Election results for School Board and City Council

The local General Election for school board and city council was held on Saturday May 1. After early voting and election day ballots were finalized, Marissa Barrett defeated Steven Skinner for city council Place 1 by over 75% of the vote (202 to 66 votes). In the other contested race for city council Place 3, Dennis Dillon accumulated 67% of the vote vs. Grayson CeBal-

los (183 to 88 votes) and Victor Gann, city council Place 5 was unopposed and garnered 238 votes.

Ann Maria Afflerbach, school board Place 2 and Sarah York, Place 3 didn't have opponents, as well. Jarrod Roberts beat Ethan Scheffler in Place 1 (230 to 197 votes).

The Sanger News published election profile questions and answers to all the candidates the last two

weeks, but inadvertently left out Sarah York. She wanted the public to know that she's ready for another term on school board. "I'm honored to be a part of the Sanger school board for another term. My center focus is never agenda driven and remains what is best for the kids, teachers and administrators of SISD while remaining financially responsible. My goal is to continue moving the district forward. I'm excited that the board has officially invested in a firm to explore the potential for a bond. One of the biggest strengths and advantages our board has is teamwork. We work as a team to do what's best for the students in any situation. This allows for continued growth and focus on what's most important! I'm thankful for the opportunity to serve this great district."

City of Sanger responds to Super Save Grocery Store closing

The City of Sanger released a statement on April 29 about the closure of Super Save grocery store. "It has been brought to our attention that residents have expressed concerns on social media related to the recent closure of the local grocery store and the City's efforts to attract a new grocer.

As many of you are aware, TXDOT has planned the expansion of FM 455 and IH-35 through Sanger for several years. As a result of TXDOT's acquisition of right-of-way needed for this expansion, several properties have been affected by the projects.

Businesses located at the intersection of both IH-35 and FM 455, including Super Save, have seen greater impact because of

the loss of property to both projects.

Our development staff has been committed to assist impacted businesses through this transition process and has worked with several of them to help identify potential options that would allow them to continue to serve our community. In reviewing these options, staff considered the City's development ordinances, building codes, fire codes and parking regulations to ensure the viability of the proposed operations.

City Council and staff are aware of the community's desire to have more retail businesses in town, especially a new grocery store. There are many factors that go into a retailer's site selection process such as location, demographics,

proximity to other similar businesses, etc. Our staff has been actively engaging with several grocery store chains and sharing Sanger's story. This is not a new effort and will continue to be at the top of our list.

Currently, staff is working with several prospects which have shown an interest in Sanger. We are confident that the continued growth that is occurring in the Sanger area positions our city to be a very desirable location for a new grocery store.

Attracting quality businesses to our community, while recognizing the importance of the businesses that are already here, continues to remain a top priority for City Council and staff."

"SONGS OF SANGER"


Authored by Idaleene Scheu Fuqua

"Songs of Sanger", authored by Idaleene Scheu Fuqua, was originally published in 2011 and the very popular book sold out quickly. This book has now been re-printed and available for purchase.

Fuqua, whose father Fred Scheu was the station master for the Santa Fe Railroad at the Sanger depot, lived in Sanger as a young girl, and has shared many memories of the families, friends, businesses, community, young men serving their country, and special events held within the community from many years ago. Did you know that at one time there was a rodeo in downtown Sanger at the northeast corner of Third and Bolivar? It was quite an event with rodeo clowns, bull-riding on livestock from local farmers, and townspeople attended the event each week with great enthusiasm.

One of Fuqua's nostalgic memories was at the Wilfong building. The current Wilfong building at the corner of Fourth and Bolivar streets was formerly Jess Smith Drygoods store for many years after Mr. Wilfong sold the business to Mr. Smith. The lovely windows are still in place today, and were displays for goods to be sold. At Christmas-time, the store windows were as magical as Neiman-Marcus windows at Christmas. There was always a Christmas tree, holiday decorations, and gifts for the children on display in all the windows lit up for the holidays. Ms. Fuqua writes about Mr. Wilfong decorating the windows for Christmas and the doll she spied before Christmas one year; she hoped, wished, and prayed that Santa would be good to her and bring that doll with its wardrobe



trunk full of clothes. Late one night, the Christmas tree in the window caught fire before Christmas and she thought Santa could not possibly bring her that doll as she had hoped. She awoke Christmas morning and Santa did not disappoint. This doll is still around and owned by a friend of Idaleene. The Sanger Museum hopes one day this doll will be donated to our operation.

Bryan Roy Galloway

December 3, 1938 - May 1, 2021

Bryan Roy Galloway, 82, died Saturday, May 1st 2021 in Denton, Texas due to complications from a glioblastoma brain tumor.

On December 3rd, 1938 Bryan was born in Zephyr, Texas where he would spend almost all of his childhood. He often spoke of his good fortune to live and work with the good people in and around Zephyr. He was the foreman on a ranch while in high school. After graduating from Zephyr High School in 1957 he went to work for GTE (now Verizon) as a central office equipment installer. Drafted into the Army in peacetime, he served two years in Germany in the early 60's. He would retire from GTE in 1988. Not one to actually retire, Bryan worked for 2 years in Mexico City converting the Mexican telecommunications system from analog to modern, digital equipment.
