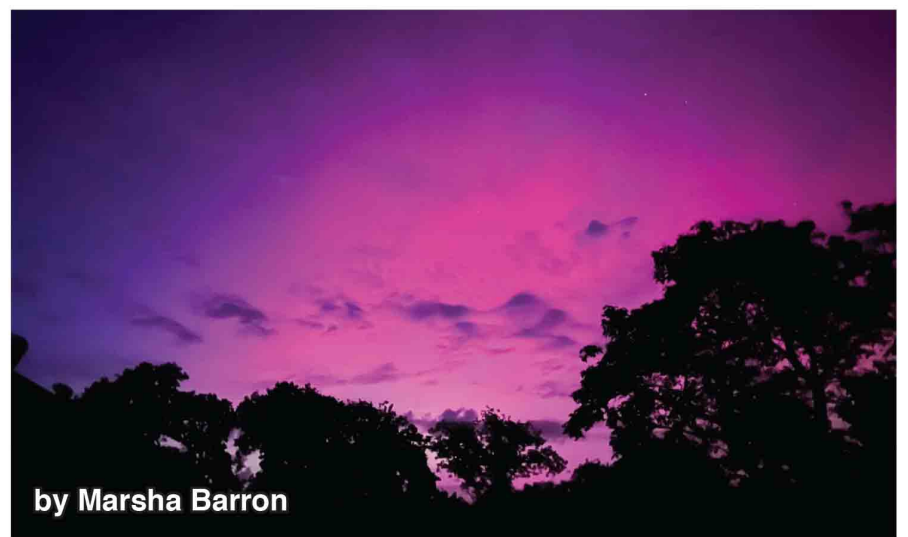

Three local residents shared their stunning photos of the display. Amy Weber Hart got her pictures between 1:30-1:45 a.m., on Saturday. Tim Hendrix got some great shots from his backyard in Bolivar, as well as Marsha Barron with their cell phones. They all three shared their pictures on The Sanger Speaker Facebook page. The newer cell phone cameras are more sensitive to light than our eyes, they're sometimes able to capture auroras we can't see. People around the world were given the opportunity to witness a dazzling display of the Northern Lights after the Earth was impacted by a historic geomagnetic storm last Friday. DCAD expects 100,000 property owners to challenge valuations

The Denton Central Appraisal District has received about 40,000 protests as of Friday last Friday and expected to have about 100,000 property owners challenging their appraised values by the May 15 deadline — this Wednesday. Homeowners who wanted to file a protest needed to do so by Wednesday. The appraisal district faces a July 20 deadline to certify total property valuations — or at least 95% of the total — and send the numbers to Denton County taxing jurisdictions for their budget planning. Chief Appraiser Don Spencer said roughly about 134,000 protests were filed

last year. Spencer said that about 65% to 70% of protests are filed by property tax agents, usually by the deadline. Spencer said he expects over 100,000 protests. Spencer said it was up to the individual on how they choose to protest but said online is easier to do so. As of last Friday morning, about 17,000 online protests have been filed, with about 4,200 protests being resolved. "It's definitely a little bit easier, I think, to do it from the comfort of your home, filing online," Spencer said. How does the process work? Homeowners pres-

ent an opinion that supports their protest. These can be uploaded through the eFile portal or presented in person. Helpful opinion evidence includes a fee-based or bank appraisal, closing statement, current photos with date stamps, estimates for repair or any other documentation relevant to the protest. Once DCAD receives the protest form, an appraiser reviews the protest and contact the homeowner to schedule an appraisal review board hearing by phone, video call or in person at the DCAD building. Check email or mail for status reviews. A homeowner can

