Margaret "Peggy" Elizabeth McLain Fearing was born on September 12, 1924 to Dr. Charles W. and Frances (Dawley) McLain in Fort Collins, Colorado, and died on June 12, 2026. 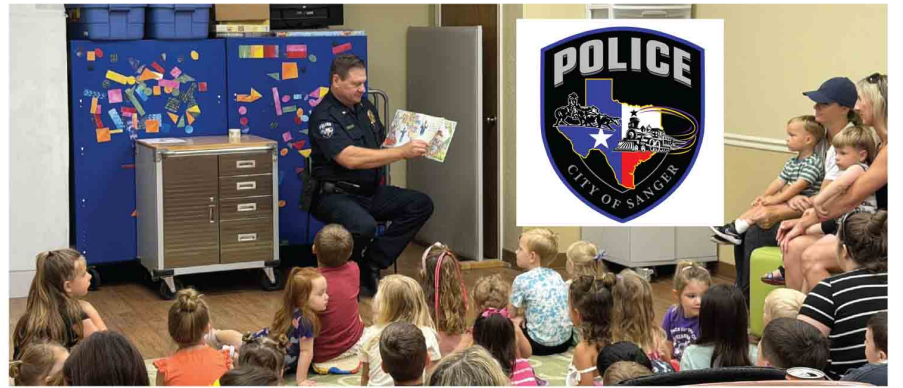

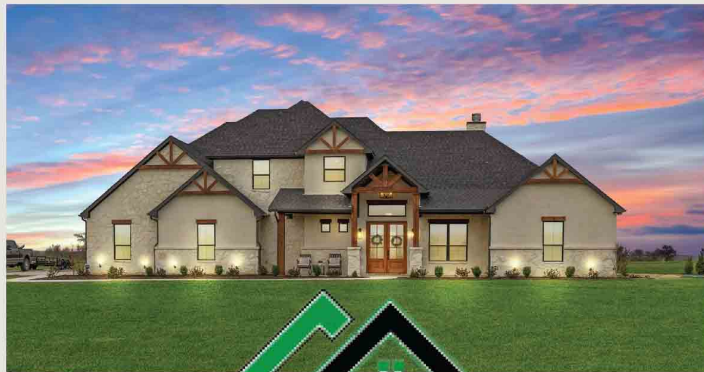

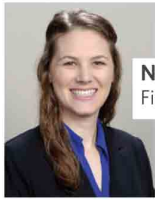

Turn your savings into paychecks in retirement

Margaret had saved diligently for decades. Every paycheck, a portion went toward her retirement account. Then, the day finally came: she retired. Suddenly, the hardest part wasn't the saving. It was learning to spend.

If that sounds familiar, you're not alone. Many retirees find the shift from building savings to living off them emotionally difficult, even when they've planned carefully. Here are five smart strategies that can help you feel more confident about what's ahead.

Give yourself permission to spend conservatively. Your retirement plan likely assumes a certain annual spending amount,

with increases each year to account for inflation. All else being equal, the lower those initial withdrawals, the longer your money will last. A financial advisor can help you set up portfolio withdrawals personalized to your goals and situation. Feel free to give yourself permission to spend those amounts, knowing there's intention behind them.

For many retirees, the challenge isn't math — it's mindset. After years of being rewarded for saving, spending can feel like doing something wrong. It can help to reframe withdrawals as a paycheck you've already earned. For example, using your monthly distribution to cover travel, hobbies or time with family isn't indulgent; it's the purpose of the plan you built. Connecting spending to your values can

make it feel more natural and sustainable.

Do be sure to to review your spending regularly and don't forget to set aside funds for annual expenses like taxes and insurance.

Keep some cash on hand. A general rule of thumb for retirees is to keep about 12 months' worth of withdrawals in a separate account for spending and another three to five years' worth in short-term, fixed-income investments. This cushion can allow your stock investments time to recover from a market downturn, reducing the need to sell investments when markets are down. That said, holding too much cash carries its own risk, as your portfolio may not grow fast enough to keep pace with inflation. So, while some cash is good, you'll also want to remain invested in assets

with more growth potential to help your portfolio last through retirement.

