

Demolition of FM 455 (Clear Creek Bridge) west of Bolivar begins Aug. 6, alternate route map provided by TxDOT

The Texas Department of Transportation FM 455 Bridge at Clear Creek project is set to begin on August 7, 2023. The bridge is located on FM 455 just west of 2450 in Bolivar (orange line) on the map to the right: There will be nighttime closures from 9 PM to 3 AM on the nights of August 6-15th for the setting of Rail and the Demolition (non-explosive means) of the existing bridge. During nighttime closures of the bridge/FM 455, a detour will be in place for traffic to utilize FM 2450 and Indian Trail and then use cross streets. The alternate routes are shown in purple. Drivers will be diverted on FM 2450 or Indian Trail roads and can cross at Davison or Michael roads.

During the Day, traffic will be moved to a single-lane/oneway traffic pattern using temporary signals on FM 455 over the bridge.

Nora Paulette Blakley


August 6, 1946 - July 26, 2023


Parks and Recreation Advisory Board

Denton Central Appraisal District received 132,000 property tax protests this year

The Denton Central Appraisal District received proved since last year. 132,000 property tax protests this year, up from about 100,000 last year, Chief Appraiser Don Spencer told county commissioners, recently.

"I do feel that the growth and the desirability of Denton County contributed a lot to the additional protests that were filed this year," Spencer said during last weeks Tuesday Commissioners Court meeting.

The appraisal district was able to get all property notices out by April 17, "which is a huge step toward a structured and more organized appeal process this year," Spencer said.

DCAD had a deadline of July 25 to certify total property valuations — or at least 95% of the total and send the numbers to taxing jurisdictions for their budget planning

Spencer said last week that DCAD had certified 98.4% of the taxable value to the taxing units of Denton

"We should wrap up the rest of the appeals by mid-August," Spencer said.

He told commissioners that the 2023 net taxable value in Denton County was just over \$177 billion, and that was across 470,000 parcels of property. Last year, the net taxable value was just under \$150 billion across 458,000 parcels.

"So that's a \$27 billion increase in taxable value, and about 12,000 added new parcels to the type to the appraisal roll," Spencer said.

Commissioners told Spencer that the relationship between the county and the appraisal district has im-







Sales Tax Holiday will take place Aug. 11-13

Additional charges affect the sales price - delivery, shipping, handling and transportation charges

The State Comptroller encourages all taxpayers to support Texas businesses while saving money on taxfree purchases of most clothing, footwear, school supplies and backpacks (sold for less than \$100) during the annual Tax-Free weekend. Qualifying items can be purchased tax free from a Texas store or from an online or catalog seller doing business in Texas. In most cases, you do not need to give the seller an exemption certificate to buy qualifying items tax free.

This year's sales tax holiday begins Friday, Aug. 11, and goes through midnight Sunday, Aug. 13.

The sales tax exemption applies only to qualifying items you buy during the sales tax holiday. Items you buy before or after the sales tax holiday do not qualify for exemption, and there is no tax refund available.

During the holiday you can buy qualifying items

in-store, online, by telephone, mail, custom order, or

any other means. The sale of the item must take place during the specific period. The purchase date is easy to determine when the purchase is made in-store but becomes more complicated with remote purchases. The purchaser must have given the consideration for the item during the period even if the item may not be delivered until after the period is over.

For example, if a purchaser enters their credit card School Supplies Purchased Using a Business Ac- information in an online shopping website on Sunday Aug. 13, 2023 at 5:00 p.m.to purchase qualifying school supplies, but the school supplies will not be shipped until Friday Aug. 18, 2023 and will not arrive until Tuesday Aug. 22, the purchase will still qualify for the exemption. However, if the charge to your credit card is declined by the payment processor at 11:00 p.m. on Sunday Aug. 13, 2023 and the purchaser does not resubmit payment until Monday Aug. 14, the purchase is taxable.

Additional Charges Affect the Sales Price

Delivery, Shipping, Handling and Transportation Charges Delivery, shipping, handling and transportation charges by the seller are part of the item's sales price.

Since clothing, backpacks and school supplies have to be less than \$100 to qualify, you have to look at the item's total sales price to determine if you can buy it tax

For example, you buy a pair of jeans for \$95 with a \$10 delivery charge for a total price of \$105. Because the jeans' total price is more than \$100, tax is due on the entire \$105 price.

If a delivery charge is billed per item, and an invoice has both exempt and taxable items, only the qualifying exempt item's delivery charge is exempt.

If the delivery charge is a flat rate per package, and the amount charged is the same regardless of how many items are included in the package, the total charge can be attributed to any one of the items in the package.

Sales Tax Holiday Refund Requests

If you pay sales tax on qualifying items during the sales tax holiday, you can ask the seller for a refund of the tax paid. The seller can either grant the refund or provide their customer with Form 00-985, Assignment to Right to Refund (PDF), which allows the purchaser to file the refund claim directly with the Comptroller's


