## Save water now to ensure future supply

The Texas Water Development Board in its 2020 Report found that almost 50% of water use in North Central Texas is for single-family residences with a high usage uptick in the summer to water our lawns and landscape plants. With the rapid population growth in Collin and Denton housing, it is obvious that we will need more water reserves or face usage restrictions. To have enough water, we can build more reservoirs, modify existing infrastructure or implement conservation practices. According to their report, "Of all the identified strategies to ensure our future water supply, conservation is often the least expensive."

How can you conserve water and save money?

"Over 50% of landscape water is wasted due to overwatering, inefficient watering practices and broken or poorly maintained irrigation systems." (Upper Trinity Regional Water District) To optimize an irrigation system's performance, owners should routinely check the heads for breakage, clogging or missing heads. Check the water pressure and coverage at each head. You may want to use a certified irrigation inspector for the component check that should include the isolation and drain valve, backflow and zone devices, sensors and control panel.

Whether you are cre-

ating a new landscape or are adding plants to an existing one, select plants that are water smart, meaning they are comfortable growing under North Central Texas typical conditions and do not require excessive supplemental water. For ideas on which plants are attractive and sustainable, see the evaluations in the Texas Smartscape plant database (<http://www.txsmartscape.com/plant-search/>). And, check out the Texas Superstar® Plants (<https://texassuperstar.com/plants/>) list for expert assessments of growing success and relatively low water needs.

Do not water too much or too often. Generally, one inch of water per week is all that is needed to keep your landscape healthy and beautiful, except during the hottest weeks of summer. If you are using an overhead sprinkler rather than an irrigation system, check the amount of water delivered with a simple can test. Place several small empty cans around the area being watered. Cat food or tuna cans work well for this. Note the start time. Run the sprinkler until the cans are full, meaning one inch of water in the can. How long did that take? That's the amount of time you should set your sprinkler to water that area.

If you have a dedicated vegetable, herb or landscaped area, consider adding a drip irrigation

system, which uses less water than a sprinkler. A typical drip system includes isolation and control valves, a backflow preventer, filter, adapter, emitters, connecting pipe and tubing. The drip tubing lays on the ground in your bed with emitters placed by the plants or evenly spaced. Adding a three-inch layer of mulch around your vegetable and landscape plants also reduces water consumption by retaining moisture and moderating soil temperatures so that less water is lost to evaporation.

Let's all do our part to save water and save money!

## Avoid these estate planning mistakes

or a health care directive. Now, let's consider a few estate-planning mistakes:

Not communicating your plans. You'll need to inform your family about whom you've chosen as executor – the individual who will administer your estate – and whom you've named as the trustee – the person who will manage your trust's assets. (You can also choose a trust company to handle this duty.) And to help avoid unpleasant surprises when your estate is being settled, consider letting your children or other close relatives know who will be receiving what.

Not reviewing your plans periodically – Once you create your estate plans, don't forget about them. Over time, your personal situation may change – you may experience a remarriage or bring in new children. Your interests may change, too – perhaps you'll become deeply involved in

supporting a favorite charitable organization. Given these and other potential changes, you'll want to review your estate plans once in a while to see if they need to be modified.

Not updating beneficiary designations – Every so often, you may want to review the beneficiary designations on your life insurance policies, investment accounts and retirement assets. As mentioned, changes in your life, such as remarriage and the addition of new children, may affect your beneficiaries. Beneficiary designations are powerful and can even supersede your will, so you'll want to update them as needed. Also, if you have a 529 education savings plan, you'll want to name a successor owner – someone who can take over your 529 if you were to pass away.

Not re-registering assets placed in a trust – A living trust offers you many potential benefits, such as the abil-

ity to bypass the time-consuming and highly public process of probate when it's time to settle your estate. However, just establishing the trust, by itself, may be insufficient – you likely also need to re-register assets, such as your investments, so they are officially owned by the trust, not by you. This is essential for the trust to work as you intended.

Here's one other mistake – not getting the help you need. Estate planning can be complex, so you'll want to work with an attorney, and possibly with your financial advisor and tax professional, too.

By avoiding key mistakes and working with a qualified team of professionals, you can create and maintain an estate plan that will help you leave the legacy you desire.