Review regularly. Retirement can last 25 years or more, and even the best-laid plans need updating along the way. Review your financial strategy at least once a year or after any major life change.

Stay flexible. Even small adjustments to your spending can have a big impact on how long your money lasts. Retirees who hold off on spending increases in years when their portfolio declines are often able to stretch their savings further than those who increase withdrawals each year for inflation regardless of market performance.

Making the switch

from saving to spending takes both careful planning and a genuine shift in mindset. A financial advisor can help you build out an effective approach to switch from saving to

spending, and work with you so you can fully enjoy the retirement you worked so hard to reach.

Stay cool, stay hydrated, and stay safe, Sanger!



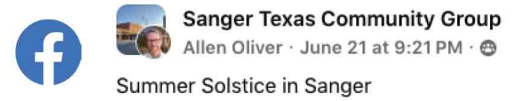

Summer Burnout Is Real: How to Protect Your Mental Health When Life Gets Busy

Summer is often marketed as carefree. But for many adults, summer is a high-demand season. Kids are home from school which often leads to shifting work schedules, travel planning, family gatherings, and the pressure to “make memories.”

Burnout doesn't only happen in high-powered careers. It can happen in parenting, caregiving, running a small business, or simply trying to keep up.

Burnout is not a personal failure. It's a sign that your nervous system has been carrying too much for too long.

What burnout can look like
Burnout isn't always dramatic. It often shows up as:
• Feeling emotionally numb or detached
• Irritability and impatience
• Difficulty concentrating
• Sleep changes (too much or too little)
• Increased headaches or stomach issues
• Feeling like everything is “too much”

Some people also notice increased anxiety or sadness.
Why summer can increase burnout
Summer brings unique stressors:
• Less routine and more decision-making

Financial pressure from activities and travel
• More social events (even when you're already tired)
• More noise and stimulation at home

For people with anxiety, ADHD, or trauma histories, increased stimulation can be especially draining.

5 ways to protect your mental health this summer
1) Lower the bar on perfection

You do not need a “Pinterest summer” to have a meaningful one. Kids often remember connection more than activities.

Ask: “What's the one thing that matters most to us this season?”

2) Create a weekly rhythm
Even one predictable

day can reduce stress:
• Library day
• Pool day
• Family movie night
• Sunday meal prep

Predictability helps everyone feel more grounded.
3) Schedule recovery like you schedule events
If your calendar has only obligations, burnout is predictable.

Add recovery:
• Quiet mornings
• A 20-minute nap
• A walk alone
• A ‘no-plans’ evening

4) Watch for “over-yes-ing”

Summer invites extra invitations. If you say yes to everything, your body will eventually say no.

Try this boundary phrase:
• “That sounds fun, but we're keeping our schedule simple this month.”

5) Use sunlight and nature as a daily reset
Even brief outdoor time can help your nervous system downshift.

Try:
• Stepping outside for 3 minutes between tasks
• Eating one meal outside
• Taking phone calls while walking

When to reach out for support
If you're feeling persistently overwhelmed, disconnected, or stuck in survival mode, therapy can help you:

• Identify what's draining you
• Build boundaries

without guilt
• Improve coping skills
• Strengthen relationships

• Create a sustainable routine
Summer can still be a season of growth—even if it's messy.

Bus registration for the 2026-27 school year opened June 9th, and closes on July 18th. To ensure your child has bus transportation on the first day of school, please complete your registration by July 18th.

Due to the complex nature of route, stop location, and pickup time adjustments, any registrations submitted after July 18th will experience a service delay until August 18th. We appreciate your cooperation in helping us plan our routes safely and efficiently and in notifying all affected families.

