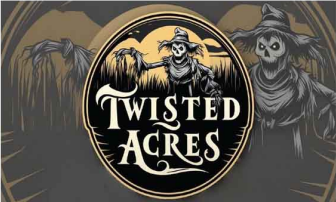

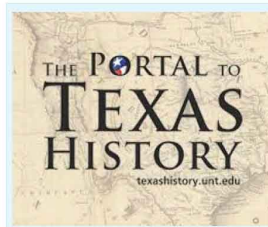

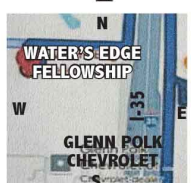

Financial steps to prepare for Alzheimer's and dementia

More than 7 million Americans have Alzheimer's disease, according to a 2025 report from the Alzheimer's Association. The emotional toll of watching a loved one struggle with the memory loss, depression, anxiety and cognitive decline is already overwhelming — but the financial burden can be significant too. Hopefully this disease will never touch your family, but it's important to be financially prepared just in case. By planning to cover long-term care costs and creating a financial strategy for caregivers, you can help protect your family's financial well-being.

Expenses related to Alzheimer's and other forms of dementia can be extensive. Families often face ongoing medical treatment costs, medical equipment purchases, home safety modifications, prescription drugs and personal care supplies.

Long-term care represents one of the largest health care costs not covered entirely by traditional Medicare, making advanced planning crucial.

Here are a few essential planning steps to consider:

Plan for care costs and identify insurance coverage. Start by understanding your family's health insurance options, including Medicare, supplemental policies and veteran's benefits if applicable. Determine coverage for adult day care services, in-home care services, full-time residential care and other long-term care options. Confirm whether you or your loved ones have long-term care policies or other insurance with long-term care riders.

In some states, Medicare offers Special Needs Plans (SNPs) for people living with dementia, including Alzheimer's. These plans specialize in care and coverage for beneficiaries with dementia, and only those diagnosed can enroll.

Identify assets and debts. Create a comprehensive picture of your family's financial position, including bank accounts, investments, property and debts such as credit cards, mortgages or lines of credit. You'll need this if you take over financial management for a loved one.

Ensure legal documents are in place. Work with an attorney to establish crucial documents like a durable power of attorney for finances and health care decisions. These documents should be created before someone is diagnosed or when they're just starting to show early signs of Alzheimer's, so they can understand what they're signing. Waiting until cognitive ability declines makes the process more challenging and may require court procedures for conservatorship.

Consider a living trust. A living trust can hold financial assets and property while a successor trustee, like trusted family member, manages money and makes investment decisions. While complex, these trusts can provide valuable protection for families dealing with a parent or older relative experiencing dementia.

Look for tax benefits. Caregivers who pay care costs out of pocket may qualify for tax credits and deductions. These benefits vary by state, so consult with a tax advisor about your eligibility.

Consider protective measures for early stages. If a loved one is showing signs of Alzheimer's or other dementia, you may want to set up auto-pay for bills, open joint checking accounts, freeze credit

reports at major bureaus, consolidate or cancel credit cards, and monitor financial activities closely. This can help keep financial responsibilities flowing smoothly and prevent exploitation by scam artists.

A qualified financial advisor can help evaluate your family's overall situation and recommend appropriate strategies to prepare for potential dementia-related costs. They can work with your legal and tax professionals to help you put comprehensive protection in place.

While an Alzheimer's or dementia diagnosis will change everyone's life in your family, taking proactive financial steps can help ease the burden and provide greater confidence for the journey ahead. For more information, visit www.alz.org.

Indians fall to Krum, have a bye this week

Sanger Sports Corner Game Recap

Last Friday night at Stephen Baker Field at Indian Stadium featured another classic District 5-4A battle as the Sanger Indians hosted the rival Krum Bobcats. Despite a strong first half and several explosive offensive plays, the Indians ultimately fell short as Krum stormed back to win 49-35.

Fast Start, First-Half Fireworks

The game began with a tough break for Sanger — a fumble on the opening kickoff gave Krum early field position. But the Indian defense held firm, limiting the Bobcats to just a field goal. That stop lit a spark for the Sanger offense, and quarterback Reed Sebastian wasted no time responding, hitting Joel Rodriguez on a 21-yard touchdown strike to give Sanger the lead.

From there, the Indians caught fire. Sebastian threw another touchdown — a 44-yard bomb to Rodriguez — and connected with Wyatt Pennington on a 9-yard score. The senior quarterback also punched in two short touchdown runs himself, helping Sanger take control with a 35-24 halftime lead.

Second-Half Struggles

After the break, momentum began to shift. Krum opened the second half with a big kickoff return and quickly cut into the lead with a field goal, making it 35-27. From that point forward, the Sanger offense went cold — shut out in a half for the first time since September 2024.

Meanwhile, Krum's offense capitalized on Sanger penalties and turnovers, scoring 22 unanswered points to seal the comeback victory.