## SANGER’S SISTER COMMUNITY - BOLIVAR

Submitted by Sanger Area Historical Society

Bolivar, a small community, approximately five miles west of Sanger, was the original thriving location in northwestern Denton County. The settlement was on Clear Creek, and because of plenty of good water and timber, it became a popular location for people moving west. The Chisolm Trail ran just west of Bolivar, and a need for a community to serve the needs of these trail riders began to flourish. There were routes to the west for those in search of gold. Trading posts were set up along these routes where there could be protection from hostile Indians as they were pushed farther and farther west.

In the late 1840s and early 1850s, the little village that would become Bolivar had 50 to 60 permanent residents. Because the Indian populations were moving westward, the federal government built a fort in 1852, and Bolivar was born. The settlement was close to Clear Creek. Dr. Daily built the first store; a doctor, Methodist preacher, and a carpenter soon followed. Dr. Daily laid out streets to run north and south. When referring to “Main Street,” it is now called FM 2450, while First Street is now FM 455.

The town was named New Prospect by Daily. Ben F. Brown had located to the area from Bolivar, Tennessee, and proposed the new name of Bolivar. An election was held, and the Tennessean exchanged mugs of rum for votes for the winner of the new name of Bolivar. Bolivar began to flourish and at one time had four churches, a school building, two hotels, a flour mill, a blacksmith, two stage-lines coming through, and a sawmill and cotton gin.

Jesse Sartin opened the Sartin Hotel, which had a flowing water well in the lobby with his saloon nearby. Other businesses and owners were:

During the early years the Indians were prevalent in the area of Bolivar. During an Indian raid on October 30, 1868, A.H. Fortenberry, a farmer and stock raiser, was killed. It is believed he was the last fatality in the area. After this raid, about 1860, a group of settlers in the area drove the Indians to

the Fort Sill area, where they were placed by the Federal Government.

Mr. P.A. Lughinbyhl tells of his father's part in this Indian raid. “The Indian raiders were sighted early in the morning. Demesey Jackson gave the alarm. Chris Lughinbyhl was building the Keep and Terry Mill, a well-known early landmark on the Mill Branch of Clear Creek. The mill was the first grist mill in this part of Denton County. In October 1868, Chris Lughinbyhl was working on the mill and heard the sound of Indians. He quickly hid in the shavings and lumber piles until they passed. In a few minutes, the posse came by, which was following the Indians. Lughinbyhl immediately got his horse, which luckily was overlooked by the Indians traveling in haste, and rode with the men, about 100 in number, who followed the Indians as far south as Denton-Decatur Road where they turned and headed back for Indian Territory.” The Denton Record-Chronicle published a special edition in 1958 listing the men on this ride. Chris Luginbyhl was not named in the article. Lughinbyhl died on May 28, 1910, according to the ledger of the Dr. G.D. Lain.



The Bolivar Baptist Church, shown in 1958, was organized in 1883. The historic cemetery is located on the eastern side of this church building, with many families of original settlers buried there.

A settler riding hard to join the posse was not so lucky. A.H. Fortenberry was killed on a prairie north of White's Creek just before he was to join the posse. Fortenberry served in the War Between the States as a Confederate soldier. He was one of a company of 30 men who followed 300 Indians in the northwest part of Denton County. In an article published in Fort Worth and the Texas Northwest, Volume 4, p. 454, the daughter of A.J. Fortenberry (then Mrs. Jane Howard) says the number of Indians was 600; they “scalped him, piled grass on his body, and burned him to death.”

Jack Waide was a loyal historian of

the Waide family. His records can be found at the Sanger Area Historical Society Museum. During his visits, he would tell the story of his family's horses being stolen by the Indians. These horses were later found during a raid of an Indian campsite, and the government took them. Waide attempted to be compensated for these horses

up until his death in August of 2020. Jack had a letter from the U.S. Government acknowledging they had the horses and the Waide family would be reimbursed; he never received any payment.

Bolivar has a rich history in the northwestern Denton County area. Many good families settled in this small community, and detailed information about these families was published by Rheba Marshall and Frances Abelson, which may be found at the SAHS Museum.

