## LOCAL MAY 4 ELECTION: Election for City Council, Mayor this Saturday, Bilyeu and Freeman vye for Place 2

Early voting ended in the Saturday, May 4, 2024 General Election for Mayor and Sanger City Council. Voting on election day will take place at the Sanger Community Center at 101 Freese Drive from 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. on Saturday.

Exactly 200 people early voted at the Sanger Community Center from April 22-29. Plus, 103 ballots were cast for the Sanger election at other Denton County Early Voting locations, as well. Without a Sanger School Board election, voting turnout is lower than normal.

Incumbent Thomas Muir and Jeffrey W. Jaracke, a retired fireman, will seek a 2-year term for Mayor. Muir has been Mayor since May of 2010 and this will be Jaracke's second time running for Mayor.

Councilmembers for Place 2 (incumbent Gary Bilyeu), a financial advisor will face Lisa Freeman. Place 4 (Allen Chick) is unopposed. Bilyeu has been on the council since May of 2010 and Chick (May of 2014). Freeman is a Cyber Security specialist.

There will not be an election for Sanger school

board. Sarah York, president of the Sanger school board has earned another 3-year term on Place 3. She is unopposed. Place 2 will be filled by Staci Moore, a retired Sanger school teacher. Ann Marie Afflerbach has been on the board since 2017 isn't running for another term on Place 2.

## Term vs. Perm: Which life insurance is right for you?

If you've been thinking about life insurance, especially if you have family, loved ones, or anyone who depends on you financially, you might be

curious about the different kinds of policies available. Which type is right for you?

Essentially, you can look at two main categories of life insurance: term

and permanent.

Term insurance is a pay-as-you-go option that covers a specific amount of time, usually 20 years or fewer. Term insurance benefits are paid to your beneficiaries free of federal income taxes if you pass away during the coverage period, but there's no opportunity to build cash value.

Permanent insurance, such as whole life or universal life, offers coverage for as long as you pay the premiums, and in addition to providing a tax-free

death benefit, also offers a chance to build equity, or cash value, on a tax-deferred basis.

When determining which type of insurance is appropriate for your needs, you'll want to consider these factors:

**Cost** – Term insurance is generally affordable for most people, which is why it may be particularly suitable for parents and young adults who may be at the beginning of their careers. Permanent insurance is typically more expensive, largely because it is meant to last for one's lifetime and some of the premiums go toward building cash value in the policy and paying for other features. Generally, the younger and healthier you are when you purchase permanent insurance, the lower your rates will be.

**Length of time insurance is needed** – If you think you will only need life insurance for a certain period — perhaps until your children are grown — you might lean toward term insurance. If you feel the need for life insurance for other goals throughout your lifetime, for whatever reason — you might have a special needs child, or perhaps you want to use your policy to help pay for retirement, or you wish to include the policy as part of your legacy and estate plans — you may want to

consider some type of permanent insurance.

**Investment preferences** – You may have heard the phrase “buy term and invest the difference.” Essentially, this just means that an investor could purchase low-cost term insurance, and then invest the money that was saved by not getting permanent insurance. This can be a valuable strategy in some situations, but people often don't actually invest the difference. A permanent insurance policy, through the payment of premiums, may result in a steady buildup of cash value or continued contributions to the policy's investment components. For many people, this discipline is helpful.

**Future insurability** – If you have health issues, it could become difficult to get permanent insurance after you've reached the end of a term insurance policy. (Some term insurance policies do offer the opportunity to convert to permanent coverage, usually without the need for a medical exam.) You could avoid this potential problem by purchasing permanent insurance when you are still young and healthy.

Ultimately, you will need to weigh the various factors involved in the permanent-versus-term decision. ### CITY OF SANGER, TEXAS ORDINANCE NO. 04-06-24

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SANGER TEXAS, TO IMPOSE AN ADDITIONAL PENALTY FOR COLLECTION COSTS; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING A CUMULATIVE CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. SECTION 1. There shall be imposed on delinquent property taxes and future delinquent PID assessments that become due or are delinquent on the dates described in 33.07, 33.08 and 33.11, Texas Property Tax Code, in the amount of compensation specified in the most recent contract entered into under 6.30, Texas Property Tax Code by the City of Sanger, with McCreary, Veselka, Bragg & Allen, P.C. for the collection of delinquent property taxes and delinquent PID assessments. Taxes that remain delinquent on July 1st, incur an additional penalty of twenty percent (20%) of the amount of taxes, penalty, and interest due; such an additional penalty is to defray costs of collection due to the contract with the City's attorney. This device reads your meter and then downloads the information to our water meter system. When these devices are hit by lawn mowers, weed eaters, etc., they can break, which prevents them from sending your water reads to our system. We are asking residents to be careful when mowing around these devices and to please inform your lawn care service if you use one. If your device becomes damaged, there is a \$115.38 fee to replace the meter.
