# I-35 traffic will be diverted each night to repair Lone Oak Bridge

The FM 3002 (Lone Oak Road) Bridge over I-35 was closed for damage in May and the structure will remain closed until it is repaired by a bridge maintenance company. TX-DOT, recently, hired a contractor and work started this week. Crews will close I-35 northbound and southbound from 8pm-6am every night at Lone Oak exits and traffic will be diverted to the frontage roads to bypass the bridge. They will begin dismantling the surface in the middle and working their way outwards. The most damage is in the middle, but they expect to find more damage as they go and the repairs are expected to take several weeks.

In a TX-DOT press release, it stated, “These repairs will be done at night after rush hour and before the morning drive time. Only one side of the freeway will shut down at a time. The simple detour for north and southbound traffic is to exit at FM 3002.CR 2148 (Lone Oak Road) to the frontage road and get back on the interstate at the next entrance ramp.”

The bridge is located a few miles north of Sanger on the county line. Signs have been installed on I-35 in the area to notify motorists of the closures to the main lanes of I-35.

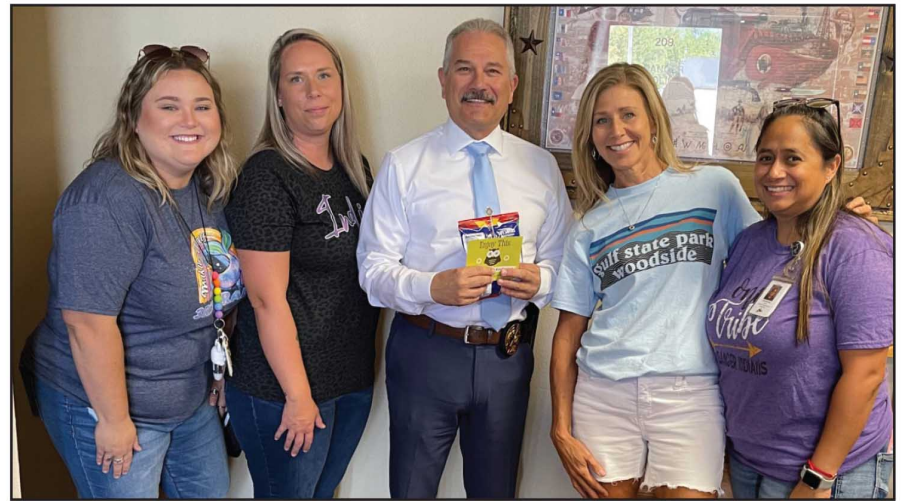

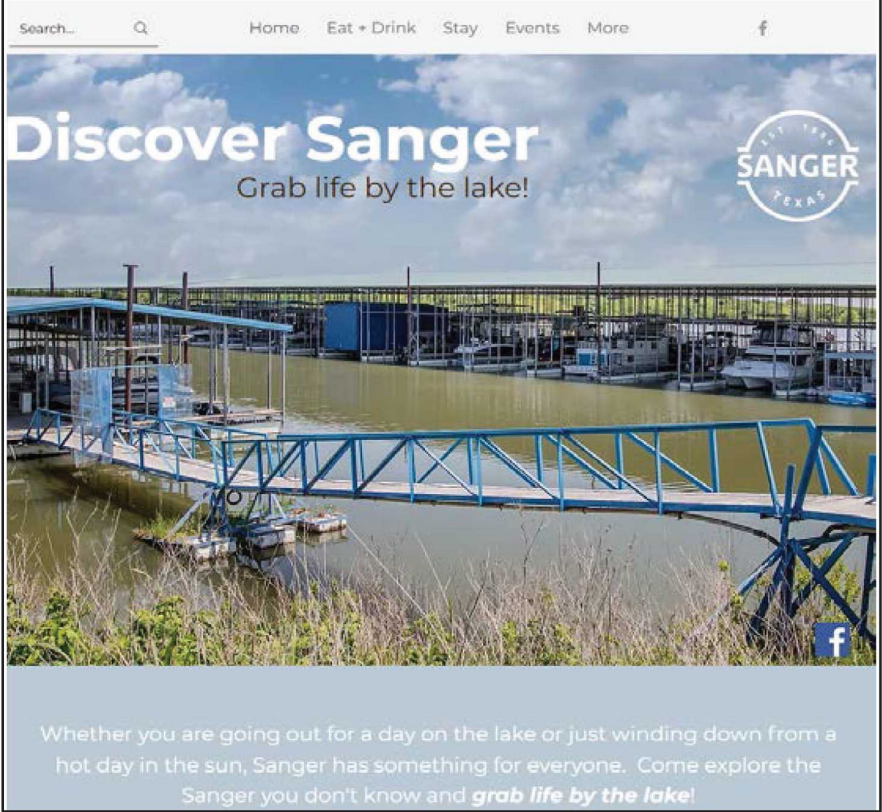

# Sanger ISD policy for providing free and reduced price meals

Sanger ISD announced its policy this week for providing free and reduced-price meals for children served under the attached current income eligibility guidelines. Each school/site or the central office has a copy of the policy, which may be reviewed by anyone on request.

Starting on August 1, 2022 Sanger ISD began distributing letters to the households of the children in the district about eligibility benefits and any actions households need to take to apply for these benefits. Applications are available at 601 Elm Street, Sanger, TX 76266 or your child's campus. Sanger ISD is excited to announce that Meal Applications are also available to complete online and can be accessed through the Sanger ISD website, <https://frapps.horizonsolana.com/SANI01> or scanning the QR Code.



## Criteria for Free and Reduced-Price Meal Benefits

The following criteria will be used to determine a child's eligibility for free or reduced-price meal benefits:

### Income

1. Household income that is at or below the income eligibility levels

### Categorical or Automatic Eligibility

2. Household receiving Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), or Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR)

### Program Participant

3. Child's status as a foster child, homeless, runaway, migrant, or displaced by a de-

