Sanger ISD announces health protocols, masks optional

As Sanger ISD is gearing up for an amazing school year in 2021-2022 with full in-person instruction only. Sanger ISD officials will monitor overall school health and safety and adjust plans as needed. Guidance from local and state officials, including the Texas Education Agency, will be followed and communicated as needed. When school starts on Thursday, August 19, the practices below will be in place regarding COVID-19 and variants. These practices are subject to change. Dr. Tommy Hunter, Superintendent of Schools issued the following information earlier this week.

Masks & Hygiene Practices

As previously announced, masks and face coverings are optional for all students and staff. Staff are encouraged to ensure that any student wishing to wear a mask feels supported in their decision to do so. SISD will continue to promote the great hand washing and hygiene practices among all individuals on campus.

COVID-19 Reporting

Staff and students are asked to report any positive COVID-19 test result for themselves or for a household family member to your assigned campus nurse. See chart at the end of this article on page 9.

Quarantine Requirements

Lab confirmed individuals are required to quarantine for 10 days at the onset of symptoms or the date of test administration if asymptomatic. Quarantine for 10 days will also be required for individuals with a COVID-19 positive household family member. Vaccination status and COVID-19 history can overrule this quarantine period. Please reach out to the campus nurse for details.

Contact Tracing

Sanger ISD will not conduct contact tracing for COVID positive cases

Sanger ISD offers free meals to all students in school year 2021-2022



USDA program provides free meals for all children for 2021-22 school year.

Sanger ISD has announced its policy that this school year, healthy meals will be offered every school day to all students at no cost. Typically, a student's household must meet income eligibility requirements to qualify for free or reduced-price meals. However, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) issued guidance that allows schools to offer meals to all students at no cost for the 2021-2022 school year. Each school/site or central office has a copy of the policy, which may be reviewed upon request.

While no application or eligibility determination process is required for your student to receive free meals this school year, the income eligibility requirement will likely resume in

the 2022-2023 school year.

The United States Department of Agriculture announced in April it would extend universal free lunch through the 2021-2022 school year, in an effort to reach more of the estimated 12 million youths experiencing food insecurity.

Child nutrition program waivers, which aimed to cut through red tape to allow kids to eat free even outside normal meal times, were implemented at the beginning of the coronavirus pandemic, at a time when millions of families faced financial strain, hunger and hardship. The waivers allowed schools and community organizations to adapt programs to better meet the needs of children and families.

The waivers allowed all children to eat free and outside of the traditional group settings and meal-times. They also allowed parents to do curbside pickup of multiple days of food at once for students learning from home, even without the children's presence, and in many cases for meals to be dropped off at a student's home if they continue to learn virtually part- or full-time.

Sanger ISD Dress and Grooming Code

The district’s dress code is established to teach grooming and hygiene, prevent disruption, and minimize safety hazards. Students and parents may determine a student’s personal dress and grooming standards, provided that they comply with the following:

APPROPRIATE ATTIRE	<p>Male students must wear clean clothing (shirt, slacks, shorts, trousers) that is not torn or damaged. Female students must wear clean clothing (dress, blouse, shirt, skirt, slacks, shorts) that is not torn or damaged. Jeans may have holes located below the fingertips when hands are placed at the side. If jeans are shredded above the fingertip length, undergarments or skin must not be showing.</p> <p>Pants must be worn with the waist at waist level, and shirts or blouses must be buttoned. All students must wear shoes and appropriate undergarments.</p> <p>Sweatshirts/jackets with hoods may be worn; however, the hoods may not be worn on the head in the school building.</p> <p>Leggings and yoga pants must be worn with a shirt, blouse or tunic that covers the backside, and front, must be below fingertip level. Mesh panels in yoga or athletic pants must be below fingertip level (when fingertips are placed at the side).</p> <p>Track shorts may be worn during physical education/athletic classes ONLY (6-12 grades).</p>
INAPPROPRIATE OR UNACCEPTABLE ATTIRE	<p>The following clothing and accessories are inappropriate attire for any student at school or school-related or sanctioned activity:</p> <p>Shorts, including skirts, or dresses shorter than the length of all fingertips when standing with arms at the side.</p> <p>Track shorts are prohibited (6-12 grades).</p> <p>Spandex shorts are prohibited.</p> <p>Pants worn below the natural waistline or sagging, bagging or extremely loose pants.</p> <p>Shirts or blouses that reveal undergarments or cleavage, midriff length tops that leave exposed skin, or halter tops.</p> <p>Exposed undergarments, including bra straps and boxer/briefs, or undergarments visible under clothing. Shirts that reveal skin around the waist when the student is sitting, bending or reaching.</p>

