Whether you're going to be out of the county or you have conditions that make vou more susceptible to catching COVID-19, mail-in and absentee voting is an option that's steadily increased in popularity over the last two decades, according to MIT's Election Data.

Texans who are registered to vote can mail in their ballots if they are 65 years or older, jailed but still eligible to vote or if they have a disability or illness. Being out of the county you're registered to vote is another qualification to request a ballot by mail.

Prospective voters must submit an Application for Ballot by Mail by printing one from the Texas Secretary of State's office website or submit an online order to have one mailed to them, and then send the application in time so it can reach the Early Voting Clerk by Oct. 23 — 11 days before Election Day.

The application will ask for a person's name, residence address and address to mail the ballot to. The application asks voters to state their reason for voting by mail.

The application also asks if voters want to apply to vote by mail for only one election, future elections, primaries and runoffs.

Once the application is all filled out, mail it to the Early Voting Clerk: Denton County Elections, 701 Kimberly Drive, Denton, Texas, 76208.

They can also be faxed to 940-349-3201, but Denton County Elections also ask applicants to send a hard copy of the application within four business days with a written signature.

Denton County Elections will also accept applications in person if the voter brings it in before early voting begins Oct.

The latest voters can return their ballots is 7 p.m. on Election Day, Nov. 3, but the latest date is five days after the election if you're mailing your ballot from outside of the United States.

Ballots won't be returned to voters if they don't have sufficient postage. The U.S. Postal Service is supposed to deliv-

er the ballot and bill the county for the missing or insufficient postage.

Americans using this system can track their ballot online. Mail-in ballots for military and overseas voters started going out Sept. 19. Other Texans can start receiving their ballots 30 days before the election if county elections received their application more than 45 days

before the election. After that, the county must mail voters their ballot within seven days of approving the application.

For more information about voting by mail in Denton County, call 940-349-3200.

The Sanger News will publish all the early voting locations in the October 8 issue and sample ballot. Early voting begins October 13 and runs through October 30. The local voting site will be at the Sanger Community Center at 101 Freese Drive in Sanger. There are 46 total locations you can early vote in Denton County. Sanger residents can only vote at Sanger High School on election day Tuesday, November 3.

State releases number of virus cases in school districts

The Texas Department of State Health Services last Thursday released its first data dump related to coronavirus in school districts.

Argyle, Denton, Krum and Sanger ISDs reported a total of 18 students who had tested positive for the virus that causes COVID-19 since the first day of school. Sanger ISD had one student and two staff members from grades 7-12. All three sources of infection were off-campus.

Twenty-four staff members from those school districts tested positive during the same time

School districts reported the majority of those people were infected off campus, while it was unknown how rough-None of the four districts reported any instances of

on-campus infection. Out of all districts in the county, Lewisville ISD appears to take the lead with the most coronavirus infections from the first day of school until Thursday afternoon with 62 student and 10 staff infections.

Only students and staffers who participate in any on-campus activities and who test positive are included in the self-reported data, according to the Texas DSHS.

The department released a short statewide summary of the data ly 43% had been infected. this past week. As of last Thursday, the department reported 3,445 Texas students had tested positive for the virus over the past eight weeks. The same was true for 2,850 staff members.

The Texas Education Agency began collecting this information in late August but didn't publicly release the information until last Thursday. It will be updated each Wednesday online, according to the Texas DSHS.

Springer and Luther headed to runoff in Texas Senate District 30

Nearly 41,000 people cast their ballots during the early-voting period that ended on Friday for Texas Senate District 30.

The special election was held Tuesday, September 29, 2020.

The only Democrat in the Texas Senate District 30 special election, Jacob Minter, carried the Denton County vote, but Republicans Drew Springer and Shelley Luther are headed for a runoff on a

date yet to be set.

In unofficial results from the 14-county area that makes up the district, Springer received 21,903 votes (31.83%) to Luther's 21,814 (31.7%). Springer, R-Muenster, currently represents Texas House District 68. Luther, a Denton County resident, became known for defying the governor's orders by opening her Dallas salon during the pandemic.

Under state law, a

candidate must receive 50% of the vote plus one to win.

Minter, an electrician, received 3,476 votes from the portion of Denton County in District 30 and 14,493 votes (21.06%) overall.

Outgoing Denton Mayor Chris Watts garnered 4,324 votes across the district. Also running on the Republican ticket, businessman and entre-
