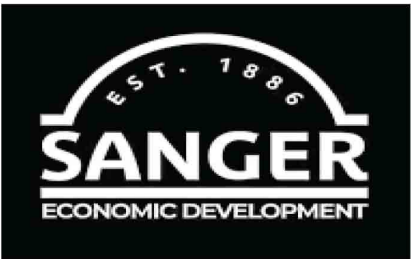

The Sanger Economic Development Corporation is proud to welcome several new businesses that will soon be coming to Sanger. These additions reflect the city's continued growth and increasing demand for expanded retail, dining, and service options.



Exciting Update: Stephen Baker Statue Fundraising

The Stephen Baker Bronze Statue was ordered January 6, 2026. In addition to his athleticism, Stephen Baker is remembered for his steadfast moral compass and his commitment to ethical principles. Although many who knew Stephen in the early years of the 50s and 60s are no longer with us, Stephen's memory still lives within the friends and classmates that remain and the community who have learned about Stephen.

Sanger ISD has renamed the current football field "Stephen Baker Field at Indian Stadium" as a tribute to a young man who exemplified character, integrity and compassion. He will not be forgotten as the young man who lost his life playing football for the Indian team but forever remembered as an upstanding young man in all aspects of life.

In early 2025, a committee of Stephen's classmates, in association with the Sanger Historical Society, began its fund-raising for a memorial bronze statue. At that time the quote from the bronze casting company totaled \$92K. It's now 10+ months later, and increased materials prices have pushed the total to \$97.5K. "We are about \$18.4K from the final amount required for the statue and installation. We will no doubt reach this goal, but to those that have not previously donated, we are asking for your consideration to help end this funding drive quickly," stated Tona Batis of the Statue Committee.

Steps of the process of creating and receiving delivery of the statue are as follows:

1. Payment of \$20K was issued at time of contract signing (1-6-26). Committee visited Schaefer Art Bronze on 1-6-26 to review contract and processes. Their website may be visited at Schaeferartbronze.com. This company built the statue located at the current middle school (previously high school).

2. Maquette (small model of statue) prepared by artist will be reviewed by committee and approved. After approval another \$20K payment will be issued. Note: the committee will have the option of making any changes necessary to the maquette and will revisit once changes have been made. Committee has complete approval rights before statue goes to next stage.

3. Enlargement of the statue to 7'6" in size will be approved based upon maquette approval by committee. At this time a payment of \$40K will be issued.

4. Statue is completed and approved by the committee and is ready for delivery. \$13K is paid at this time.

5. Delivery and installation time and date will be determined. \$4.5K due at the time of installation. As a note, if our committee is able to provide a lift device for the installation, Schaefer Art Bronze will deduct \$1K from the installation costs.

This bronze statue will then become the property of the Sanger ISD. An unveiling date and time will be set and an event for the unveiling will be announced for the community to attend the unveiling.

"We appreciate everyone that has joined in on this with their donations. We encourage everyone to become a part of this historic memorial which will remain a part of the Sanger ISD complex," added Batis

Places up for City and School Board Elections

The first day to file for council/mayor seats for the City of Sanger and school board trustees was Wednesday, January 14, 2026. Election Day will be Saturday, May 2, 2026 and early voting TBA. Open places on the council are Place 2 - Gary Bilyeu and Place 4 - Allen Chick. Bilyeu has been on the council since 2010 and Chick's first term started in 2014. Mayor Thomas Muir announced last week he will not seek another term. He's been Mayor since May of 2010.

Sanger ISD has three places on the ballot: Place 7 - Bruce Elsey, Place 6 - Mitch Hammonds and Place 1 - Jarrod Roberts.

The last day to file is Friday, February 13 at the close of business. Applications are available at City Hall and Sanger ISD Administration buildings.



He served there for 20 years, positively impacting the lives of countless students.

He loved cooking dishes from around the world, smoking and grilling meats, hunting, fishing, woodworking, and reading fantasy and historical-fiction books. He had a keen eye for vintage tools, often exploring pawn shops to find tools, many of which he sold through his eBay business, where he was once a top seller. Steve had a deep love for animals, especially his dog Crystal, who heroically saved him from a house fire. A devoted pet parent, he spoiled his three dogs and cherished his grandkitty, often making pet snack trays and creating cat toys for them. Above all, Steve treasured time with his family and traveling. He particularly loved trips to Camden, Maine, where he spent countless summers, and cruising, with Alaska holding a special place in his heart.



Steve is survived by his wife, Cindy Erdman; his daughter, Haven Melott, and son-in-law, Lane Melott; a granddaughter expected in April, whom Steve was eagerly anticipating; his brother, Peter Erdman, and sister-in-law, Rebecca, along with their children, Alexander and Adelaide; his sister-in-law, Terri Patton and his nephew-in-law, Casey Patton. 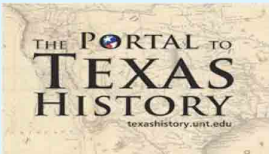

New tax laws for 2026 that you should know

The new year brings more than resolutions and fresh starts; it also ushers in several tax changes that could affect your wallet. Whether you're saving for retirement, funding your child's education or supporting your favorite charity, here's are a few things you need to know about the tax landscape in 2026.

More room to save for retirement and healthcare. There's good news for savers: Contribution limits for retirement accounts are going up. If you're under 50, you can now contribute up to \$7,500 to an IRA, which is up from \$7,000 in 2025. Those 50 and older can contribute an additional \$1,100, for a total of \$8,600.

The limits for 401(k), 403(b) and governmental 457(b) plans are also increasing, with workers younger than 50 able to defer up to \$24,500. Visit IRS.gov and search "401k limit increases" for an article outlining the details.

Health savings account limits are rising too. In 2026, individual coverage increased to \$4,400 and family coverage to

\$8,750. If you are age 55 or older and are not enrolled in Medicare, you can contribute an additional \$1,000 as a catch-up contribution.

The start of the year is an ideal time to review your contributions and consider increasing them, even by small amounts which can add up over time.

A catch-up rule for high earners. If you're 50 or older and earned more than \$150,000 last year, there's a new wrinkle in your retirement planning. You can still make catch-up contributions to your workplace retirement plan, but they must now be Roth contributions rather than traditional pre-tax contributions. This includes 401(k), 403(b) and 457(b) plans.

While you won't get an immediate tax break, Roth contributions offer tax-free income in retirement and can provide a tax-free legacy for your heirs.

Expanded benefits for 529 education plans. Families using 529 plans to cover K-12 expenses will see the annual federal distribution limit double from \$10,000 to \$20,000 per student. The definition of qualifying expenses has also expanded to include curriculum, books, certain tutoring expenses and testing fees.

This change provides more flexibility for families with overfunded plans and increases options for managing education costs across multiple children or beneficiaries.

New charitable giving provisions. The rules around charitable deductions are shifting in two directions. Taxpayers who take the standard deduction can now deduct up to \$1,000 in cash donations (\$2,000 for joint filers) to qualified organizations.

However, those who itemize deductions face a new threshold: only charitable contributions exceeding 0.5% of adjusted gross income are now deductible. Donors may want to consider bunching strategies or using donor-advised funds to maximize their tax benefits.

Getting help. Navigating these tax changes can be challenging, but you don't have to go it them alone. A qualified financial advisor and tax professional can help you understand how these and other changes affect your specific situation. Together, you can develop strategies to make the most of new opportunities while minimiz-
