H-E-B purchases 600 acres just north of Sanger



H-E-B, recently announced, they have purchased 600 acres just north of Sanger. The land connects between Metz Road and W. Lone Oak Road, on the west side of I-35. The project is part of a multi-phase plan to develop the property, but not for a grocery store. The land is located just north of Chisam Road just inside the Cooke County Line.

To support its growing business, H-E-B finalized the land purchase in North Texas where the company has plans to build facilities in multiple phases to support its supply chain operations.

The project is still in the early planning stages, and there is not a timeline for construction. Additional details about the project will be released as plans develop. The terms of the land purchase were not disclosed.

Once in operation, the facilities will expand and build upon H-E-B's existing supply chain operations, allowing the company to better serve customers and communities across North and West Texas.

"Buying this property marks the first step in developing a master-planned campus that will strengthen our ability to serve more Texans," said Carson Landsgard, Chief Supply Chain Officer for H-E-B. "This project reinforces our commitment to communities across the state and will generate more local job opportunities in the years ahead."

Additionally, H-E-B recently purchased 122 acres next to its current distribution campus in Temple to support future growth at the site. There are no immediate plans for construction there, and details will be shared as plans develop. The terms of the deal were not disclosed.



H-E-B, which has been expanding its footprint in North Texas, has two supermarkets planned in Denton.

One will be at Hillwood's Landmark development at the northwest corner of Interstate 35W and Robson Ranch Road, at Denton's border with Argyle. The other will be at University Drive and Bonnie Brae Street near Rayzor Ranch.

Both are expected to begin construction this spring.

There is no construction timeline for the supply chain facilities yet, as the project is still in the early stages.

The largest privately held employer in Texas, H-E-B continues to grow its business across all areas of the company, maintaining its push as an economic driver for Texas.

Gary Bilyeu to run for Sanger Mayor

A proud Denton, Texas, native, Gary Bilyeu has called Sanger home since 1999. It is the community where he met his wife and where they chose to raise their family. Now finishing his eighth term on the Sanger City Council, Gary also serves as Mayor Pro-Tem.

Bilyeu filed his candidacy paperwork to run for Mayor on Tuesday morning. He's been on the City Council since May of 2010. "If I decided not to run for office again, then I would be very proud of the accomplishments during my eight terms on City Council. Like most cities, we continue to face many challenges. However, we will soon have a void in leadership. This is a critical time for our city. I believe that continuity of knowledge and experience along with proven leadership would serve the city well in meeting those challenges. After much consideration, I decided to run for Mayor," said Bilyeu, in an email Wednesday morning.

The week before the filing period, which started Wednesday, January 14, Sanger Mayor Thomas Muir announced he wasn't running for re-election. Muir has been elected Mayor since May of 2010. "I wanted to make my intentions clear regarding the Mayoral position. I have decided not to run for re-election. My hope is that this announcement will allow extra time for thoughtful, well-considered, decisions by those that might consider running for Mayor.

"Personally, when I

started in elected position, I hoped to use my service as an example to teach my children the importance of serving others by investing in a town that means so much to our family. With all our kids basically out of the house now and with

our last one down at UT in Austin, Elizabeth and I have entered a new phase. We have three grandchildren. It is time to invest personally in the next generation of our family and spend some extra time together. Additionally,

there are some personal ministry opportunities and initiatives in my business that I would also like to press into more fully. I look forward to focusing more effort toward these areas. It is certainly hard to step away from some-

thing in which I have been so invested, but I think the time is right to make the transition."

Bilyeu's dedication to public service began long before his council tenure,

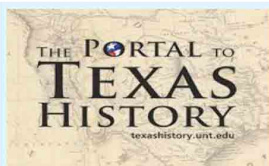

Zack is preceded in death by his grandparents, Bill and Pauline Hauser, and Don and Inez Nafe who surely welcomed him with open arms.

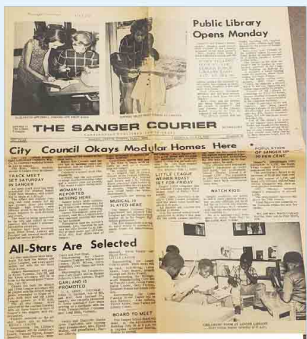
A funeral service to honor Zackary Wayne Hauser was held at Bolivar Baptist Church in Sanger, Texas, on February 7, 2026.

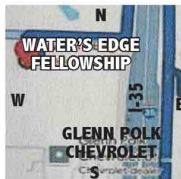

What should you do with your tax refund?

It's almost time for people to begin receiving their tax refunds. If you get one, what will you do with it?

The answer will depend somewhat on the size of your refund. Last year, the average was \$3,167, according to the Internal Revenue Service's Filing Season Statistics report.

Whatever the size of your refund, you'll want to maximize its benefit. Here are some suggestions:

Contribute to your IRA. If you receive \$3,167, it could go a long way toward funding your IRA for the year, but any amount would help. You have until April 15 to contribute for the 2025 tax year, but if you've already "maxed out" contributions, you could use your refund for 2026, when the annual contribution limit for an IRA is \$7,500, or \$8,600 if you're 50 or older. Beginning early toward fully funding your IRA can help reduce the pressure of coming up with large amounts later.

