



Indians football play tough against Gainesville in district opener, lose homecoming game

Sanger lost its third consecutive game Friday as the Indians fell to Gainesville 45-31 at Sanger High School in their district opener.

Sanger came out strong and led for the first quarter, but the Indians had a hard time containing the Leopard's quick quarterback Cade Searcy.

London Daniels and Cade Searcy each scored two touchdowns Friday night to lead Gainesville (4-1) to a road win over Sanger (1-4).

Sanger took a 14-6 lead into the second quarter, only to face a 19-point onslaught and 25-14 Gainesville lead at halftime. The Leopards withstood a 17-point third quarter rally by the home team with three more second half touchdowns.

Sanger quarterback Reed Sebastian threw four touchdown passes, two long ones to Rece Faulkner and Barrett Beard and running back Luke Thompson caught two touchdown passes. Thompson had four receptions for 118 yards and rushed 15 times for 57 yards. Faulkner caught four passes for 101 yards and Beard (3-81 yards), to lead the Indians offense.