APPROPRIATE GROOMING	<p>Bedtime attire, pajamas with or without pockets, undershirts, or undergarments worn as outerwear, e.g., boxer shorts.</p> <p>Clothing made of any see-through material, fish net, or very loosely woven fabric, unless other acceptable clothing is worn underneath.</p> <p>Sleeveless shirts are not acceptable, .e.g., tank tops.</p> <p>Shirts or blouses that reveal undergarments or cleavage, midriff length tops that leave exposed skin, halter tops, strapless (off the shoulder), spaghetti straps or racerback shirts are not permitted.</p> <p>Slippers or house shoes.</p> <p>Hair grooming products such as combs, picks or rollers worn in the hair are not acceptable.</p>
	<p>All students will exemplify grooming standards that project a positive image for the student, school, and District. Hair must be clean and neatly groomed and worn in a style that does not cover the eyes or eyebrows.</p> <p>Male students’ hair must be neatly trimmed and worn in a style above the eyebrows that exposes the earlobes and has a length not exceeding the bottom of the collar of a dress shirt or top of a crew-neck tee shirt.</p> <p>Male students must be free from facial hair. Sideburns may extend no lower than the bottom of the ear and must be trimmed in a straight line without flares at the bottom.</p>

CLOTHING WITH WORDS OR PICTURES	<p>Clothing worn at school or school-related or sanctioned activities may not display printed statements or pictures:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. That are vulgar or obscene;2. That are related to or depict sexual activity;3. That promotes hate or violence in general or are directed at any specific person or group of persons; or4. That are related to or depict the use of drugs, alcohol, guns, ammunition, or tobacco.
JEWELRY, TATTOOS, BODY PIERCING	<p>Students may not wear any jewelry or similar artifacts that are obscene or distracting or that are likely to cause a disruption to the educational environment or may be used as a weapon.</p> <p>Students may not wear tongue piercings, facial jewelry (nose, lip, brow), or facial decorations (other than normal makeup). Spacers, spikes, gauges, cartilage bars, and mouth jewelry are not allowed.</p> <p>Males are not allowed to wear earrings (No band-aid covering).</p> <p>Tattoos including temporary tattoos and skin drawings must be covered at all times while students are under the school’s jurisdiction.</p>
GANG ATTIRE AND GROOMING	<p>Clothing, grooming or any attire that identifies or connects a student with a gang is prohibited. The principal will stay updated on clothing items that are deemed to be gang-related.</p>
OTHER GUIDELINES	<p>Hats, caps or other coverings are not permitted in the school building.</p> <p>Females may wear earrings that are appropriate and not distracting (pins, spikes, cartilage bars and gauges are not acceptable).</p> <p>Sunglasses may not be worn in the building unless approved with a physician’s note.</p> <p>Excessive makeup or jewelry is not acceptable.</p> <p>Male students may not wear make-up, hair accessories or fingernail polish of any sort.</p> <p>Student contact lenses must be a natural color or shade. Distracting styles or colors are not allowed.</p> <p>Blankets are NOT allowed to be brought to school.</p>
INAPPROPRIATE GROOMING	<p>The following hairstyles or colorings are inappropriate grooming for any student at school or a school-related or sanctioned activity:</p> <p>Liberty spikes or other sculptured hairstyles.</p> <p>Neon or other hair colorings or bleaching, whether permanent or temporary, in shade or tone that the principal determines to be unnatural, such as, but not limited to, neon orange, neon pink, magenta, any shade of blue, any shade of green, violet, purple, white.</p> <p>Hair coloring, bleaching, highlighting for the purpose of creating extreme differences in color, shade, or tone between sections of individual strands of hair, hair extensions, weaves, or areas of hair on the head.</p> <p>Ponytails, mohawks, man buns, for male students.</p> <p>Patterns or designs shaved or cut into the hair, notched eyebrows, etc.</p>
PRINCIPAL’S AUTHORITY	<p>The district reserves the right to prohibit any clothing or grooming style that the administration determines to pose health or safety hazards or that may cause the disruption of, a distraction from, or interference with general school operations. The district also reserves the right to alter the dress code for special occasions as deemed necessary by the campus administrator.</p>