clared disaster

### Income Eligibility

For those households that qualify for free or reduced-price meals based on income, an adult in the household must fill out free and reduced-price meal application and return it to Audrey Roberts, Child Nutrition Director, 601 Elm Street, Sanger, TX 76266 or your child's campus. Those individuals filling out the application will need to provide the following information:

1. Names of all household members
2. Amount, frequency, and source of current income for each household member
3. Last 4 digits of the Social Security number of the adult household member who signs the application or, if the adult does not have a social security number, check the box for "No Social Security number"
4. Signature of an adult household member attesting that the information provided is correct

### Categorical or Program Eligibility

Sanger ISD is working with local agencies to identify all children who are categorically and program eligible. Sanger ISD will notify the households of these children that they do not need to complete an application. Any household that does not receive a letter and feels it should have should contact Audrey Roberts, Child Nu-

trition Director, [audrey.roberts@sangerisd.net](mailto:audrey.roberts@sangerisd.net) 940-458-7438 ext. 25.

Any household that wishes to decline benefits should contact Audrey Roberts, Child Nutrition Director, [audrey.roberts@sangerisd.net](mailto:audrey.roberts@sangerisd.net) 940-458-7438 ext. 25.

Applications may be submitted anytime during the school year. The information households provide on the application will be used for the purpose of determining eligibility. Applications may also be verified by the school officials at any time during the school year.

### Determining Eligibility

Under the provisions of the free and reduced-price meal policy, Audrey Roberts, Child Nutrition Director will review applications and determine eligibility. Households or guardians dissatisfied with the Reviewing Official's eligibility determination may wish to discuss the decision with the Reviewing Official on an informal basis. Households wishing to make a formal appeal for a hearing on the decision may make a request either orally or in writing to Monica Herren, CFO, [monica.herren@sangerisd.net](mailto:monica.herren@sangerisd.net) 940-458-7438.

### Unexpected Circumstances

If a household member becomes unemployed or if the household size increases, the household should contact the school. Such changes may make the children of the household eligible for benefits if the household's income falls at or below the attached current income eligibility guidelines.

