Sanger ISD surprises staff with employee retention stipend

Teachers and staff in Sanger ISD were greeted with an unexpected surprise on Tuesday morning — an employee retention stipend. As a thank-you for their tireless work since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Sanger ISD school board unanimously approved the stipends at January's board meeting on Jan. 11. The checks, which were funded using ESSER II allocations, ranged from \$500-\$1,000, depending on length of employment. Staff who had been with the district one year or less received \$500. Employees who had been with Sanger ISD 2-5 years received \$750, while staff employed six years or more received \$1,000.



Martha Ann Futch, 86, passed away on Sunday, January 9, 2022 in Arlington, Texas.





July 11, 1955 - January 11, 2022


Guy Charles Beckham, 66, of Sanger, passed away on January 11, 2022, in Denton, Texas.

Joneen (McCorkle) Haisler


December 2, 1940 - January 15, 2022
