Sanger and Valley View communities in shock after Kemp's motorcycle accident

Two Valley View residents and Sanger business owners were killed Sunday evening when their motorcycle was hit by a pickup truck at a rural intersection in Cooke County.

The Texas Department of Public Safety said 45-year-old Robert Kemp was driving the Harley Davidson west on FM 922 between Tioga and Valley View with Heather Kemp, 43, as his passenger.

Trooper C. said the pickup, driven by 61-year-old William Hawk of Collinsville, failed to yield the right-of-way at the stop sign at County Road 215 and collided with the motorcycle.

Robert and Heather Kemp died at the scene. Hawk was not injured.

DPS said the investigation continues and that no additional information was available.

The news of the tragic accident has sent shockwaves through the communities of Sanger and Valley View, leaving friends, family, co-workers and employees in mourn-





> You may set out approximately the equivalent of up to three (3) recliners on your second weekly collection day for small bulk pick-up.

Acceptable Items Include:

Unacceptable Items Include:

Roofing shingles, concrete, brick, rock, dirt, paint or other hazardous chemicals, tires, building material from remodeling and auto parts.
