QuickTrip, Glenn Polk Chevrolet to start construction soon

QuickTrip will be located where Super Save and Burrus were located at the corner of I-35 and FM 455. They will start construction this fall, the City of Sanger announced in an economic development newsletter, recently. Also, Glenn Polk Chevrolet plans a new facility that will be approximately 21,000 to 24,000 sq. ft., this fall.

The Sanger City Council recently approved a zoning change for future planned development for approximately 327 acres located on the south side of FM 455, east of the intersection of Marion Road and FM 455.

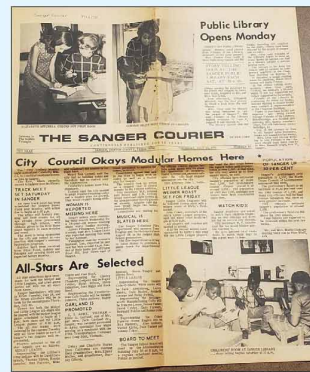

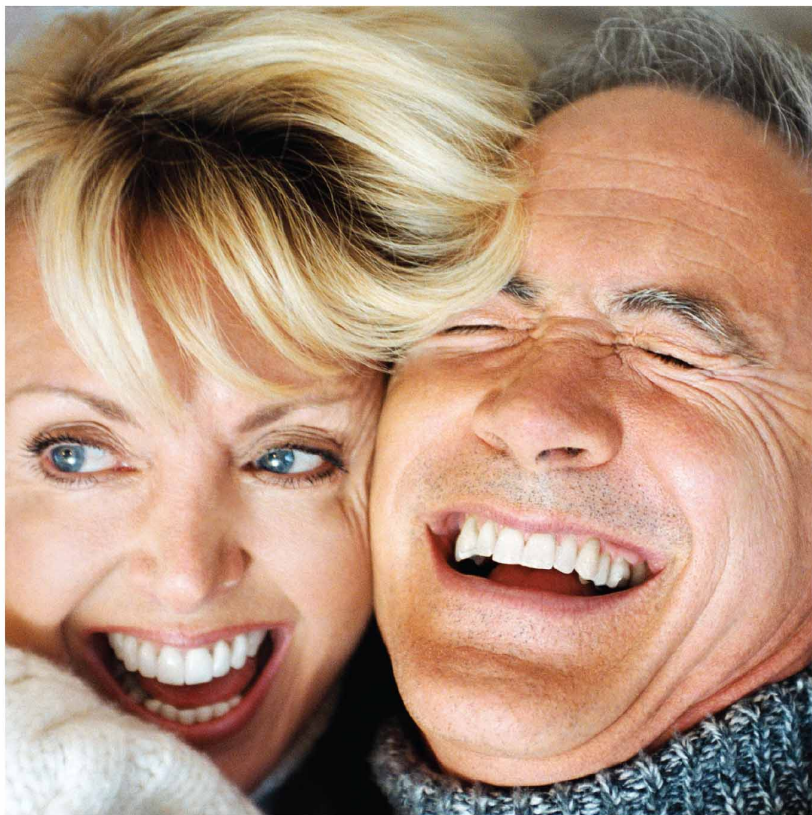

Glenn Polk Chevrolet plans to expand

Glenn Polk will begin on-site construction in the fall of 2022 on a new facility. The proposed facility will be approximately 21,200 sq. ft. to 24,000 sq. ft. and will contain a new four-vehicle showroom; new-car and pre-owned sales and financing offices, management offices, customer amenities spaces, parts storage, and sales, and a new 16-bay service facility. This new facility will bring approximately 15 new, high-paying jobs to the Sanger economy.



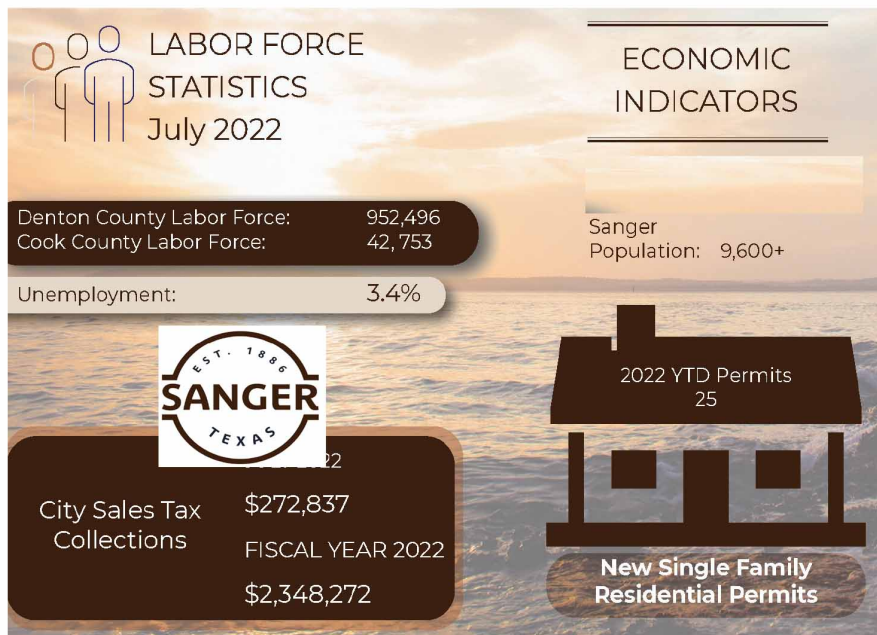
Star Business Park Under Construction

Construction has begun on a 290,940-square-foot building in the Star Business Park. This 274-acre development is located along State Highway 35, just north of the Walmart Distribution Center, and is zoned for light industrial use. The project includes plans for up to 10 industrial buildings ranging between 200,000 and 1 million square feet.



New Residential Development

The Sanger City Council recently approved a zoning change for future planned development for approximately 327 acres located on the south side of FM 455, east of the intersection of Marion Road and FM 455. Lane Ranch will include 242 acres of single-family residential, 16 acres for townhomes, 18 acres of multi-family, 43 acres of neighborhood business, and 8 acres of assisted living. There will also be about 83 acres of open space throughout the development. These will include parks, walking trails, a dog park, and benches.

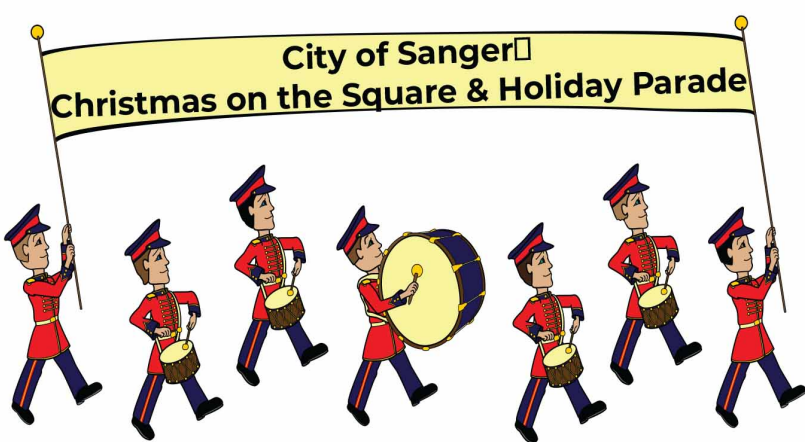