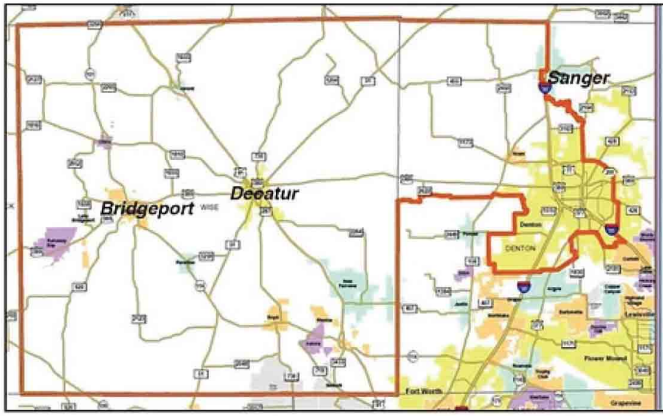

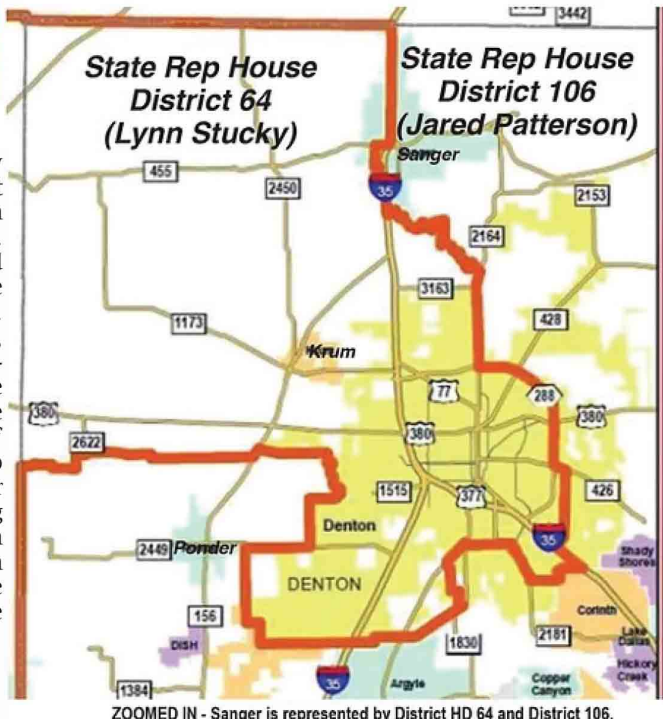

far south as Florida and Texas in the southern U.S. has finally started to wane.

The sky around the world was filled with brilliant colors of green, pink, purple and red from the Northern Lights on Friday and Saturday after a massive sunspot the width of 17 Earths spewed solar flares, leading to the geomagnetic storm activity reaching Level 5 "extreme" conditions.

Some North Texans got a chance to see the northern lights due to the rare extreme solar storm, but many are asking why the lights were pink instead of green. To explain, you have to know a bit about how auroras are formed.

When energized particles from the sun hit Earth's upper atmosphere the planet's magnetic field then directs the particles towards our poles.

When particles enter the atmosphere they then super-charge the electrons in the different gases. Those molecules then release the energy as light.

The different elements in the atmosphere that give off the light give off different colors.

Green is the most common color in an aurora because that is the color given off when there is a high concentration of oxygen.

An unusually strong solar storm hitting Earth was able to produce northern lights across parts of the U.S. and the world.

The lights in North Texas were very high in the

atmosphere, where there is a low concentration of oxygen. That gave off the red and pink hue that some saw on Friday night.

If you are in an area seeing purples and blues, that is at a very low altitude, where the concentration of nitrogen is high.

send a property tax agent, friend or family member to represent them in a hearing.

If the individual has hired a licensed agent, the homeowner must submit an Appointment of Agent for Property Tax Matters form. If they send a friend or family member, they had to fill out a Non-Agent Representation form.

The final step is the hearing with the appraisal review board to determine the appraisal's standing. If there is not an agreement made prior to their scheduled hearing, the homeowner will need to proceed with their appraisal review board hearing at the scheduled date and time.

The appraisal review board will request hard copies of the evidence for all hearings, and only the submitted evidence will be reviewed.

A notice of protest hearing will be mailed to an individual at least 14 days before the scheduled hearing, including details on the exact time and location of the phone or video hearing. Expect a two-hour window for all phone and video hearings.
