**Memorial Day 2025 falls on Monday, May 26.** Since 1971, the holiday has fallen on the last Monday of May, so the date moves around a bit from year to year

Memorial Day is now observed on the last Monday in May. Originally, however, it was held on May 30, regardless of the day of the week.

In 1968, Congress passed the Uniform Monday Holiday Act which moved several federal holidays, including Memorial Day, to designated Mondays—creating three-day weekends for federal workers.

The change officially took effect in 1971, establishing the final Monday in May as Memorial Day. Still, it took time for all states to adopt the new observance, and even today, some states continue to recognize Decoration Day in their laws or traditions, reflecting the holiday's historical roots.

**How Do People Observe Memorial Day?**

- Many people honor Memorial Day in traditional ways, such as:
  - flying the American flag at half-staff from dawn until noon
  - taking part in a national moment of remembrance at 15:00 (3 pm) local time
  - visiting local cemeteries and memorials to pay respect to fallen service members
  - placing flowers or wreaths on soldiers' graves
  - volunteering to decorate military graves with American flags at national cemeteries
- attending memorial services, parades, and community events

**Modern Memorial Day Traditions**

Although the primary purpose of the holiday is remembrance, Memorial Day weekend has also become a time for families and communities to gather and enjoy the unofficial start of summer. Many Americans:

- have barbecues, picnics, and family gatherings
- travel for short trips or weekend vacations
- attend sports games or summer events
- Memorial Weekend kicks off the lake season
- Wearing white between Memorial Day and Labor Day was once a widely followed tradition in the United States. This custom began as a way to stay cool in hot weather and as a sign of wealth and social status among upper-class families, though this is much less common today.

**Public Life on Memorial Day**

Memorial Day is a federal holiday, which means:

- Schools, non-essential government offices, and many businesses are closed.
- Public transportation often operates on a reduced or holiday schedule.
- Highways and airports tend to experience increased traffic.
- Most retail stores stay open, and Memorial Day sales have become a significant part of the weekend.

**Symbols of Memorial Day**

The Red Poppy: This flower became a symbol of remembrance after World War I, inspired by the poem "In Flanders Fields" by poet and soldier John McCrae. People often wear or display red poppies to honor fallen soldiers, and the American Legion distributes them every Memorial Day.

The American Flag: On Memorial Day, the flag is lowered to half-staff from sunrise until noon and then raised to full-staff for the remainder of the day. This process symbolizes mourning in the morning and a commitment to continue the fight for freedom in the afternoon. The flag's colors—red for bravery, white for purity, and blue for perseverance—carry deep meaning on this day of reflection.

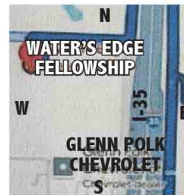

What Are These Creatures? GRUBS!!

If you're digging in the garden or removing sod, you may encounter a creamy white, worm-like creature with a dark head and tail. If it keeps curling into a C-shape and has 6 legs, that creature is most likely a grub or a grub worm.

Grubs are the larvae of beetles. The most common grub in north Texas is the June beetle (Phyllophaga species) larva. Other names for June beetles include June Bug, May beetle and May bug.

Grubs feed on the roots of plants just below the surface. They prefer the roots of turf grasses, but also eat the roots of other newly germinated plants. High numbers of grubs feeding in your soil can kill turf in a short time. Grub-damaged turf can be rolled up like a rug. Grubs can also leave seedlings or young garden transplants lying on the ground, having been cut at the base of the stem by the grub worms.

Grub sightings peak from April through September. Most adults emerge between the end of May and early July in North Texas. They retreat deeper into the ground during winter for protection. Homeowners may not even realize they have grubs in their landscape until they wake up and find damage caused by hungry armadillos rooting into the soil to find their grubworm dinner.

Anyone concerned about grub damage can spot check their proper-



ty by digging square-foot holes about six inches deep in several locations. If there are fewer than five grubs per square foot, they are unlikely to cause significant harm to plants or turf grasses. Low numbers may even benefit plants by improving soil aeration and



permeability as they burrow. Some turf types can tolerate up to 15-20 grubs per square foot if the moisture and light requirements for them are met.

Integrated Pest Management (IPM) strategies are the best options to control grubs, allowing for the least environmental harm while protecting turf and plants. IPM methods are generally recognized as safe (GRAS) to use in food-growing spaces and provide localized control. Grub infestations tend to be in small areas, allowing efficient application of IPM. Some people smash or drown grubs as they find them. Others gather

grubs and place them in a feeder or a shallow pan for birds, toads, or lizards. Some choose to carefully follow directions to apply a specific beneficial nematode, Heterorhabditis bacteriophora, to kill grubs. Providing a welcoming environment for scoliid wasps that lay eggs inside the grubs, which feed their larvae, helps limit grub numbers, too.

Correctly timing IPM or the application of other grub controls is critical. Chemical controls are

most susceptible to early larval stages. Gardeners choosing chemical grub control have better success by applying a chemical control about five weeks after the peak June bug emergence.

## What comes after, 'I do?'

Marriage is more than a ceremony — it's a union of families and finances. When you and your partner are honest with each other about money and financial goals, it can help build trust, leverage your strengths and help pave the way for a financial happily ever after.

