Early voting for the November 8 General Election ends Friday, November 4th. The Sanger early voting location is 101 Freese Street at the Sanger Community Center, but you can vote at any of the 49 locations listed on the Denton County Election website.

On Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, Sanger residents can vote from 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. Precinct 1000 will vote at Bolivar Baptist church at 6690 FM 455 W.; Precinct 1001 / 1002 will be at Pilgrim's Way Baptist Church at 806 N. Keaton Road; Precinct 1003 ballots can be cast at Grace Bible Church 1012 N/ 5th St. in Sanger and Precincts 1004 / 1005 / 1006 at Sanger Community Center at 101 Freese Drive.


His greatest accomplishments on this earth were in his humorous stories, his witty smile and the kindness of his heart. John was an amazing husband, father, grandfather, and friend.
