

Sanger Police Chief resigns

Sanger Police Chief Waylan Rhodes resigned last Friday without notice, citing difficulties with the department.

Rhodes told the Denton Record-Chronicle Saturday morning he intended for the Sanger Police Department to be his last place of employment, but heading the department was unusually difficult.

“It’s been anything but a good experience,” Rhodes said. “ ... This was my last hurrah. It’s disheartening that it turned out to be a challenge from the get-go.”

He insinuated some personnel seemed resistant to administrative and cultural changes he wanted to make for the better, he said, and would resign from the department even though he hadn’t written them up. Some officers left for higher paying positions at larger police departments or sheriff’s offices. And, some left because of Rhodes’ leadership style.

Rhodes said he has accepted a few interim police chief opportunities. He will be moving over the weekend to the Austin area, where he

said he has family living.

The city of Sanger did not have a comment as of Wednesday morning before the Sanger News press deadline.

Assistant Chief of Police Jonathan Perkins retired last month after 20 years on the force. He was also the interim chief for almost a year before Rhodes was hired.

On November 30, 2021 the City of Sanger announced Rhodes as their new Chief of Police. Rhodes was chosen from a pool of 38 qualified applicants from across the nation in a search for a successor to 36-year Sanger Police Veteran, Chief Curtis Amyx.

Rhodes brought more than 35 years of community-based law enforcement. Rhodes attended McNeese State University in Lake Charles, LA, where he studied Criminal Justice. He holds certifications from the Law Enforcement Management Institute of Texas, FBI National Academy, FBI Command College, and TPCAF Executive Leadership.

Rhodes most recently served as the Interim Chief for the City of Beeville. Prior experience includes Chief of Police for Silsbee, TX, and Chief of Police in Little Elm, Texas.

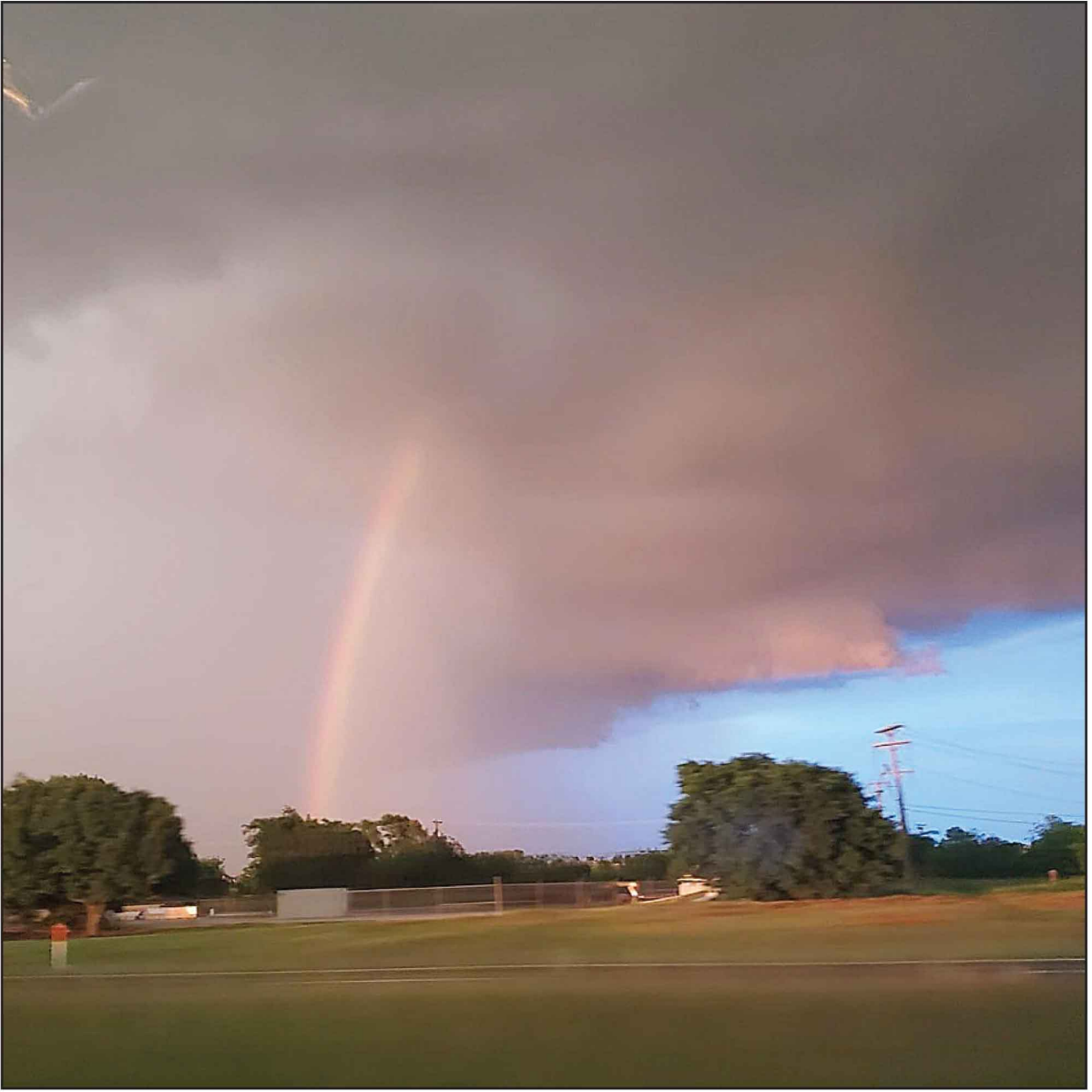
Rhodes’ official start date with the City was Monday, January 3, 2022.