Build an emergency fund. Your tax refund could help you start or expand an emergency

fund. It's a good idea to keep three to six months' worth of living expenses in such a fund, with the money kept in a liquid, low-risk account, separate from the funds you use for your daily expenses. You might need to draw on this fund for unexpected expenses, such as a major home or car repair or a large medical bill. Without an emergency fund in place, you might be tempted to dip into your IRA or other retirement accounts to pay for these types of costs, and that could be expensive, resulting in taxes, penalties and lost opportunities for growth.

Contribute to a 529 plan. If you have children or grandchildren and want to support their education, you might consider investing in a 529 education savings plan. Earnings and withdrawals are federally tax free, provided the money is used for qualified education expenses. Your 529 plan may provide state tax benefits, too. (It's possible, though, that 529 withdrawals could affect financial aid packages, depending on who owns the account.) A 529 plan can be used to help pay for college, accredited trade

school programs, some K-12 expenses and even some student loans.

Pay down debts. You may wish you could reduce your debt load. Your tax refund could offer you that chance. But which debts should you tackle first? You could follow the "snowball" method by paying off the smallest of your loans or debts as quickly as possible. Or you could choose the "avalanche" route by making minimum payments on all debts and using extra funds – such as your tax refund – to pay off those with the highest interest rates. Either method could help you save money in the long term.

Prepare for other tax obligations. Your refund can also be set aside in a separate savings account to pay estimated quarterly taxes or personal property or real estate taxes.

It's not often that you receive a financial windfall such as a tax refund — so think carefully about how you can maximize its benefits.

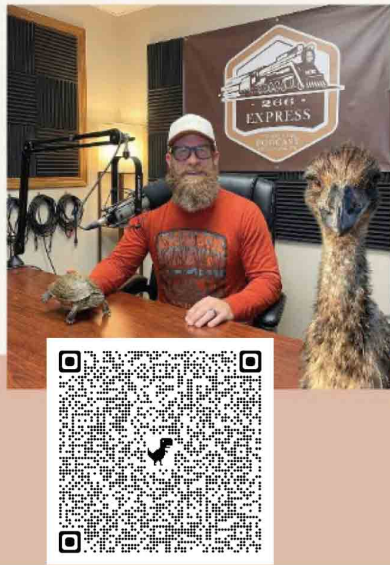

Second Chances

New Episode Alert | The 266 Express Podcast

A starving lab named Happy and a fragile calf named Alice don't just make for powerful stories. They challenge how we think about compassion, responsibility, and coexistence.

In our newest episode, we sit down with Jeremy Sons, known to many as the Denton Spider-Man, to talk about how stopping for stray animals led to the creation of Clear Creek Adventure Ranch, a 501(c)(3) sanctuary now home to more than 60 rescued animals, many with special needs.

Jeremy takes us inside the daily rhythm of the ranch. Sunrise turnouts. Bottle feeding and diapers. Endless scooping and fresh hay. Building safe habitats and ending the day with quiet evening rounds. The mission is simple and unwavering: reduce stress, increase safety, and put animals first.

We also talk about the ranch's animal-first "Meet the Animals" experiences, hands-on education for kids led by Jeremy's wife, a longtime elementary teacher, and the importance of protecting the Clear Creek wildlife corridor as a proposed tollway threatens vital habitat.

City and School Board Election Update:

As of Wednesday, February 4th morning, the seats for city council Place 2 and Place 4 remain empty for the May 2, 2026 local election. City Councilman Gary Bilyeu has filed to run for Mayor.

Open places on the council are Place 2 - Gary Bilyeu (This place will be vacated since he is running for Mayor) and Place 4 - Allen Chick. Bilyeu has been on the council since 2010 and Chick's first term started in 2014.

As of February 4, Roberts and Drew Hall, have turned in their packets for Place 1 and Hammonds has filed for Place 6. Elsey confirmed Wednesday, he will be picking up a packet and file this week for Place 6.

The last day to file is Friday, February 13 at the close of business. Applications are available at City Hall and Sanger ISD Administration buildings.

The loss completes a season split between the two programs, but Aubrey now holds the edge in the district standings at 7–4, while Sanger dropped to 4–7 at the time.

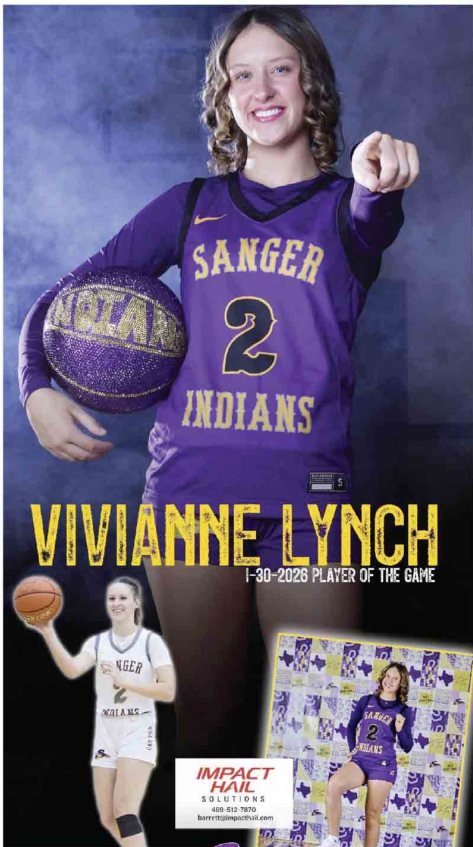
