Wings over USA coming to Sanger Crossing Retail Center

A new dining destination is making its way to Denton County, with Wings Over Sanger preparing to open a brand-new restaurant. The new eatery is an upcoming location for Wings Over USA, a rapidly expanding Texas-based chicken and sports-bar chain that first originated in Kaufman and Seagoville in 2005.

The restaurant will be taking over a spacious 4,500-square-foot suite located at 1409 W Chapman Drive, Suite 300, in Sanger.

The project involves a \$400,000 interior finish-out to transform the

vacant suite into a fully operational restaurant and sports bar.

Construction is scheduled to kick off very soon on June 1, 2026, with a rapid turnaround targeting a completion date just in time for the start of the fall football season on September 8, 2026.

Wings Over USA is coming to Sanger Crossing, next to Tom Thumb. They started in 2005 with two small hometown locations in Kaufman and Seagoville — and from day one, their mission has stayed the same: bring people together over great

food, big energy, and even bigger community spirit.

For more than 20 years, families, friends, and sports lovers have walked through their doors for more than just wings. They've come for the good vibes and an extensive menu that gives everyone a chance to try something new. Since 2023, Wings Over USA has taken that mission to a whole new level, growing into 12 locations and counting across Fort Worth, Seagoville, Frisco, Bonham, Mount Pleasant, Forney, Gun Barrel City, Heath, Kaufman, Commerce,

Houston and now Sanger.

SISD Special Education announces Coop transition and next steps

Sanger ISD provided an update last week about the changes to the Special Education program in the district and the dissolution of the Denton County Special Education Coop.

Many inquiries have been received regarding how the dissolution of the Denton County Special Education Cooperative will impact Sanger ISD, particularly regarding the specialized programs offered at Linda Tutt High School (LTHS).

For over 50 years, the Denton County Special Education Cooperative has been a valued partner of Sanger ISD, support-

ing special education programming and services for students across several smaller area districts. This partnership has contributed to strong outcomes, and Sanger ISD is proud to be

recognized for maintaining one of the state's most highly regarded special education programs.

Currently, the Cooperative serves Krum, Pilot Point, Ponder, and

Sanger ISD. Cooperative models are typically used when district enrollment is smaller, allowing participating districts to pool resources to provide specialized programming efficiently. As districts grow, it is common practice to transition away from a cooperative model and establish a district-operated special education department.

Beginning July 1, 2026, Sanger ISD will transition to a fully district-operated special education program under the lead-

ership of Melissa Dorum, Director of Special Education. As always, Sanger ISD remains committed to doing what is best for students and families while maintaining high-quality programming throughout this transition.

Several programs currently housed at LTHS are cooperative-based programs. Beginning in August 2026, students from partner districts previously served at LTHS will return to their home districts for services. At this

point, Sanger ISD is large enough to operate these programs exclusively for Sanger students.

As expected, this transition results in adjustments to staffing and program placement. Cooperative districts currently represent approximately 60% of the student enrollment in these specialized programs. After careful review and consideration, Sanger ISD has determined that Sanger High School will host two specialized programs/classrooms previously located at LTHS, and Sanger Middle School will host one classroom. This realignment provides students with greater access to campus opportunities, including extracurricular activities, athletics, band, Career and Technical Education courses, and dual credit offerings. It also supports the district's commitment to ensuring students with disabilities are educated alongside their non-disabled peers to the greatest extent appropriate.

LTHS will continue to operate five specialized classrooms serving students who require intensive support to access their education, as well as the School of Choice program, which allows students to earn credits at an individualized pace to accelerate graduation, and the District Alternative Education Program (DAEP).

Kids Don't Always Have the Words: How Play Therapy Helps Children Heal

Adults often process emotions through talking. Kids are different. Many children, especially kids between the ages 3 and 9, don't have the vocabulary or emotional awareness to explain what they're feeling. Instead, they show it.

You might notice:

- Big meltdowns over small things
- Increased clinginess or separation anxiety
- Aggression, defiance, or frequent arguing
- Sleep problems or nightmares
- Regression (bedwetting, baby talk)
- Complaints of stomach aches or headaches
- Trouble at school or sudden changes in their behavior

When kids can't say, "I'm anxious," or "I'm grieving," their behavior often becomes the message.