## Sanger ISD

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Children need healthy meals to learn. Sanger ISD offers healthy meals every school day. Breakfast costs \$2.00; lunch costs \$3.15 at Primary Schools (Butterfield Elementary, Chisholm Trail Elementary & Clear Creek Intermediate) & \$3.35 at Secondary Schools (Sanger High School, Sanger Middle School & Sixth Grade Center). **Your children may qualify for free meals or for reduced-price meals.** Reduced-price is \$0.30 for breakfast and \$0.40 for lunch. If you received a notification letter that a child is directly certified for free or reduced-price meals, do not complete an application. Let the school know if any children in the household attending school are not listed in the letter.

The questions and answers that follow and attached directions provide additional information on how to complete the application. Complete only one application for all the students in the household and return the completed application to Audrey Roberts, 601 Elm Street, Sanger, TX 76266, [audrey.roberts@sangerisd.net](mailto:audrey.roberts@sangerisd.net). If you have questions about applying for free or reduced-price meals, contact 940-458-7438, [audrey.roberts@sangerisd.net](mailto:audrey.roberts@sangerisd.net).

### 1. Who Can Get Free Meals?

- **Income**—Children can get free or reduced-price meals if a household's gross income is within the limits described in the *Federal Income Eligibility Guidelines*.
- **Special Assistance Program Participants**—Children in households receiving benefits from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Food Distribution Program for Households on Indian Reservations (FDPIR), or Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), are eligible for free meals.
- **Foster**—Foster children who are under the legal responsibility of a foster care agency or court are eligible for free meals.
- **Head Start or Early Head Start**—Children participating in these programs are eligible for free meals.
- **Homeless, Runaway, and Migrant**—Children who meet the definition of homeless, runaway, or migrant qualify for free meals. If you haven't been told about a child's status as homeless, runaway, or migrant or you feel a child may qualify for one of these programs, please call or email Margarita Dunn 940-458-4859, [mdunn@sangerisd.net](mailto:mdunn@sangerisd.net).
- **WIC Recipient**—Children in households participating in WIC may be eligible for free or reduced-price meals.

### 2. What If I Disagree with the School's Decision About My Application?

Talk to school officials. You also may ask for a hearing by calling or writing to Monica Herren, 601 Elm St., Sanger, TX 76266, [monica.herren@sangerisd.net](mailto:monica.herren@sangerisd.net) or 940-458-7438.

### 3. My Child's Application Was Approved Last Year. Do I Need to Fill Out A New One?

Yes. An application is only good for that school year and for the first few days of this school year. Send in a new application unless the school has told you that your child is eligible for the new school year.

### 4. If I Don't Qualify Now, May I Apply Later?

Yes. Apply at any time during the school year. A child with a parent or guardian who becomes unemployed may become eligible for free and reduced-price meals if the household income drops below the income limit.

### 5. What If My Income Is Not Always the Same?

List the amount normally received. If a household member lost a job or had hours/wages reduced, use current income.

### 6. We Are in The Military. Do We Report Our Income Differently?

Basic pay and cash bonuses must be reported as income. Any cash value allowances for off-base housing, food, or clothing, or Family Subsistence Supplemental Allowance payments count as income. If housing is part of the Military Housing Privatization Initiative, do not include the housing allowance as income. Any additional combat pay resulting from deployment is excluded from income.

### 7. May I Apply If Someone in My Household Is Not a U.S. Citizen?

Yes. You, your children, or other household members do not have to be U.S. citizens to apply for free or reduced-price meals.

### 8. Will Application Information Be Checked?

Yes. We may also ask you to send written proof of the reported household income.

### 9. My Family Needs More Help. Are There Other Programs We Might Apply For?

To find out how to apply for other assistance benefits, contact your local assistance office or 2-1-1.

### 10. Can I Apply Online?

Yes! The online application has the same requirements and will ask you for the same information as the paper application. Visit [www.sangerisd.net](http://www.sangerisd.net) to begin or to learn more about the online application process.