Important Sanger ISD Transportation Update: 2026-27 School Year

As a reminder, Texas Education Agency (TEA) policy states that students in grades K-12 must live two or more miles from their assigned campus to be eligible for regular school bus transportation. Sanger ISD is legally obligated to prioritize these students.

Due to ongoing driver shortages, limited bus availability, and an increase in the number of students living outside the two-mile boundary, we are adjusting our routing for the upcoming school year:

- **Eligibility:** For the 2026-27 school year, Sanger ISD will only provide transportation to students living outside a two-mile radius. In-town routes will not be available.

- **Seat Availability:** Seats will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.
- **Waitlist:** Once a bus reaches capacity, additional eligible students will be placed on a waitlist until a seat opens.

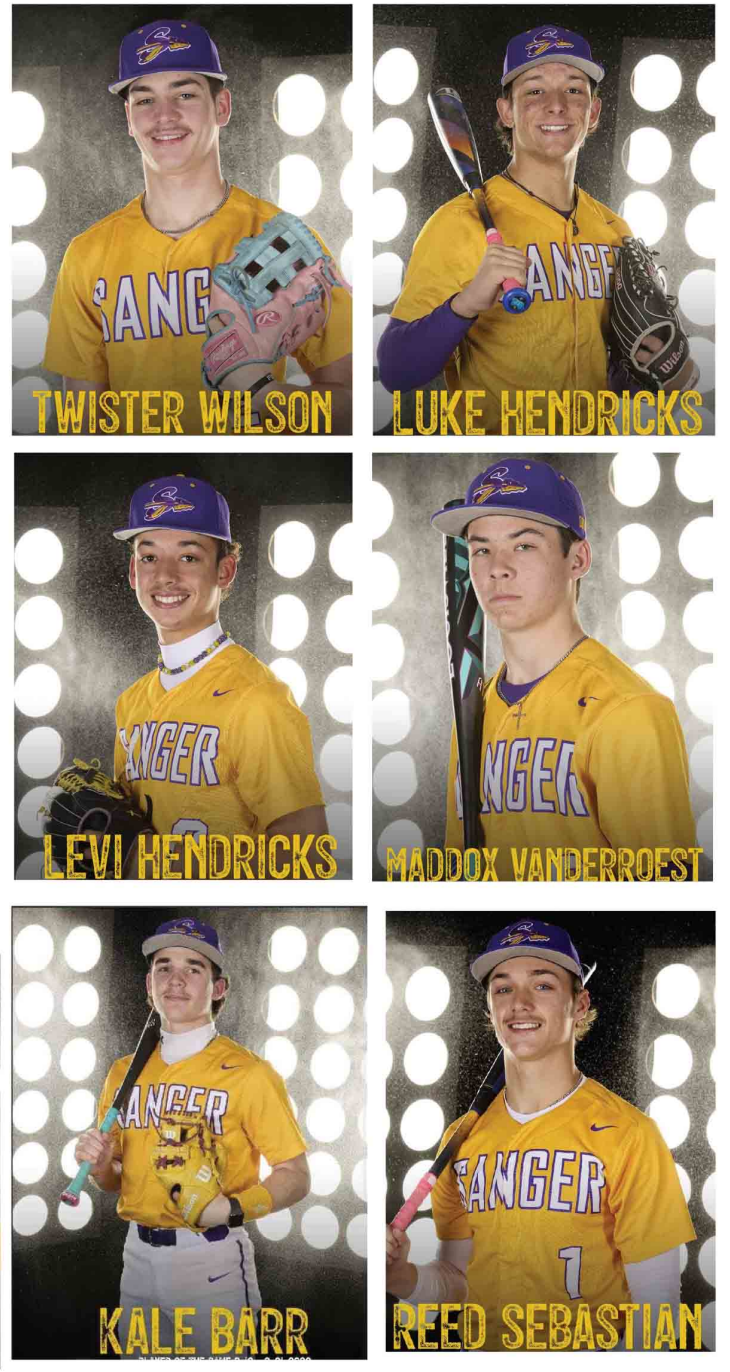
