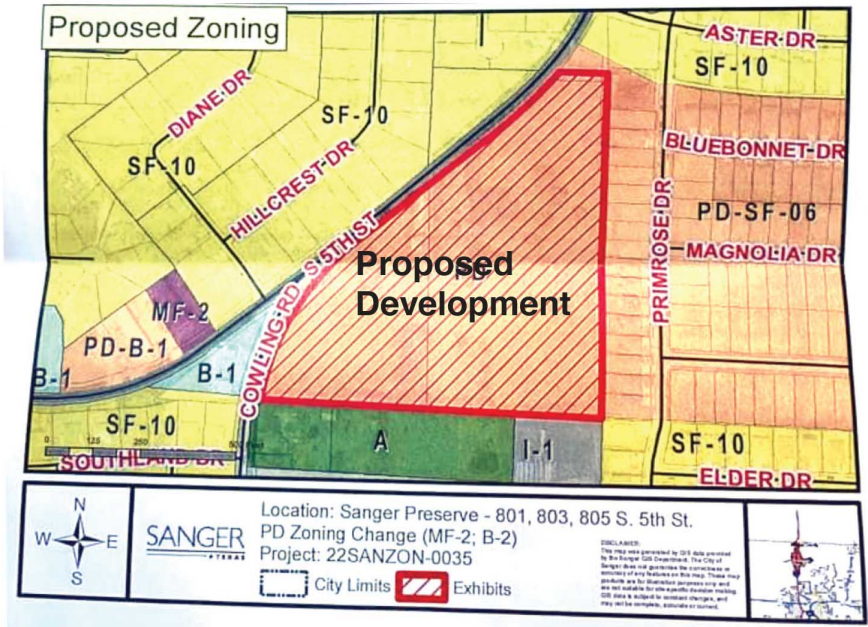

Request for Rezoning Public Hearing to be held for 166 unit apartment complex



The City of Sanger will conduct a public hearing by the Planning & Zoning Commission in the Historic Church Building, 403 N 7th Street, Sanger, Texas at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, September 12, 2022, and by the City Council on Monday, October 3, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. in Historic Church Building, 403 N 7th Street, for the purpose of considering the following: A Rezoning from Agricultural (A) to Planned Development (PD) of approximately 12.01 Acres of land, described as A1241A TIERWESTER, TR 264 and 265 R BEEBE, within the City of Sanger, and generally located on the southeast corner of 5th Street and Cowling Rd. The developer is wanting to build and apartment complex with 166 units. A recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission will be forwarded to the City Council.

5. The individual placed at the entrance to the parking lot needs a map of the lot with locations of each entry noted. This will allow a smoother entry process.

6. Only parade entrants and parents dropping off small children should be allowed to enter the parking lot. This will decrease the traffic, make everyone safer and decrease the frustration level of all involved.
