The projects include state highways, local arterials within cities, safety improvements, and county roads and bridges.

Denton County is routinely in the top 10 fastest growing counties in the nation by percentage. Denton County's population grew approximately 43.5% who lived in the county in 2010 to an estimated 950,660 in 2022, according to the U.S. Census and the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG). For comparison, the population in the ties in Texas. U.S. grew 7.4% and the 15.9% during that period. Denton County grows by an average of 82 people a day.

The City of Sanger has contracted with Republic Services to continue our resident brush removal services. Residents whose utility account is in good standing, will be permitted one pick-up per calendar month of up to four cubic yards, at no charge.

- * Pickups will be made on Wednesdays. Only one pickup per calendar month permitted.
- * Inclement weather may delay your scheduled pickup.
- * You must schedule your brush pick-up by 5:00 PM the Friday prior to your pickup.
- * Pickups can be scheduled using our free app "Sanger Solutions" (preferred method) or by calling 940-458-2571. Calls can be made M - TH 7:30 AM - 5:00 PM and Friday 7:30 - 11:00 AM.
- * Brush left on the curb without scheduling a pick-up will not be removed.
- * Tree limbs larger than 1" in diameter must be cut from the main branch.
- * Brush must be less than eight (8) feet in length and less than eight (8) inches in diameter. * Place limbs and brush on the curb with the cut side out. Brush should not extend into the
- road and should be free and clear from any overhead obstruction or utility facilities.