Corinne Kerbs Sadau

Corinne Kerbs Sadau, 91, of Joshua, Texas passed away on May 13, 2023, in Fort Worth, Texas. She was born in Shattuck, Oklahoma on June 9, 1931, to Huldreich and Emma Kerbs. She lived in various places; Higgins, Texas, Coweta, Oklahoma and White City, Kansas. Her father was a farmer and rented different farms and they moved around a lot. Her family then moved to Sacramento, California on her 14th birthday; her father got a job with Union Pacific Railroad driving heavy machinery. Corinne attended Jr. High and High School in Sacramento. She then attended one year of college at Pacific Union College and worked in Sacramento, California for the Department of Interior Region II as a secretary for four years.

In 1951 Corinne moved to D.C. to work for George Mathews, the Seventh-day Adventist Church Secretary in the Department of Education, for three years. Corinne and her future husband, Carl, were visiting mutual friends in D.C. who introduced them in 1952.



They corresponded off and on for a year and then reconnected in 1953 and continued writing to each other. They saw each other twice during that time and decided that long distance did not work, so Corinne moved to Keene, Texas, and got a job as secretary to Southwestern Adventist Junior College President, Conard Rees. Carl lived in Sanger, Texas and would drive down to Keene to see Corinne and she would drive to Sanger to see him. They married on September 30, 1956 in Sacramento, California. Corinne then moved to Sanger with Carl and lived and worked on the family farm where they raised their three daughters, Lynne, Carla and Sharon.

Carl and Corinne lived in Sanger until 2012 when they decided to move to Joshua to be closer to more family as they were aging. Corinne and Carl remained married to each other for 61 years until Carl's death on December 27, 2017.

Corinne is survived by her daughters, Lynne Anger and husband, Charles of Gainesville, Texas, Carla House of Cleburne, Texas, and Sharon Wahlenmaier of Cleburne, Texas, brother, Raymond Kerbs of Jacksonville, Florida, seven grandchildren: Tonja, Denise, Hailey, Steven, Dillon, Alex and Ashton, ten great-grandchildren, and many beloved nieces, nephews and cousins.

