoffs both times.

"It checks all of the boxes with what we were looking for," Rogers said about the move. "Talking with them, seeing what they are doing there, it seems like a perfect fit."

This past fall the Bulldogs went 8-3 overall, losing against Hamilton to open the playoffs. Tioga had a 5-0 record in District 6-2A (I) play, just two years removed from a winless district campaign. The eight wins were the most for the program at the 11-man level since an 11-0 record in 1934.

Tioga did not play football from 1950 to 2012 before reinstating the pro-

gram as a six-man squad and growth in the area sent them up to Class 2A in realignment following a state semifinal appearance and 11-2 mark in 2017.

But the Bulldogs struggled to gain football after the Class 2A jump. Rogers inherited a program that won just a single game in 2020, and was 0-5 in district play. In three seasons since moving up from the six-man ranks it had just

five wins.

The Bulldogs matched that total with a 5-6 mark in 2021, losing in the bi-district round against Celeste, before improving against this past season.

Sanger will be the fourth stop in Rogers' career. He has compiled a 159-94 record, starting with 11 years at Snyder and two state-semifinal appearances before leaving to lead Denison for nine

years from 2012-20 before stepping down there for the position at Tioga.

Rogers has had 16 winning seasons in 22 years, including five of the last six, and 15 playoff appearances — including three straight and five of the past seven seasons. He has a 15-9 playoff record.

Sanger had an opening the first week of Jan-

uary when Rocky Smart stepped down to take the same position at Valley View. The Indians are in District 5-4A (II) and are coming off 7-4 record with a bi-district loss to Caddo Mills and a fourth-place district finish.

"We were excited to receive over 140 applications. This solidified to us what we know, Sanger

ISD is a great place to be," Sanger ISD superintendent Dr. Tommy Hunter stated in an email. "A search and interview committee consisting of educators, who collectively have 139 years in public education, we created a characteristic profile to assist in narrowing down the applicants.

Krum knocks Sanger out of the playoffs

Krum (24-7) beat Sanger 57-40 in a Class 4A bi-district basketball playoff game at Denton Guyer High School on Tuesday night. The Indians hung in there much of the game. Sanger cut Krum's early lead to 23-18 when Kasen Hastings made a half court shot at the buzzer. Krum broke the game open with a 9-0 third quarter run.

Krum's full court defensive press gave the Indians problems. "We just had way too many turnovers in the first half, but we battled," Sanger coach Bobby Stastny said. "I think they (players) might have been a little nervous, they've never been in this situation. It's the first time in the playoffs since 2018-2019. I'm proud of 'em, extremely proud of 'em."

Jordyn Brown led Sanger's scoring effort with 15 points on the night. Hunter Nelms chipped in nine points and Kason Peebles scored eight, Brandon Hodge (4), Dyland Brown (3) and Jett Jones added one point.

For Sanger, the loss ends what was largely a resurgent season in Stastny's first year at Sanger. They had 17 wins this season, more than the previous two combined.

Those achievements have Stastny excited about what's to come heading into his second year leading the program. "This is all new to these guys, the way I do things. 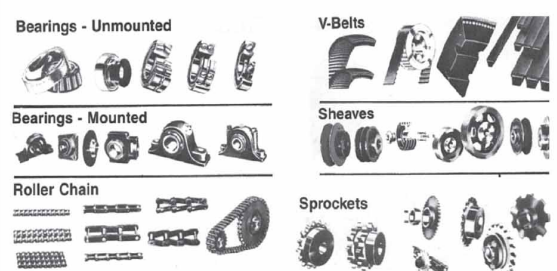