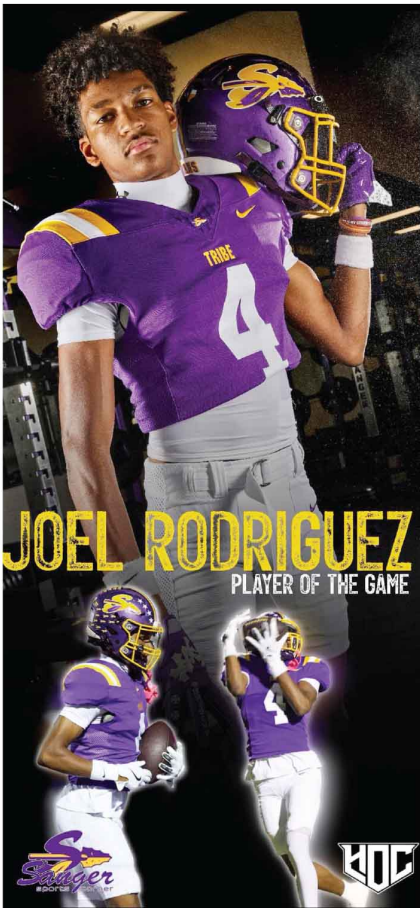

The Indians fall to 5-3 overall (3-1 in district) heading into their bye week. They'll look to regroup and refocus before traveling to Gainesville for a Halloween night showdown with the Leopards. The Krum Bobcats, meanwhile, improve to 6-0 overall and 3-0 in district, and will host Gainesville next Friday, October 24th.



Sanger Sports Corner's House of Carts Player of the Game was without question Joel Rodriguez.

Here's why: Joel Rodriguez — WR — Senior Rodriguez was electric all night, serving as the spark plug for the Indian offense in the first half. He finished with 7 catches for 187 yards and 2 touchdowns, plus another catch that was ruled down at the 1-yard line. Nearly every big play in the passing game went through him, and his ability to stretch the field gave Sanger control early.

Even though the Indians couldn't hold off Krum's second-half surge, Rodriguez's performance was dominant and dynamic, showcasing his speed, hands, and playmaking ability on the biggest stage of the season.