high quality meals while being responsive to their local needs as children safely return to their regular routines," Agriculture Secretary Tom Vilsack said in a statement. "This action also increases the reimbursement rate to school meal operators so they can serve healthy foods to our kids. It's a win-win for kids, parents and schools."

According to Lisa Davis, a senior vice president at Share Our Strength, a charity combating hunger, the

announcement was important for schools and community organizations, giving them time to plan and budget for this school year.

"We are so appreciative they made this announcement with so much lead time so schools can plan their programs. Last year there was uncertainty, and it was more chaotic than it needed to be," Davis said. She said that the waivers reimburse schools for meals at the summer rate, which is higher than the rate during the regular school year. This is a significant help to school districts that have run a deficit during the pandemic

due to increased operating costs associated with safety protocols and packing up meals to go.

Should all American kids get a free school lunch? The pandemic might make that a reality.

During the 2020-2021 school year, the waivers allowed the reimbursement rate to schools to be increased from \$3.60 per lunch served at the free rate to the summer rate of \$4.25 per meal. This increase has helped schools pay for higher costs for boxes and bags for to-go options, for increased transportation and labor costs, and for bringing in temporary support and providing PPE.

Diane Pratt-Heavner, director of media relations for the School Nutrition Association, the trade group for school food-service manufacturers and professionals, said the waiver extensions are a "lifesaver" from a number of perspectives.

"Schools aren't going to have to scramble to collect applications from families that are eligible," she said. "At the start of every school year, this is a huge task for administrators to collect and process the applications, a task made bigger because during the pandemic there are more families eligible who may never have applied before."


The waivers also provide flexibility on the types of foods served to address ongoing supply chain issues, disruptions and procurement challenges.

"The goal is to meet the nutrition standards where they can. We know this works — it's evidence-based," Dean said, pointing to a pre-pandemic Tufts University study that found Americans eat food mostly of poor nutritional quality except at school.



campus. School nurses will resume normal protocols for contacting parents of ill children. As always, please remember that students must be free of fever, vomiting and/or diarrhea for 24 hours (without Medication) before returning to school to prevent spread of illnesses. Should the campus request you to pick up a sick child, please do so as promptly as possible.