Bill DeBerry

Bill DeBerry of Denton, entered into Gods eternal care on May 13, 2017. He was born in Whistler, Alabama to Edmond Clyburn and Ella Nora (Briggs) DeBerry.

The family moved to Galveston, Texas in 1948, a short time later Edmond died. Bill quit school and went to work at various odd jobs to help support the family. Bill was a lifeguard in Galveston beach until he went to work for J. Levy Funeral Home in Galveston driving an ambulance assisting with funerals. During his time in Galveston Bill was known as "Scooter" although his mother called him "Buddy". He was one of the best pool players on the island and made extra money hustling pool. Mr. Levy convinced him to go back to school. At age 21, he went back to a Catholic High School driving the school bus to cover his tuition and graduated. His mother raised him as a Catholic to insure he was able to receive the proper education, after moving to Denton he later joined St. David of Wales Episcopal Church.

He moved to Denton, Texas in 1958 to attend the University of North Texas. He went to work for J.B. Floyd at Schmitz-Floyd-Hamlett Funeral home. While working for J.B. Floyd, he went to the Dallas Institute of Mortuary Services and began his lifelong career in

Denton of over 59 years.

He married Juanita Clampitt in 1960 and had three children; Bill DeBerry Jr., Jennifer DeBerry and Andrew DeBerry. He later married Betty Foshee in 1970. Bill was a fan of old Blues Music and Waylon Jennings. You could walk in the house and hear the likes of Son House, Howling Wolf, Muddy Waters, Waylon, Willie and Meryl to name a few, playing on the record or 8 track player.

He worked for J.B. for many years and later for Bob Schmitz at Jack Schmitz and Son Funeral Home. At the time Bob retired, Bill went back to work for J.B. Floyd until the fall of 1988 when Bill made a huge commitment to open his own funeral home in Denton in 1990. At that time very few people thought that he could actually make it work. Those that did believe in him supported him whole heartily. Bill Jr worked a full time job and in his time off helped Bill Sr. at the funeral home Betty and Andrew helped where they could.

In his 64 years in the Funeral Service Bill dedicated himself to the families he served, and the community in and around Denton. He touched so many lives and will certainly be missed.

He is survived by his sons, Bill DeBerry Jr. and wife Mary Ann of Denton, Andrew DeBerry and wife Nichole of Krum, and daughter, Jennifer DeBerry Evans and husband John of San Marcos his grandchildren, William "Justin" DeBerry, Erin Nicole DeBerry and Jessica Lynn DeBerry all of Sanger, Cody and Tyler Evans of San Marco, step-grandchildren, Alyssa and Damian Perez of Krum, one great-grandson, William "Waylon" DeBerry, and extended family members with an enormous amount of friends.