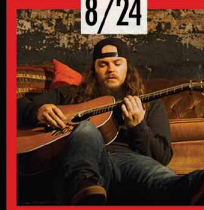

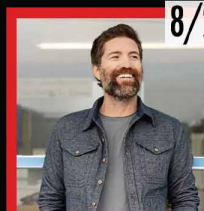

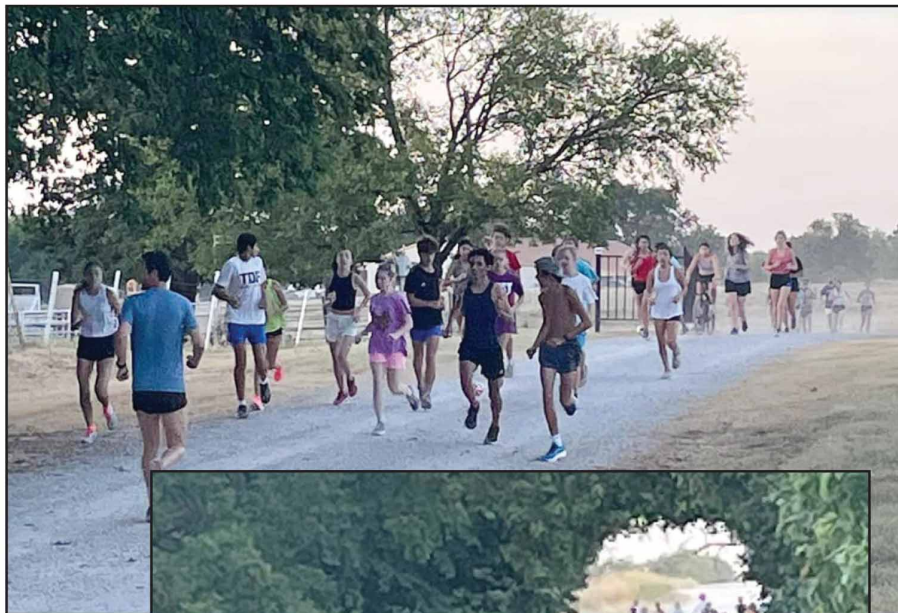

## 2022 - 2023 Returning Student Enrollment Grades PreK -12

Returning student registration is open! All students who were enrolled at any time during the 2021-2022 school year can be registered by logging in to the Parent Portal. If your student is a returning student, you already have a Parent Portal account created. There is no need to create a new one. You simply need to make sure your student is linked to your account prior to completing the Returning Student registration process. Additionally, if you are enrolling a new student but already have a student in the district, you do not need to create a new Parent Portal account. You will just add the new student to your existing account. Every student must register through a Parent Portal account.

You will be asked to upload the following documents throughout the course of the registration process. Your registration will not be complete until all documents have been uploaded or received. You can upload documents in several formats, including a picture that you take with your cell phone (jpg/jpeg). To be able to complete registration, you will need to upload these documents:

- Parent Identification (Valid Photo ID; Driver's license, Passport, Permanent Resident Card or Naturalization Papers)
- Proof of Residency – a current utility bill (the most current bill is required: credit card & cell phone bills, & driver's license not accepted); lease agreement; closing documents on a home; tax or mortgage statement on a home, or a notarized letter stating that the family is living with a Sanger ISD resident along with that resident's proof of residency.
- Most current immunization records

If you cannot upload your documents, you can drop them off at your student's campus. Please be sure to provide us with a copy as we cannot return originals. If you need access to a copier, we can assist you at the campus in which you drop off your documents.



## 2022 - 2023 New Student Enrollment Grades PreK -12

New student registration is open! If you already have a student enrolled, go to your existing account, and click My Account in the top right corner; do not create a new account for them. Click Enroll New Student to begin. Every student must register through a Parent Portal account. PreK Registration information can be found at the PreK Program website.

If you do not have another child enrolled, you will create a new account in the Parent Portal; to do this, you must have an email address. You will need to verify the email account you enter prior to being able to enroll your child(ren), so be sure you are using an email you have access to at the time of registration.

You will be asked to upload the documents below. Your registration will not be complete until all documents have been loaded or received. You can upload documents by either scanning them or taking a picture of them with your phone.

- Parent Identification (Valid Photo ID; Driver's license, Passport, Permanent Resident Card or Naturalization Papers)
- Student's Immunization Record
- Student's last report card and withdrawal forms, if available
- Proof of Residency – current utility bill (electric, gas, or water); lease agreement; closing documents on a home; tax or mortgage statement on a home, or a notarized letter stating that the family is living with a Sanger ISD resident along with that resident's proof of residency.
- 2 forms of ID – These will need to be from the following list: original birth certificate; driver's license; passport; report card from the previous school; Social Security card; Military ID; hospital birth record; adoption records; Foster Care form 2085