Cleaning

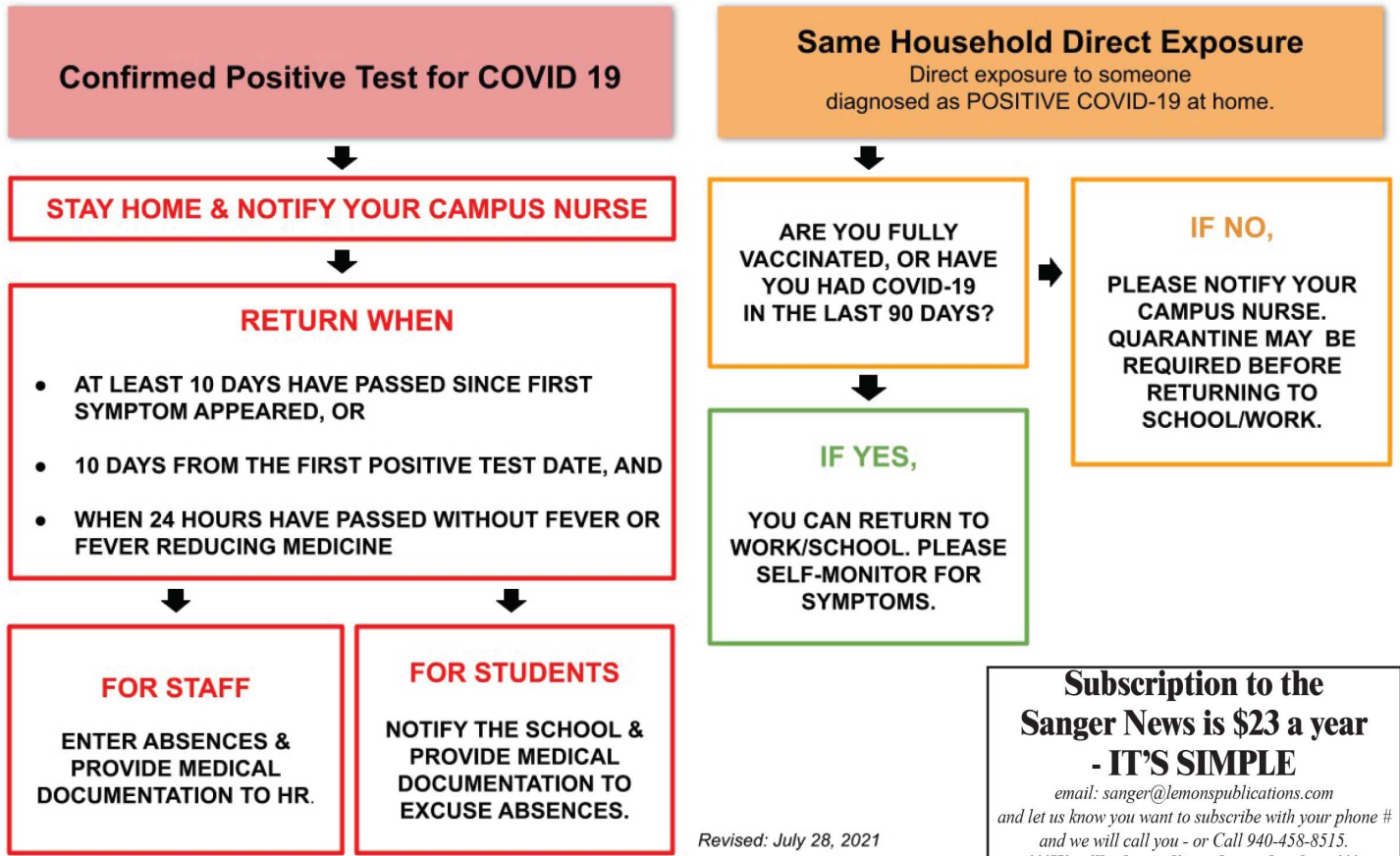
Custodial teams will continue to provide extra cleaning measures in areas as needed to combat germs and spreading of illnesses of any kind. Hand sanitizer stations and surface wipes will continue to be available.

Remote Conferencing Learning for Positive COVID Positive and or Quarantined Students

If a student has to quarantine for being COVID positive or Same Household Direct Exposure, the student may be counted present and/or gain attendance credit by accessing our remote learning conferencing. During the required 10-day quarantine, the district's COVID Remote Conferencing Support Instructor will provide the student instructional support.

According to the Texas Education Agency (TEA), students participating through remote conferencing will generate attendance according to the two-through-four-

hour rule and based on whether the student is virtually "present" at the official attendance-taking time. Instruction must be provided synchronously, which means two-way, real-time/live virtual instruction between teachers and students. The instruction cannot be concurrent, which means remote students must not be taught by a teacher who is also teaching in-person students at the same time. Please reach out to your child's campus principal for additional information or clarification.

Sanger ISD has announced its policy that this school year, healthy meals will be offered every school day to all students at no cost. Typically, a student's household must meet income eligibility requirements to qualify for free or reduced-price meals. 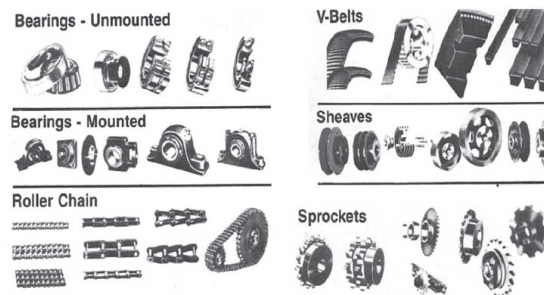