Since talking about money can be difficult, begin with conversations not so much about money itself but about the things that matter to you. You'll find these are also your financial priorities and a good way to see if you're

on the same page, or how far apart you might be.

### Here are a few conversation starters.

Make a list of short- and long-term goals — from buying a house to retiring early. Do you want children? Will one of you change careers or go back to school? See where your lists overlap and where some goals may be more important to one partner.

Ease into the financial implications. If you plan to grow your family, would one of you like to stop working or reduce your hours to provide child care? If more schooling is a priority, what kinds of changes might that require?

In nine community property states, all assets and debts are shared 50/50 after marriage regardless of individual or joint account status. Check to see whether yours is one of them.

Align on your budget and spending. This can empower you to spend within your means while moving toward your financial goals.

Determine who will handle the various tasks of managing money. Who is responsible for which

ills, who files the taxes and when will you consult each other on financial decisions like major purchases — a car, perhaps, or a major household appliance?

Once you're married, there are a few things to address right away. You may want to consult with financial, tax and legal professionals to help avoid pitfalls and identify opportunities.

Employer benefits. Newly married employees usually have a 30-day special enrollment period to update certain benefit elections — such as health and life insurance.

Adjust the W-4 tax withholding on your employee forms to reflect

your marital status and ask your tax professional which tax-filing status makes sense for you.

Insurance policies. Combine and update policies and beneficiaries, including adding each other to auto insurance policies if you drive each other's cars.

Estate documents. Now with a family, prepare for the unexpected. Create or update a will, medical directive, and financial and health care powers of attorney, and you may want to explore whether a revocable trust is appropriate.



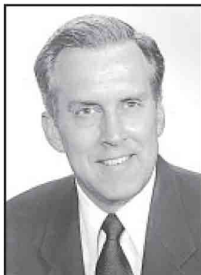

Sanger took a 1-0 series lead last Wednesday behind a 6-2 win, ambushing Speed early for five runs on five hits in the first two innings. The Lady Indians totaled six more hits over the next 20 innings.

Sanger was one-hit in Game 2, which featured seven scoreless innings and two lightning delays Friday before being postponed due to a lightning delay in the top of the eighth to finish Saturday

morning. After resuming play, Sulphur Springs got a two-out RBI single in the frame and held on through the bottom half to stave off elimination.

Sanger pitcher Leala Kloewer pitched a pair of strong games in defeat. The senior Daytona State signee struck out 10 while allowing just five hits, two walks and one hit batter across eight innings of work in Game 2, and followed that up by surrendering just three hits, two walks and one hit batter through six innings in the decider.

She gave up a total of three earned runs for the series while pitching all 21 innings, throwing more than 320 combined pitches in the trio of games.

"We left it on the field," Toby Kloewer said. "They played their hearts out. Defensively, we made the plays we needed to make, but when you get shut out two games in a row, it's hard to win."

"We just couldn't get the runs in when we needed them."

The loss ended Sanger's second consecutive trip to the regional final round of the playoffs. The Lady Indians were coming off a 2024 trip to the state semifinal round, their deepest postseason push since winning the 3A state championship in 2001.

The Lady Indians weathered an up-and-down start to peak in the playoffs, achieving another historic season in the process.

"I am so proud of every one of these girls," Toby Kloewer said. "We had a

rough start to the season. Everybody was expecting the world from us, and we didn't give that to 'em at the beginning of the year. They found a way to come together as a team and get it done."

"I'm so proud of them for that, more than anything, because it's a large weight to have on your shoulders of 'Hey, you guys made state last year and now we have to go do it again.' They handled it well, came together as a team, made it back to the regional finals and came up just a little short."

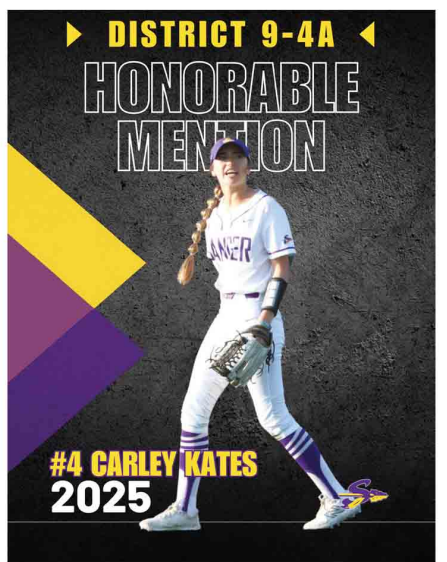
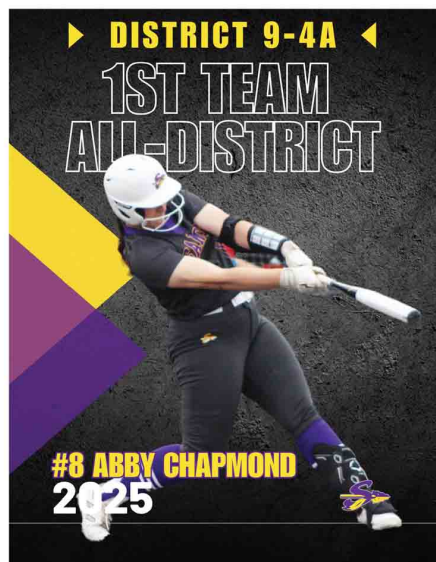
