Early voting for the November 8 General Election ends Friday, November 4th. The Sanger early voting location is 101 Freese Street at the Sanger Community Center, but you can vote at any of the 49 locations listed on the Denton County Election website. On Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, Sanger residents can vote from 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. Pre-

cinct 1000 will vote at Bolivar Baptist church at 6690 FM 455 W.; Precinct 1001 / 1002 will be at Pilgrim's Way Baptist Church at 806 N. Keaton Road; Precinct 1003 ballots can be cast at Grace Bible Church 1012 N/ 5th St. in Sanger and Precincts 1004 / 1005 / 1006 at Sanger Community Center at 101 Freese Drive. Texas governor's race topped \$220 million as Ab-

bott, O'Rourke hit home-stretch. Democrat Beto O'Rourke narrowly out-raised Gov. Greg Abbott over the last month, but Abbott maintains a dominant financial advantage going into the final stretch of the most expensive governor's race in Texas history.

O'Rourke raised \$10.5 million from Sept. 30 to Oct. 29 and has now raised almost \$77 million in his effort to become the first Democratic governor since 1994.

Abbott, a Republican, reported raising almost \$9 million during the same stretch and has raised \$143 million in his bid to win a record-tying third term as governor.

The two have combined to raise a record-shattering \$220 million for the governor's race, fueling a television ad war that has reached every corner of

the state. Already about 3.5 million Texans have voted with early voting ending Friday. Election Day is Nov. 8.

Both campaigns still have millions left in their campaign accounts as they travel the state trying to boost turnout in the final days. Abbott, with \$3.7 million left in his campaign, was in West Texas on Tuesday for get-out-the-vote rallies in Amarillo and El Paso.

"With the end of this campaign in sight, we have the resources we need to show Texans the clear contrast between Gov. Greg Abbott's vision for a successful Texas and Beto O'Rourke's radical leftist orthodoxy," said Gardner Pate, chairman of the Texans for Greg Abbott campaign.

O'Rourke had about \$4.2 million left and was in deep South Texas making campaign stops in Harlingen and Brownsville on Tuesday.

"We're receiving support from those in every part of this state who are ready to turn the page on Greg Abbott's failures and vote for change after eight years of this governor putting his extreme agenda over the people of Texas," O'Rourke said.

There is a Denton County Proposition A on the ballot for Sanger residents:

"THE ISSUANCE OF \$650,000,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS FOR CONSTRUCTING, IMPROVING, REPAIRING AND MAINTAINING ROADS, BRIDGES AND HIGHWAYS WITHIN

DENTON COUNTY, INCLUDING CITY, STATE AND COUNTY STREETS, ROADS, HIGHWAYS AND BRIDGES AND PARTICIPATION WITH FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL PUBLIC ENTITIES RELATED TO SUCH IMPROVEMENTS AND THE IMPOSITION OF A TAX SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON THE BONDS."

The ballot includes unopposed candidates, as well. In the past there has been some confusion about Sanger's State Representative. Sanger resident, Dr. Lynn Stucky (District 64) represents most residents west of I-35 and Jared Patterson (District 106) boundary is most of Sanger east of I-35.

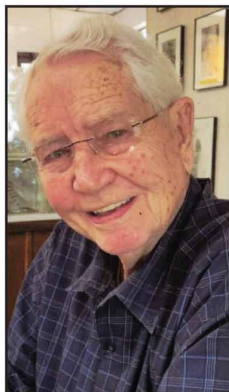
His greatest accomplishments on this earth were in his humorous stories, his witty smile and the kindness of his heart. John was an amazing husband, father, grandfather, and friend.

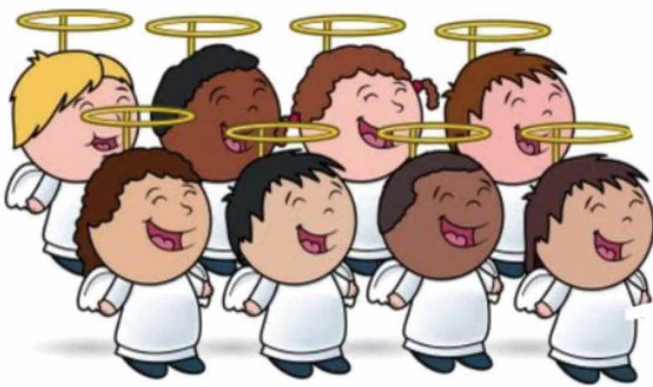

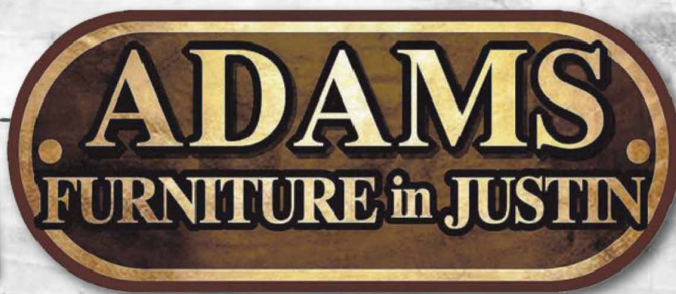
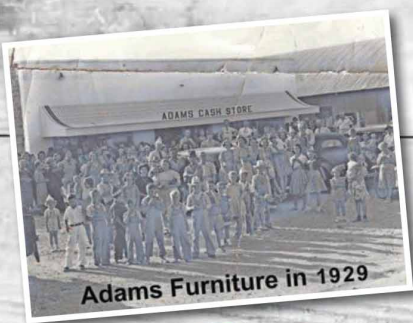

If they get that gap back down to the 20-30 second range, a top 5 or podium finish will be in the cards." Sophomore Cade Knavel and Junior Alex Limon will be the pushers for the Sanger Indians. "With the race that I am expecting, these two will be important in pushing the other team scores

up. A difference in a top 5 or top 10 placing, really depends on the 6 and 7 runners. If it comes down to a tie, they will go to the 6th runner. We've already had an instance of our team winning a tie breaker because of our 6th runner."

In the Team points race, it will be a tight race from all of the teams from Region 1. Sanger, Canyon, San Elizario and Big Spring all have amazing teams that are looking to be on the podium. Kaufman and Giddings will be looking to break up the Region I domination at the state meet.

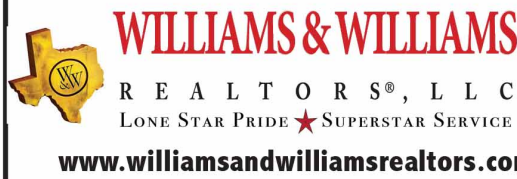
