## Check out Sanger Public Library Online during National Library Week

While the Sanger Public Library is still closed for renovation after the extensive water damage during Winter Storm Uri, we would like to encourage community members to visit the library's website to explore and access

to your library," which promotes the idea that libraries extend far beyond the four walls of a building and that everyone is welcome to use their services. The community can show its appreciation and support for libraries by visiting their library's web-

all types have been going above and beyond to adapt to our changing world by expanding their resources and continuing to meet the needs of their patrons. Sanger Public Library has provided curbside pickup for requested materials since shortly after the governor's Stay at Home order was lifted and began offering library visits by appointment in early June.

The library recently added a new digital service, hoopla, to its lineup of electronic resources. It has over 900,000 eBooks, downloadable audio-books, songs, movies, and television shows to choose from! Since hoopla uses a pay-per-download model, for budgeting purposes the library has a three downloads/month limit for each cardholder. To help offset the limits libraries need to put in place, the service offers "Bonus Borrowings" specials during four months of the year. Hundreds of "free" titles are available during these months, which don't count towards the monthly limit and are free to the library.

The library continues to offer its other e-services, including Overdrive audio and eBooks, Freeding eBooks, and the many Texshare databases for research and test preparation. Even though the building is still closed, staff members are usually able to answer questions either by phone at 940-458-3257 or email at libraryclerk@sangertexas.org.

The library staff has been working hard on the cleanup and recovery efforts, and a new arrangement of furniture and shelving is in the works that will improve the building's overall functionality. When the library reopens, it will offer an improved space for the community.

## STAAR Testing delayed

Students across Texas weren't able to take their state-mandated STAAR tests Tuesday morning due to technical issues, with students in Argyle, Denton, Krum and Sanger ISDs impacted.

Students attempting to take the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness online weren't able to due to a widespread technical issue, as reported by The Texas Tribune.

The Texas Education Agency, in a statement sent out late Tuesday morning, said districts were informed of the issues at 10:17 a.m. and were told to stop online testing for the day.

It went on to say the issues were unacceptable.

The statement said the issues lay with the tests'

vendor, ETS, which "experienced problems with their database system, which are in the process of being corrected."

"The 2021 online administration of STAAR will be ETS's last for the State of Texas," the statement read.

Cambium Assessment will take over the tests' administration beginning next school year.

Representatives for four local districts confirmed their schools were affected Tuesday.

Marta Chavez, an executive assistant for Sanger ISD Superintendent Tommy Hunter and the school board, said several district students were impacted Tuesday, and the district was awaiting further guidance from the state before

deciding on its next steps.

On Wednesday morning, SISD told the Sanger News they have worked cooperatively with Region and State and all tests have been scheduled for next Tuesday.

According to TEA, students testing online faced one of three basic problems:

They were able to submit answers, but response times were slow.

Students were unable to log in and begin the test.

Students were able to begin the test but weren't able to continue later on.

TEA said answers were saved every 30 seconds, so students in the third camp should be able to pick up roughly where they left off.

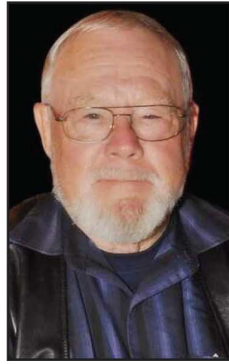
There will be a memorial service held on April 17, 2021 at 5 pm at the Willowood Church of Nazarene in Denton, Texas.

There was a viewing at DeBerry Funeral Home in Denton from 10:00 - 12:00 on Monday morning.

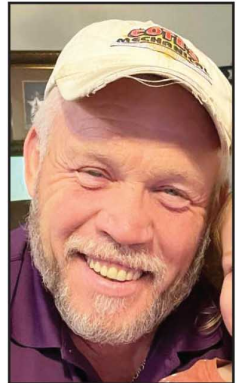

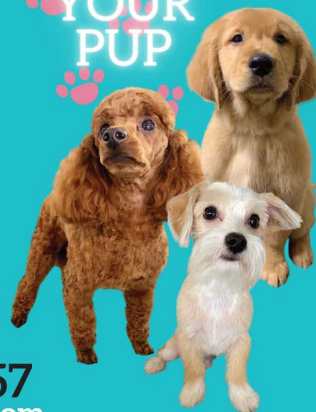

## Over 2,000 digital scanned newspapers of Sanger Courier and Sanger News already added to a Texas History Portal website

Last year the Sanger Public Library received a grant for \$15,600 from the Tocker Foundation to fund the majority of the digitization of the Sanger newspaper collection, including available issues of the Sanger Courier going back as far as 1905 and up to 1965. This part of the collection consists of approximately 15,000 pages. The Texas Digital Newspaper Program, through the University of North Texas, covers the cost of digitizing issues after 1965, which includes the more current Sanger News, and also performs the conversion. Once digitized, the Sanger issues are searchable through The Portal to Texas History at <https://texashistory.unt.edu/explore/collections/SANG/>. Over 2,000 issues are available now and thousands more are being added in the future. You can type in a name, topic, date, etc... to find the scanned digitized editions.

The Sanger Area Historical Society has played an instrumental role in collecting many of the older newspapers over the years, indexing obituary information, and assisting the library in storing microfilm and other materials. A member of the SAHS, Devin Pipes, assisted with the grant application, including performing an inventory of newspaper issues and obtaining digital files from Blake Lemons at

the Sanger News, as well as providing thorough written answers to several questions in the application.

Digitization of this newspaper collection will enable not only the local community but anyone around the globe with open Internet access the opportunity to research

Sanger's history. The Tocker Foundation was established in 1964 and in 1992 began focusing its grant distribution to small rural libraries supporting a population of 12,000 or less, based on official population assignments from the Texas State Library and Archives Commission.

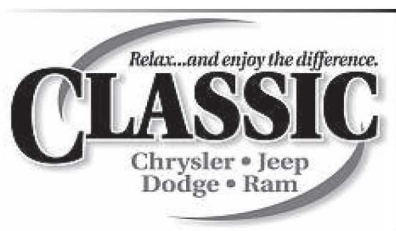

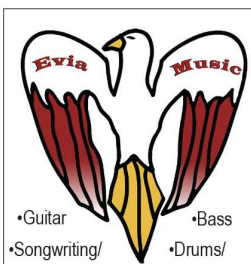