What is play therapy?

Play therapy is a counseling approach designed for children, using play as the primary way they communicate. In a safe, supportive environment, children can express their feelings, work through their fears, build coping skills, and practice healthier ways of relating.

To a child, play therapy may look like toys, art, games, or storytelling. To a trained therapist, it's a structured, evidence-informed way to help a child process what's happening inside.

What play therapy can help with
Play therapy is often helpful for:

- Anxiety and worries
- Trauma or scary experiences
- Grief and loss
- Divorce or family changes
- Behavioral challenges
- Social struggles and low self-esteem
- ADHD-related emotional regulation

It's also helpful for children who are sensitive, perfectionistic, or who "hold it together" at school but fall apart at home.

What parents can expect

Parents are an important part of the process. In many cases, you'll have periodic parent sessions to discuss your child's progress, learn supportive strategies, and understand what your child may be communicating through behavior.

Play therapy isn't about labeling a child as "bad" or "broken." It's about giving them a safe space to grow.

One small step you can take today

If your child is struggling, try this simple practice:

- Spend 10 minutes in "child-led play."
- Let your child choose the activity.
- Follow their lead without correcting or teaching.
- Offer one or two warm reflections: "You're working hard on that," or "That seems really important to you."

This builds connection and emotional safety—two key ingredients for healing.

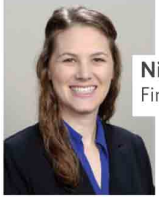

Help your graduate use credit and debit cards wisely

As your new graduate prepares to step into the next chapter of life – whether that's more education or starting a career – one of the best things you can do is help them understand how to use credit cards, debit cards and prepaid cards wisely. They can be powerful financial tools, but without some basic knowledge, they can also lead to trouble.

Here are a few things for graduates, whether from high school or graduate school, should know.

Credit cards have benefits — and risks. About 69% of Americans ages 18-29 have at least one credit card, according to the Federal Reserve. They can

borrow money up to a set limit, pay it back and borrow again – a cycle known as revolving credit. Used responsibly, credit cards can help build their credit history, cover unexpected expenses and even earn rewards like cash back or travel discounts.

On the cautionary side, if your child or grandchild doesn't pay the full balance each month, interest charges can accumulate quickly. Carrying a high balance relative to the credit limit can hurt their credit score. Perhaps most importantly, it's easy to fall into a debt cycle in which they charge more than they can pay, interest can add up to more than the original purchases cost, and they might even open new cards to cover old ones. It creates a hole that's hard to climb out of.

The key message is simple: pay off the balance monthly, pay on time and treat the card as a convenience, not a lifeline.

Debit cards can be a good option. Since debit cards draw directly from a bank account, they naturally limit overspending. But they aren't risk-free. Overdrawing the account can trigger fees, and debit cards generally offer fewer fraud protections than credit cards. Additionally, since you're spending your own money rather than borrowing, debit cards don't help build a credit score. Still, for a young person just starting out, a debit card can be a practical way to manage day-to-day spending.

Prepaid cards can help teach the basics. Money is loaded onto the card before use, and your young

adult can only spend what's already on the card. Because of this, there's no risk of debt, no credit history needed and no bills to pay.

Prepaid cards come in several forms. General purpose reloadable cards can be used anywhere cards are accepted. Payroll cards are sometimes used by employers to distribute wages. Gift cards are another option.

The downside is that prepaid cards typically don't help build a credit history, since transactions usually aren't reported to credit bureaus. Some also come with fees for activation, reloading or transactions. These fees can add

up, so it pays to read the fine print.

Teaching your graduate the difference between these tools, and how to develop good habits for each,

can help them build financial confidence for decades to come.

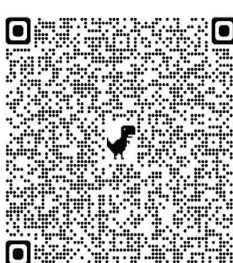