Public Open House for Regional Outer Loop In Denton County Study announced

Loop will connect from I-35 to the Dallas North Tollway

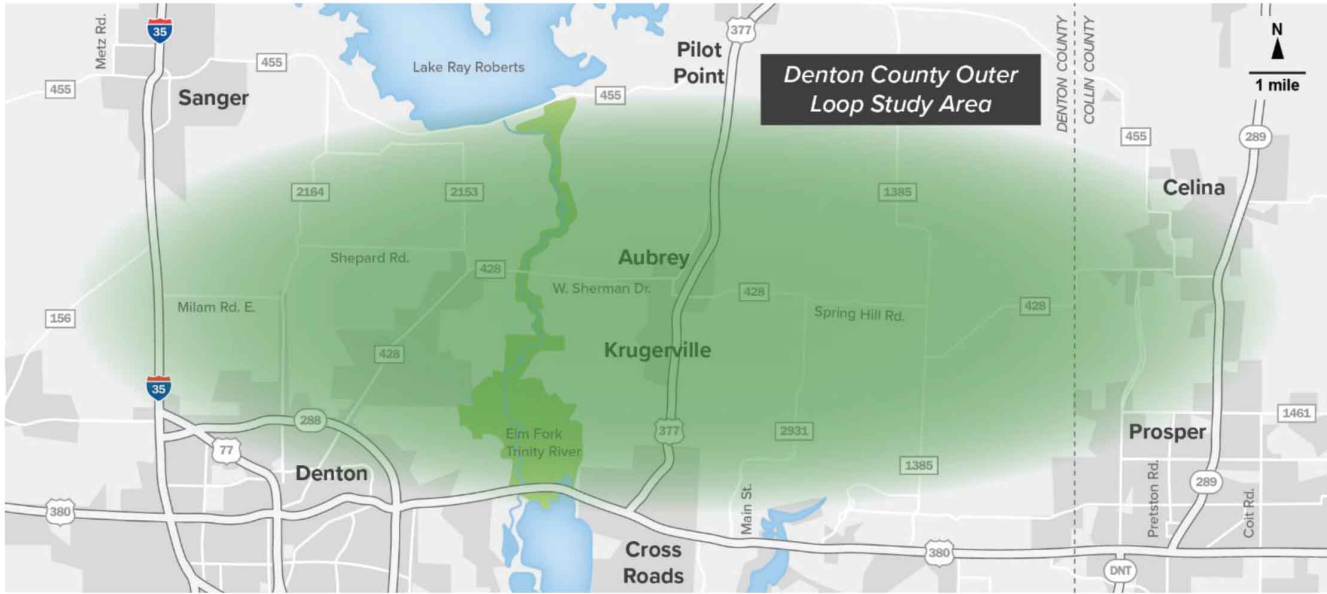
To accommodate increasing growth in the region, Denton County and the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) have partnered to study a potential new location east-west freeway portion of the Regional Outer Loop in Denton County extending approximately 23 miles from I-35 to the Dallas North Tollway in Denton County, Texas. This notice advises the public that Denton County will be conducting in-person and virtual public open house meetings to share information about the project and potential alignments under consideration. Part of the study area includes property south of Sanger from Rector and Milam Roads and southeast of Sanger.

The in-person public meetings will begin at 4 p.m. and will follow an open house format where the public may come and go at their convenience until 7 p.m. Staff will be available to answer questions and take comments. Materials presented will be the same at each public meeting.

The virtual meeting can be viewed beginning Thursday, May 18, 2023 starting at 8 a.m., through Thursday, June 22 at 11:59 p.m. The virtual public meeting materials will be posted to the project website at www.DentonCountyOuterLoop.com and will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation that includes both audio and video components, along with other exhibits. The virtual public meeting is not a live event.

The purpose of the meetings is to present information on the study and the potential project alignments under consideration and receive public feedback. The study, which is just beginning, will take three to four years to complete and will identify potential routes for a new location roadway. Transportation projects require years of advanced planning and development, which is why the county must plan now for the growth it expects in the next 30 years. No decisions have been made about a final alignment.

The proposed project is needed to improve connectivity in northeast Denton County and the DFW metroplex and to accommodate increasing population growth. Anticipated traffic demand in this area is expected to lead to operation-

al deficiencies and congestion over time. Ultimately, this study will allow Denton County to preserve the land needed for the corridor to protect it from future development.

The proposed project would, subject to final design considerations, require additional right-of-way and potentially displace residences and/or non-residential structures. The proposed project may involve construction in wetlands and an action in a floodplain.

The in-person and virtual public meetings will be conducted in English. 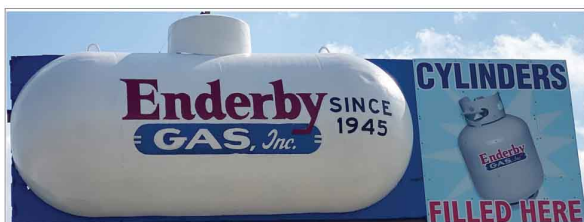