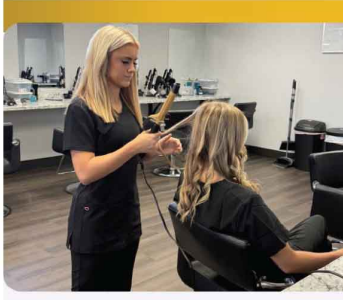

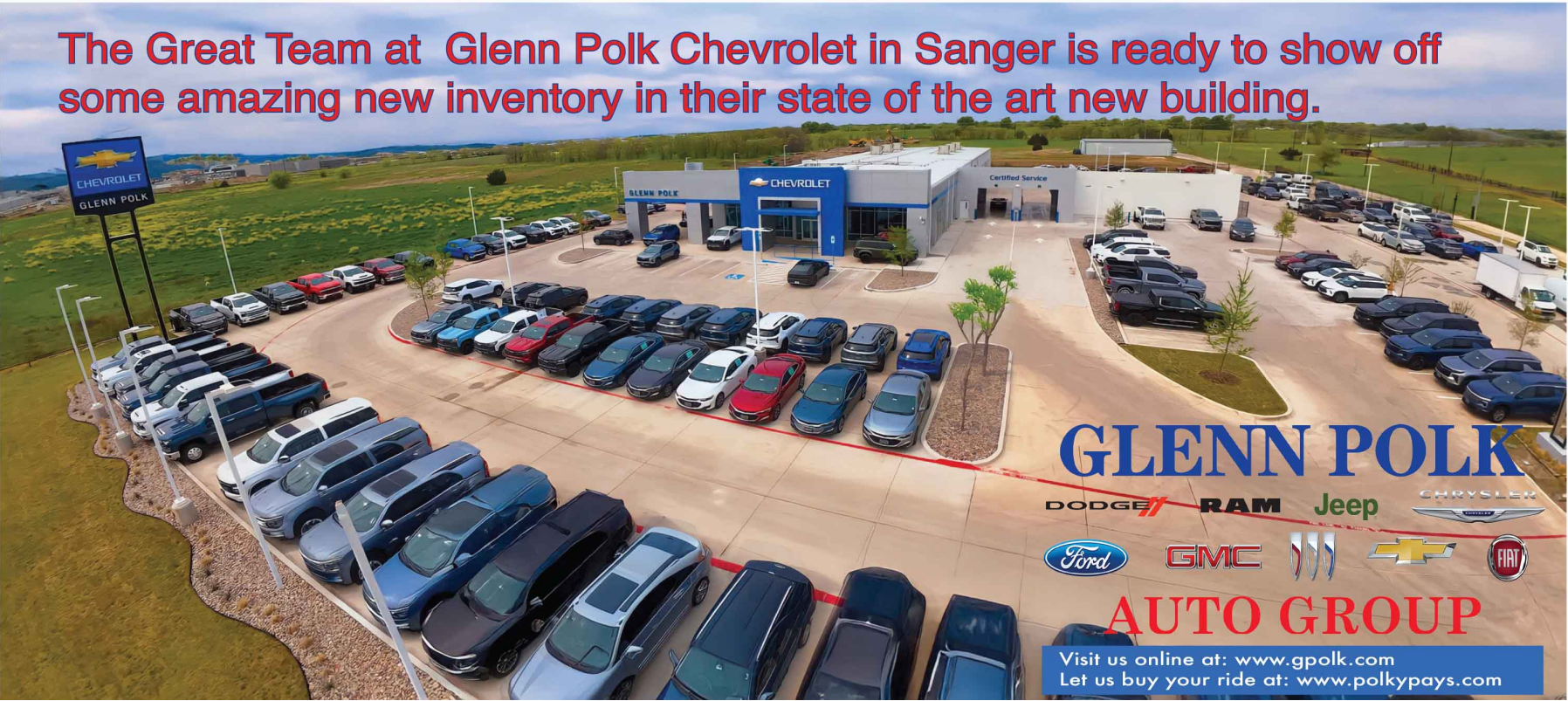

SHS earns Division I Rating at UIL Region 2 Marching Band Contest

The Spirit of Sanger High School Band competed in the UIL Region 2 Marching Band contest along with all 30 of the bands Class (1A-6A) from ther Region last Saturday at C.H. Collins Stadium in Denton. Bands compete with schools that share their UIL classification (1A-6A). At this stage bands are awarded a "Rating" instead of a number. A rating of 1st division is best to 5th division being the worst. In order to advance to the Area round you must be awarded a 1st Division by 2 of the 3 judges. Sanger was awarded a 1st Division by all 3 judges. There were 7 bands in the UIL 4A classification that competed. All were awarded a 1st Division and advanced to the Area round.

It's a huge "Area" geographically according to Robert Smith, SHS Band Director. As far north as Burkburnett HS on the Oklahoma border to Robinson HS south of Waco. There are 5 "Areas" comprising 31 Regions. Those "Areas" combined, sent 27 bands to the 4A State marching contest in 2024.

In Sanger's UIL Area B, there are 49 UIL class 4A bands, and 31 of them advanced to the Area level by earning a 1st division. For every 5 bands that advance to the Area level, one band will advance on to the State level. "This Saturday Oct. 25th we will compete against all 31 qualifying bands head to head, and this time receive a numbered score instead of a rating. The number this time allows judges to rank bands among one another to determine the top 12 highest scores," said Smith. Those bands will move onto a Finals round that same evening and compete again for placement. This time the excitement builds, because now the top 6 bands at the end of the Finals judging will advance to the UIL State Marching contest in San Antonio on Nov. 5th. "Our Area is a tough one for sure with 3 of the Area B bands placing in the Top 10 of the UIL State Marching Contest. Sanger has never competed in the State Marching Contest but we have our eyes on the goal of making school history very soon," added Smith.

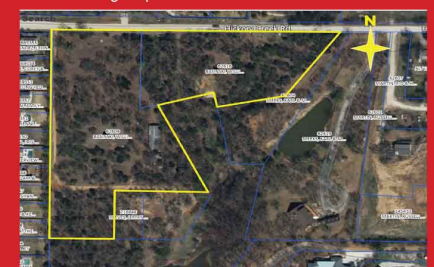

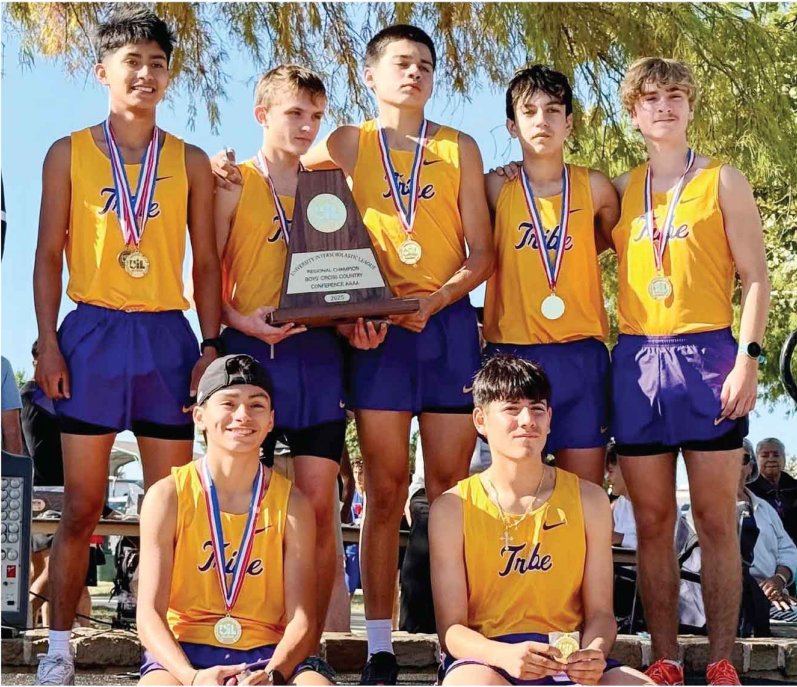
